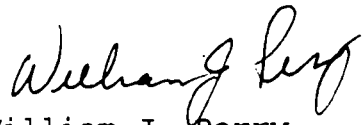

Pursuant to my authority as Commander in Chief and under title 10, section 161, of the United States Code, I hereby approve and direct implementation of the revised Unified Command Plan.

You are directed to make notification on my behalf to the Congress that may be required by title 10, section 161(b)(2), as a result of implementation of the revised Unified Command Plan.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Unified Command Plan Revision

Under title 10, United States Code, section 161, the President establishes the unified and specified combatant commands to perform military missions and prescribes the force structure of those commands. The statute also requires that the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff review not less often than every 2 years the missions, responsibilities (including geographic boundaries), and force structure of each combatant command and recommend to the President, through the Secretary of Defense, any necessary changes. The document by which section 161 is executed is known as the Unified Command Plan (UCP), which you last approved on 26 February 1993.

Attached for your approval is a revised UCP. The plan was reviewed by the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and contains changes that he and I recommend to add functional responsibilities to US Atlantic Command (USACOM) and disestablish Forces Command (FORSCOM) as a specified combatant command. The revision reflects the recommendation of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff that the CONUS-based forces of the Army's Forces Command, the US Air Force Air Combat Command, the US Navy Atlantic Fleet, and Marine Forces Atlantic be combined into one joint command. In close coordination with the other combatant commanders, USACOM will be responsible for the joint training and force packaging of these forces and facilitating deployment of joint formations drawn from the four Services. FORSCOM will become the subordinate Army component commander under USACOM, while remaining a major command of the Army. An effective date of 1 October 1993 is proposed.

I recommend that, pursuant to your authority as Commander in Chief and under title 10, section 161, you approve the revision to the UCP by signing the attached memorandum. The memorandum directs me to notify Congress on your behalf,

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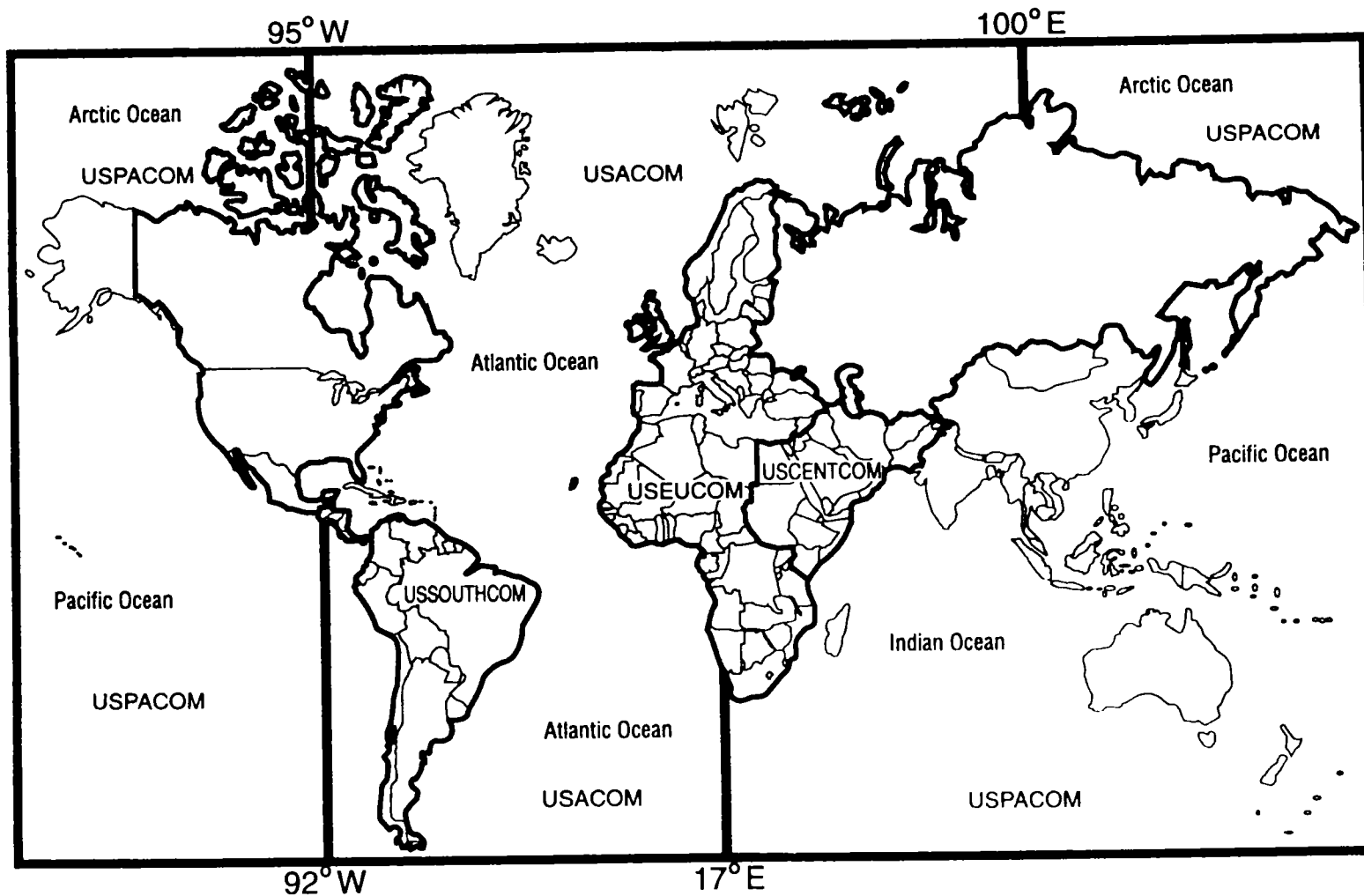
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COMMANDERS' AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY

At Tab I is a proposed memorandum to the Executive Secretary, Department of Defense, approving military exercise BRIGHT STAR 94. At Tab II Defense recommends approval and State concurs.

BRIGHT STAR 94 is a combined U.S./Egyptian field training exercise. The exercise is designed to show continued U.S. commitment to Egypt by successfully deploying a U.S. Task Force for air, ground, special forces and amphibious coalition operations. BRIGHT STAR will be the seventh and largest in a series of exercises that have developed an outstanding military-to-military relationship between Egyptian and U.S. forces. This exercise will take place in vicinity of El Hamman, Egypt, from October 6 to December 15, 1993.
