HUMANITARIAN POINTS

- Milosevic has been pushing Kosovars out ~~for over a year~~ -- we had massive displacement by end of last year -- more than 400,000 had left.
- Homes burned, civilians shot and killed, terrible atrocities that Serb forces perpetrated well ~~before~~ the media reports of last week.
- Long-term Serbian strategy that we have to oppose.
- United States has been at the forefront of international efforts to address the humanitarian needs of persons displaced within Kosovo and refugees fleeing Kosovo.
- To date, contributed estimated \$150 million to the humanitarian relief efforts for the Kosovar Albanians -- Includes \$50 million announced by President last week -- aid to support both civilian agencies and military efforts -- we are sending in tents, food, equipment.
- NATO is taking a leading role in assisting on humanitarian front -- and ensuring Macedonia and Albania are not overwhelmed.

[If asked about taking refugees:

- Need for temporary asylum is real -- other European countries have indicated they are willing to take large numbers temporarily -- as part of international commitment to provide temporary safe haven, we will do our fair share.]
