Dear John:

I am delighted to extend my congratulations as you are sworn in as the Director of The Arms Control and Disarmament Agency.

There are few challenges more pressing in this era than arms control and nonproliferation. Already we have taken several steps to address these challenges. In the past year my Administration has submitted the Chemical Weapons Treaty to the Senate. We have ratified the Open Skies Treaty. We have advanced new proposals on a comprehensive test ban and the ABM Treaty, and have made substantial progress in the de-nuclearization of the States of the Former Soviet Union. We have elevated nonproliferation on the national agenda and are pursuing a number of measures in this regard, such as focused regional strategies and a comprehensive approach to the dangers posed by fissile materials. These steps and others we will take together can make our people safer and our nation more secure.

Much remains to be done to meet these challenges. Under your guidance, ACDA will play a crucial role in advancing the full range of our arms control and nonproliferation agenda. I look forward to having the benefit of your counsel, your expertise and your leadership skills as we work together to ensure a safer world for generations to come.

SUBJECT: Proposed FAA Section 552(c)(2) Drawdown for Egypt

State has requested the drawdown of up to \$13.5 million in DOD commodities and services to provide and transport up to 70 armored personnel carriers to Egypt. This assistance will support Egypt's military security in view of its contribution of comparable equipment to the UNOSOM operation in Somalia. We understand that DOD and JCS concur in this proposed drawdown.

OMB concurs in State's proposal and notes that if this drawdown is approved, \$11.5 million will remain in the Section 552(c)(2) drawdown authority for the remainder of the year.

Dear Mr. President:

By way of introduction, I am a warm friend of Congressman John Murtha, Chairman of the Defense Sub-committee of the House Appropriations Committee; indeed, I am Chairman of Republicans for Murtha in Western Pennsylvania.

This letter is intended to thank you for your truly wonderful gesture in calling Rear Admiral Tom Lynch, the Superintendent of the Naval Academy, given the grave tragedies that have afflicted our splendid institution in the past few days. The Superintendent is under enormous emotional and other pressures relative to the deaths of six superb human beings who wore the uniform of the United States Navy.

I wanted to suggest the following two thoughts to you. Rear Admiral Lynch is one of the outstanding Superintendents in my experience with the Naval Academy, and that covers forty some years. You are no doubt not aware that there is a quite serious investigation underway relative to alleged cheating in an electrical engineering examination last spring by the then junior class. These men and women -- and the number may be large -- are now all seniors only a few months from their graduation and commissioning. There will be a report issuing before long on this matter and it could be quite devastating. At that point, you could make an important gesture by coming to the Naval Academy and having a press conference announcing your support for the Naval Academy and for Admiral Lynch and for the program he has instituted.

The second thought I have relative to this is that you would do well for the country and the Navy to get to know Admiral Tom Lynch well because he, in my judgment, is a prospective Chief of Naval Operations and is a most capable executive. As you may recall, Congressman Murtha recommended him to your staff as the National Security Advisor when you became President.
