Once John Holum is confirmed, he will recommend a permanent SCC Commissioner, which is a position that traditionally has carried with it the rank of Ambassador. Tom has consulted informally with John, and they are agreed on this recommendation for the interim SCC appointment.

I enthusiastically endorse this recommendation. As a staff member of the Senate Arms Control Observer Group from 1985-1992, I had many occasions to observe Stan's work in Geneva. The Standing Consultative Commission is scheduled to begin its next session (SCC-XLV) on November 29, 1993. SCC-XLVI will follow with no break and will either conclude on December 17 or adjourn on that date and reconvene on January 17, 1994. These sessions of the Commission will address important issues including the fundamental issue of state succession to the ABM Treaty. ~~(S)~~

When the new Director of ACDA is confirmed he will recommend a nominee for the position of U.S. Commissioner to the SCC. However, it is necessary at this time to appoint on an interim basis an Acting Commissioner for the duration of SCC-XLV and SCC-XLVI. This will provide proper leadership and continuity for the negotiations and will signal interested parties of the sincerity of U.S. affirmations of its commitment to the viability of the Treaty and its effective implementation. ~~(S)~~

I recommend that Dr. Stanley Riveles be appointed Acting Commissioner of the U.S. Component of the SCC for sessions SCC-XLV and SCC-XLVI. Dr. Riveles is the Chief of the Strategic Negotiations and Implementation Division within the Strategic and Eurasian Affairs Bureau of ACDA. He has a long record of distinguished service, and his background in and knowledge of the issues are outstanding. (U)

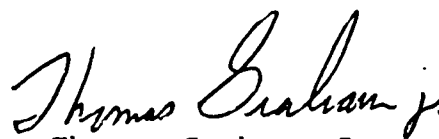

SUBJECT: Appointment of Acting U.S. Commissioner to the
Standing Consultative Commission (SCC) (U)

The Standing Consultative Commission is scheduled to begin its next session (SCC-XLV) on November 29, 1993. SCC-XLVI will follow with no break and will either conclude on December 17 or adjourn on that date and reconvene on January 17, 1994. These sessions of the Commission will address important issues including the fundamental issue of state succession to the ABM Treaty. (S)

When the new Director of ACDA is confirmed he will recommend a nominee for the position of U.S. Commissioner to the SCC. However, it is necessary at this time to appoint on an interim basis an Acting Commissioner for the duration of SCC-XLV and SCC-XLVI. This will provide proper leadership and continuity for the negotiations and will signal interested parties of the sincerity of U.S. affirmations of its commitment to the viability of the Treaty and its effective implementation. (S)

I recommend that Dr. Stanley Riveles be appointed Acting Commissioner of the U.S. Component of the SCC for sessions SCC-XLV and SCC-XLVI. Dr. Riveles is the Chief of the Strategic Negotiations and Implementation Division within the Strategic and Eurasian Affairs Bureau of ACDA. He has a long record of distinguished service, and his background in and knowledge of the issues are outstanding. (U)

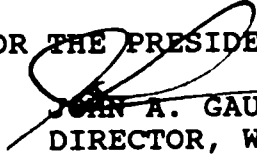

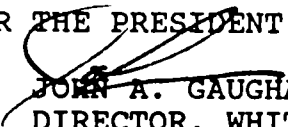

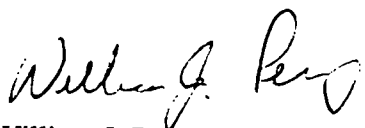
