To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to express my concern for all United States citizens in China, but especially for a friend of mine who has told me of the conditions of rising tension there presently. He has been living and working at a foreign languages university in Xi'an, Shaanxi.

In the last few days there have been numerous demonstrations against him and other expatriates (this University has the largest single foreign nationals residency). These riots are in direct response to the Nato strikes, and particularly the bombing of the Chinese embassy in Belgrade.

I believe it is important for the safety of U.S. expatriates that the United States issue a formal apology. The word "apologize" must be used. It is imperative for the safety of all the foreign nationals living in or visiting China that this is done immediately.

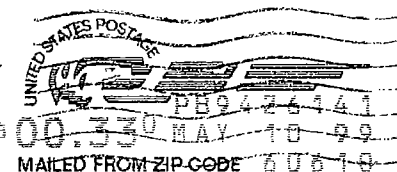
