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(FBIS TRANSLATED TEXT) DEAR FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, GREETING THE NEW YEAR, I WISH YOU A HAPPY NEW YEAR. I WISH YOU HAVE A GREAT JOY AND LEAD A WONDERFUL LIFE THIS YEAR.

TODAY, I AM GOING TO TELL YOU ABOUT MY IDEA ON THIS YEAR'S STATE POLICY AND, AT THE SAME TIME, TO CALL FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING AND PARTICIPATION IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE POLICY.

FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, THE WORLD SURROUNDING US IS NOW IN THE WAVE OF NEW CHANGES AND CHALLENGES CALLED GLOBALIZATION. THIS IS A NEW WAVE OF HISTORY WHICH CAN BE COMPARED TO THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION, WHICH PROVIDED A NEW FRAMEWORK IN THE HISTORY OF MANKIND.

TODAY, WHEN THE 21ST CENTURY IS NEAR AT HAND, MANY COUNTRIES IN THE WORLD ARE COUNTERING THESE CHALLENGES BY MOBILIZING THEIR WISDOM AND RESOURCES. WE SHOULD BREAK THROUGH THIS HUGE WAVE OF CHANGES AND, THUS, SHOULD BUILD OUR COUNTRY INTO AN ADVANCED NATION IN THE WORLD, WHICH DIGNIFIEDLY STANDS IN THE CENTER OF THE WORLD BY THE EARLY 21ST CENTURY. THIS IS PRECISELY OUR HISTORIC MISSION.

WE SHOULD MAKE THE 21ST CENTURY A CENTURY OF OUR NATION. FOR OUR NATION TO STAND IN THE CENTER OF THE WORLD IN THE CURRENT ERA OF UNLIMITED COMPETITION, IT IS IMPERATIVE TO RECTIFY TODAY'S BACKWARD SYSTEMS, CONCEPTS, AND PRACTICES.

THE CIVILIAN-LED GOVERNMENT'S MOVEMENT FOR CHANGE, REFORM, GLOBALIZATION, AND SETTING HISTORY STRAIGHT IS PRECISELY A PROCESS OF RENOVATION ON OUR OWN WITH A VIEW TO ACTIVELY RESPONDING TO THE CHANGES IN THE NEW HISTORY OF CIVILIZATION.

FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, TWO FORMER PRESIDENTS--WHO SHOULD WIN LOVE AND RESPECT FROM THE PEOPLE--WERE ARRESTED RECENTLY, WHICH IS THE FIRST EVER INCIDENT IN OUR HISTORY OF CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT. ALL OF US FEEL INDIGNANT AND DISAPPOINTED AT THE TWO FORMER PRESIDENTS' EXORBITANT EVASION OF THE LAW AND THEIR IRREGULARITIES, WHICH WERE UNCOVERED IN THE PROCESS OF THE PROSECUTION'S INVESTIGATIONS OVER THEM.

FIRST OF ALL, I DEEPLY CONSOLE THOSE WHO WENT THROUGH HARDSHIPS AND SUFFERINGS IN CONNECTION WITH THE 12 DECEMBER AND 18 MAY INCIDENTS IN MY CAPACITY AS PRESIDENT WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE STATE AFFAIRS. AT THE SAME TIME, I ALSO DEEPLY CONSOLE THE FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, WHO HAVE SILENTLY WORKED HARD FOR THE COUNTRY'S PROSPERITY, FOR THEIR MENTAL INJURY.

THE ARREST AND TRIAL OF THE FORMER PRESIDENTS ARE VERY UNFORTUNATE AND SHAMEFUL THINGS FOR THE STATE. HOWEVER, WITHOUT UNDERGOING SUCH A PROCESS, WE CANNOT SET OUR HISTORY STRAIGHT. THROUGH UNDERGOING SUCH A PROCESS, WE WILL ELIMINATE FOREVER THE UNFORTUNATE AND BACKWARD LEGACY CALLED MILITARY COUP DE'TAT AND, THUS, WILL RESTORE THE GENUINE HONOR OF OUR MILITARY AND OUR PEOPLE'S DIGNITY AND HONOR.

SETTING HISTORY STRAIGHT IS PRECISELY AN EFFORT TO BETTER THE FUTURE BY RECTIFYING THE WRONG PAST. IT IS ALSO AN EFFORT TO PROPERLY BUILD THE COUNTRY. THIS IS THE EFFORT THAT I HAVE CONSISTENTLY PUSHED AHEAD SINCE I BECAME PRESIDENT.

THE DECISION TO REMOVE THE OLD KOREAN GOVERNMENT-GENERAL BUILDING, WHICH IS A REMNANT OF THE JAPANESE IMPERIALISM, IS ALSO AIMED AT ESTABLISHING THE NATION'S SPIRIT BY SETTING OUR HISTORY STRAIGHT.

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COUNTRYMEN FOR TRULY UNDERSTANDING THE OBJECTIVE BEHIND RECTIFYING HISTORY AND FOR LENDING FULL SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT. WE MUST UNDERGO TEMPORARY PAINS TO TRULY ERADICATE INJUSTICE AND IMMORALITY SO THAT WE CAN PASS ON A BRIGHT FUTURE TO THE NEXT GENERATION. WE WILL BUILD A COMMUNITY IN WHICH JUSTICE AND TRUTH LIVES AND BREATHES IN ALL POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, SOCIAL SECTORS, SO THAT THEY ARE FILLED WITH TRUST AND COOPERATION. BEARING FAITH THAT RECTIFYING HISTORY IS THE SECOND FOUNDATION OF THE COUNTRY, I INTEND TO ACCOMPLISH THE TASK OF THE TIMES WITH MY FELLOW COUNTRYMEN. THIS IS OUR PEOPLE'S REVOLUTION OF HONOR AS WELL.

FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, DURING THE LAST PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION, I PROMISED YOU THAT I WOULD CURE THE KOREAN MALADY. THE MOST SERIOUS KIND OF KOREAN MALADY IS FOR PRESIDENTS TO RECEIVE MONEY. THE UPPER WATERS MUST BE CLEAR FOR THE LOWER WATERS TO BE CLEAR. DURING MY DAYS IN THE OPPOSITION PARTY AND PRIOR TO BECOMING PRESIDENT, I, TOO, RECEIVED HELP FROM MY SUPPORTERS FOR MY POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. HOWEVER, I NEVER RECEIVED MONEY THAT WAS DIRTY OR HAD CONCESSIONS OR CONDITIONS ATTACHED. MANY SUFFERED HARDSHIP BECAUSE THEY DID ME SMALL FAVORS. WITH THEIR HELP, I WAGED THE STRUGGLE TO ACHIEVE DEMOCRATIZATION FOR THE FATHERLAND, MANAGED THE PARTY, AND HELPED COMRADES IN HARDSHIP.

NO POLITICIANS, INCLUDING MYSELF, WERE FREE FROM THESE WRONG HABITS. HOWEVER, I NEVER RECEIVED OR SPENT A PENNY FOR MY PERSONAL WEALTH. I NEVER POSSESSED ONE PYONG OF LAND OTHER THAN MY HOUSE IN SANGDO-TONG, AND THIS WILL REMAIN TRUE IN THE FUTURE. THIS HAS BEEN A PERSONAL PRINCIPLE I HAVE SET FOR MYSELF AND STRICTLY ABIDED BY WHEN I HAD TO ENGAGE IN POLITICS AMID THE MALPRACTICES INVOLVING POLITICAL FUNDS AND THE ELECTION CULTURE. THROUGHOUT MY LONG CAREER IN POLITICS, I HAVE ALWAYS THOUGHT THAT OUR POLITICS SHOULD NOT CONTINUE IN THE SAME WAY, AND THAT POLITICS MUST BE FREE OF MONEY.

AS SOON AS I TOOK OFFICE, I MADE PUBLIC MY ASSETS AND ANNOUNCED THAT I WOULD NOT RECEIVE POLITICAL FUNDS. I DECLARED THE REAL-NAME FINANCIAL SYSTEM TO BLOCK THE ENTANGLING OF POLITICAL AND BUSINESS CIRCLES. HAD IT NOT BEEN FOR THE REAL-NAME FINANCIAL SYSTEM, WE WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN ABLE TO DISCLOSE THE IRREGULARITIES AND CORRUPTION OF FORMER PRESIDENTS. FELLOW COUNTRYMEN, THE 21ST CENTURY IS JUST FIVE YEARS AWAY. THE UPCOMING FIVE YEARS FACING US IS A VERY IMPORTANT ERA WHICH WILL INFLUENCE OUR IDEAL AND FATE IN THE 2000'S. THE TASK OF THE ERA WE ARE FACING IS TO ADVANCE AND MAKE THE COUNTRY'S SYSTEM AND PRACTICES INTO THE BEST ONES, SO THAT THE COUNTRY'S COMPETITIVENESS IS ENHANCED. INTERNATIONALLY WE MUST BE AN ATTRACTIVE COUNTRY THAT RECEIVES RESPECT.

FIRST IS TO EASE THE TENSION ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA AND IMPROVE SOUTH-NORTH RELATIONS SO THAT A BASIS CAN BE PROVIDED TO ACHIEVE THE FATHERLAND'S REUNIFICATION AHEAD OF SCHEDULE. CURRENTLY, NORTH KOREA IS SUFFERING FROM A SERIOUS FOOD SHORTAGE AND ECONOMIC CRISIS, AND THUS IS APPEALING TO THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY FOR AID. THE ECONOMIC CRISIS FROM WHICH NORTH KOREA IS SUFFERING IS NOT A TEMPORARY BUT A STRUCTURAL ONE. THE FUNDAMENTAL CAUSE OF THE ECONOMIC CRISIS IS THE NORTH'S EXCESSIVE MILITARY SPENDING USED TO MAINTAIN ITS MILITARY MIGHT OF OVER ONE MILLION ARMY TROOPS -- THE FIFTH LARGEST STANDING ARMY IN THE WORLD -- MAINTAINED FROM A POPULATION OF 20 MILLION PEOPLE, AS WELL AS INEFFICIENCY IN THE COMMUNIST ECONOMIC SYSTEM.

(FBIS TRANSLATED TEXT) IT IS NATIONAL TREACHERY AND A CRIME FOR NORTH KOREA TO WANT AID FROM THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY WHILE DEVOTING ALL ITS NATIONAL STRENGTH TO MAINTAINING MILITARY

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CAPABILITIES THAT THREATEN COMPATRIOTS. I STRONGLY URGE NORTH KOREA TO FACE THE INTERNATIONAL TREND OF RECONCILIATION AND COOPERATION, AND FUNDAMENTALLY CHANGE ITS ATTITUDE TOWARD THE SOUTH.

IF NORTH KOREA WANTS TO SOLVE ITS ECONOMIC DIFFICULTIES FROM A RECIPROCAL STAND WHILE ALLEVIATING TENSIONS BETWEEN THE NORTH AND THE SOUTH, WE WILL ACTIVELY COOPERATE IN ALLEVIATING NORTH KOREA'S DIFFICULT SITUATION. THE NORTH AND THE SOUTH SHOULD END THE ERA OF CONFRONTATION AND DISCORD AND OPEN AN ERA OF RECONCILIATION AND COOPERATION.

WE SHOULD GUARD AGAINST FANCY THEORIES ON REUNIFICATION. WE SHOULD BEAR IN MIND THAT AN INDISCREET REUNIFICATION THEORY THAT MIGHT CREATE UNREST AMONG THE PEOPLE AND INVITE A MISCALCULATION FROM NORTH KOREA IS NOT CONDUCTIVE TO IMPROVING NORTH-SOUTH RELATIONS, NOT TO MENTION REUNIFICATION.

SECOND, WE WILL STRENGTHEN OUR ECONOMY AND PROVIDE A FIRM BASIS FOR AN ADVANCED ECONOMY. THIS YEAR, ECONOMIC CONDITIONS WILL BE MORE DIFFICULT THAN LAST YEAR. THE GOVERNMENT WILL SUPPORT INVESTMENT IN EQUIPMENT AND TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT TO ENSURE THAT OUR ECONOMY MAINTAINS CONTINUOUS AND STABLE GROWTH. TO THIS END, MORE EMPHASIS WILL BE PLACED ON PRICE STABILIZATION.

THIS YEAR PRICES WILL BE STABILIZED WITHIN 4.5 PERCENT. AFTER NEXT YEAR, WE WILL EXERT EVERY EFFORT TO ESTABLISH A LOW-PRICE STRUCTURE, AS IN ADVANCED COUNTRIES. ALONG WITH THIS, WE WILL ACTIVELY SUPPORT SMALL- AND MEDIUM-SIZED COMPANIES THAT ARE IN A DIFFICULT SITUATION AND HELP THEM ADJUST THEIR STRUCTURE, THEREBY EASING THE BIPOLAR NATURE OF THE ECONOMY. THE OFFICE OF SMALL AND MEDIUM BUSINESSES WILL SOON BE ESTABLISHED TO SOLVE THE PROBLEMS OF SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZED COMPANIES IN A COMPREHENSIVE AND SYSTEMATIC MANNER.

DURING THE PAST THREE YEARS, WE PAINSTAKINGLY DEVELOPED AGRICULTURAL REFORM POLICIES WHICH BROUGHT ABOUT NEW HOPES FOR AND CONFIDENCE IN THE FUTURE OF OUR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERY.
