

PHOENIX, ARIZONA

Crime Statistics

Changes From 1993 To 1994

- The overall violent crime rate increased 108.2% from 1993 to 1994.
- Murders increased 40.7% from 1993 to 1994.
- Rape decreased 4.6% from 1993 to 1994.
- Robbery decreased 3% from 1993 to 1994.
- Aggravated Assault decreased 7.8% from 1993 to 1994.
- Burglary remained the same from 1993 to 1994.

COPS

Phoenix has so far been awarded \$23,814,961 to hire 320 new officers.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

There are nineteen school districts in the city of Phoenix. Two of these schools have either adopted or partially adopted a school uniform policy. This does not include private, parochial or charter schools. The school policy is handled individually by each district.

CURFEWS

The city of Phoenix has adopted a curfew policy. The policy applies for two age groups. For minors that are fifteen years of age or younger, the curfew is 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. seven days a week. For minors that are sixteen and seventeen years of age, the curfew is 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. This policy has been in effect at least since 7/95.

If the minor does break the curfew policy, they are detained until their guardians pick them up. They are also required to appear in court and pay a \$65 fine. In some instances, the juvenile is also required to perform community service if curfew is broken.

PUEBLO, COLORADO

Crime Statistics

Changes From 1993 To 1994

- The overall violent crime rate increased 2% from 1993 to 1994.
- Murders decreased 13.6% from 1993 to 1994 (9 in 1993 to 8 in 1994).
- Rape decreased 5.8% from 1993 to 1994.
- Robbery decreased 1.2% from 1993 to 1994.
- Aggravated Assault decreased 19.8% from 1993 to 1994.
- Burglary increased 3.8% from 1993 to 1994.

COPS

Pueblo has so far been awarded \$612,259 to hire 5 new officers.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

There are two school districts in the city of Pueblo. Neither has adopted the school uniform policy.

CURFEWS

The city of Pueblo has adopted a curfew policy for minors that are eighteen years of age and younger. The curfew is 10:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday and 11:59 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. This policy has been in place for several years.

SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

Crime Statistics

Changes From 1993 To 1994

- The overall violent crime rate decreased 1.1% from 1993 to 1994.
- Murders decreased 20% from 1993 to 1994 (5 in 1993 to 4 in 1994).
- Rape decreased 4.7% from 1993 to 1994.
- Robbery decreased 7.1% from 1993 to 1994.
- Aggravated Assault increased 18% from 1993 to 1994.
- Burglary decreased 3.8% from 1993 to 1994.

COPS

San Jose has so far been awarded \$4,363,268 to hire 123 new officers.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Twenty-two of San Jose Unified's forty-two schools have made uniforms mandatory. Since 1992 some of the schools have adopted this policy for elementary and middle schools.

CURFEWS

San Jose has adopted a curfew policy for minors. The policy requires that minors sixteen years of age and younger have a curfew of 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and minors that are seventeen and eighteen years of age have a curfew of 11:30 p.m to 5:00 a.m. This policy has been in effect for two years.

SUBJECT: Crime One-Pagers for POTUS Trips

I am writing to request that Cabinet Affairs assume responsibility for ensuring the President's trip books have one-page crime summaries for each city he visits. At the request of Staff Secretary, Dennis Burke of the DPC has been preparing one-page fact sheets on crime for the President's trips. The fact sheets contain crime data and facts on Administration programs and initiatives, both presented without discussion or analysis (example attached).

Given the President's heavy travel schedule, the volume of crime one-pagers has greatly increased. I would greatly appreciate it if Cabinet Affairs could ask the Dept. of Justice to prepare these from now on. They are simple, straight-forward, factual backgrounders. Dawn Chirwa of White House Counsel has informed me that it is appropriate for departments and agencies to help prepare them for either official or political trips.

If you are comfortable asking Justice to take over the task, Dennis will assist whomever is assigned the task to smooth the transition and make sure the one-pagers meet Staff Sect.'s standards.

Please let me know ASAP if Cabinet Affairs can work with Justice to prepare the one-pagers. Please call me at 6-5573 if you have questions. Thanks so much.

COPS

Chicago was awarded \$45,450,156 in COPS funding to put an additional 929 officers on the streets. The Chicago Housing Authority was awarded \$1,928,443 to put an additional 32 officers on the streets, and the Chicago State University Police was awarded \$358,912 to put an additional 5 officers on the streets.

Curfew

For youths under the age of 18, the curfew is enforced after 10:30 on weekdays and 11:30 on weekends. If a youth violates the curfew law more than 3 times, a youth officer gets sent out to their house to counsel them. Furthermore, the parent can be held accountable.

School Uniforms

Over 200 schools have school uniform policies in Chicago, which varies with each school.

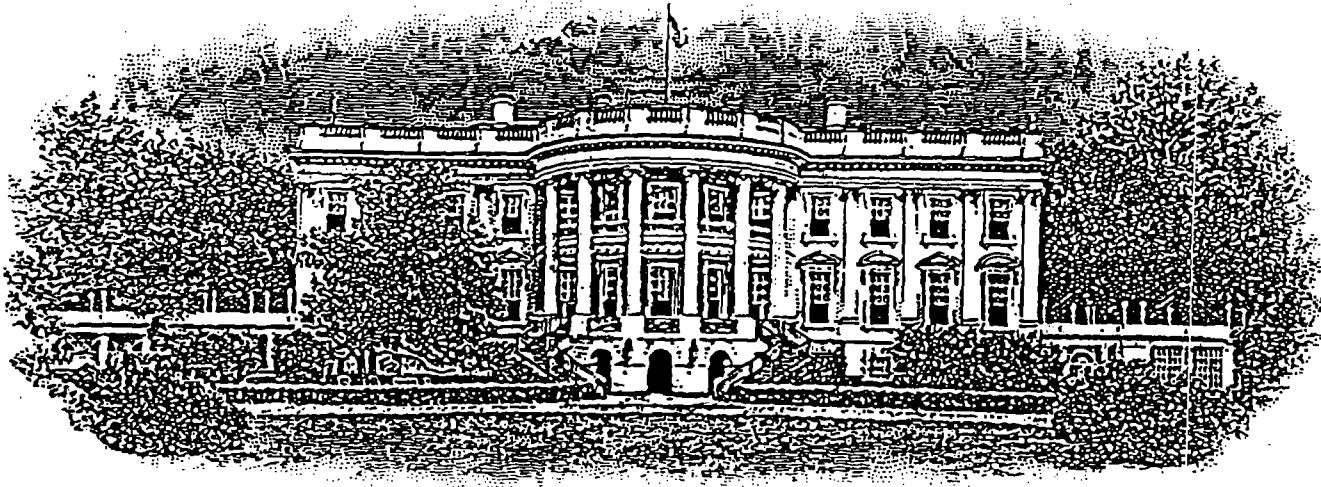
