DEAR MR. PRESIDENT:

ON THIS AUGUST 15, 1995, THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF KOREA'S LIBERATION, I TAKE SINCERE PLEASURE IN EXTENDING TO YOU AND THE PEOPLE OF KOREA THE CONGRATULATIONS OF THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES.

SINCE LIBERATION, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA'S DYNAMIC ECONOMIC GROWTH AND ITS CHAMPIONSHIP OF DEMOCRATIC IDEALS HAVE WON FOR YOU THE ADMIRATION OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. THESE REMARKABLE SUCCESSES HAVE EARNED YOU A PLACE OF PRIDE AT THE FOREFRONT OF THE COMMUNITY OF NATIONS. I HAVE GREAT CONFIDENCE THAT KOREA'S "GLOBALIZATION" WILL RESULT IN ITS

FOR THE PAST FEW YEARS, OUR COUNTRIES HAVE WORKED WITHOUT RESPITE TO GUARANTEE A NON-NUCLEAR FUTURE FOR ALL KOREANS AND TO ESTABLISH A FIRM BASIS FOR A DURABLE PEACE ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA. OUR COUNTRIES' CLOSE TIES WERE STRENGTHENED DURING YOUR STATE VISIT TO WASHINGTON LAST MONTH.

WE WELCOME THE IMPORTANT INITIATIVE FOR PEACE THAT YOU ARE PROPOSING TODAY. AS ALWAYS, YOU AND YOUR FELLOW CITIZENS CAN COUNT ON THE UNITED STATES TO GIVE STAUNCH SUPPORT TO THESE NEW EFFORTS TO HEAL THROUGH INTER-KOREAN DIALOGUE THE TRAGIC SCARS OF THE WAR THAT, MORE THAN FORTY YEARS AGO, LINKED OUR NATIONS IN AN UNBREAKABLE BOND.

AS ALWAYS, YOU AND YOUR FELLOW CITIZENS CAN COUNT ON THE UNITED STATES TO GIVE STAUNCH SUPPORT TO YOUR EFFORTS TO HEAL THROUGH INTER-KOREAN DIALOGUE THE TRAGIC SCARS OF THE WAR THAT, MORE THAN FORTY YEARS AGO, LINKED OUR NATIONS IN AN UNBREAKABLE BOND.

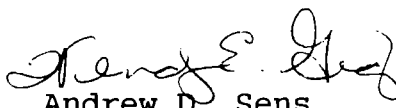

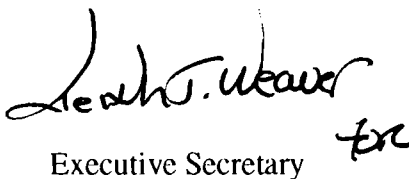
SUBJECT: Foreign Travel by DoD Officials

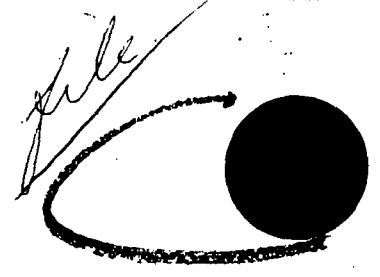

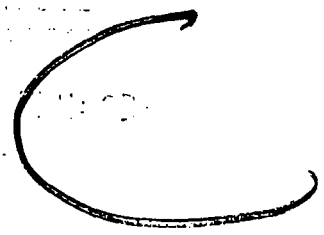
