Attached at Tab I is a proposed memorandum to the Executive Secretary, Department of Defense, concurring in the military exercise INTRINSIC ACTION. At Tab II Defense recommends approval and State concurs.

INTRINSIC ACTION is a US-Kuwaiti-UK combined arms exercise with US involvement built around a battalion task force (approximately 1300 men, with two armor companies, one mechanized infantry company, and an artillery battery). This exercise is currently slated for November 6-December 15, 1994, with the advance liaison party arriving on October 12 and the main body of troops on October 28.

At present there are discussions underway at the CJCS-level to examine the possibility of moving up the exercise and deployment dates in response to military activities in southern Iraq.

The critical cancellation date is October 13, 1994.
