Herald Opinion**James Livingstone**

THERE must be some public disquiet that it has taken so long for an internal garda review to conclude that James Livingstone could not have killed his wife Grace.

Mr Livingstone himself has always insisted that he was the Garda's chief suspect and that other lines of inquiry were being ignored.

Apart from the cloud of suspicion hanging over Mr Livingstone, it seems the force has let the trail of the real killer go cold.

Gardai announced they planned to broadcast a new appeal on RTE's Crimeline next Monday to seek public help in finding the murderer.

Since the exoneration of Mr Livingstone was based on a review of existing evidence the delay in eliminating him seems extraordinary.

Both Mr Livingstone and the public deserve better.

The real killer is still at large since December 1992.
