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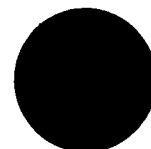

HIS CONFESSION IN WRITING [CHABAOKSO] IS AS FOLLOWS:

CONFESSION: I AM CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER BOBBY (WAYNE) HALL, JR., PILOT OF THE RECONNAISSANCE HELICOPTER [KAMSI CHIKSUNGGI] OH-58A/C OF THE 501-4 FLIGHT WING [PIHAENG TAEDAE], 17TH COMBAT FLIGHT BRIGADE OF THE U.S. FORCES IN SOUTH KOREA, WHICH ILLEGALLY INTRUDED DEEP INTO THE DPRK TERRITORIAL AIRSPACE AND WAS SHOT DOWN BY THE SELF-DEFENSIVE MEASURE OF THE KPA AROUND 1045 ON 17 DECEMBER 1994. MY ARMY SERIAL NUMBER IS 2673512

I WAS BORN IN BROOKSVILLE, FLORIDA, UNITED STATES, AND AM 28 YEARS OLD.

I JOINED THE ARMY ON 4 OCTOBER 1984. I FINISHED A ONE-YEAR FLYING SCHOOL COURSE IN THE U.S. STATE OF ALABAMA IN JUNE 1990. I PARTICIPATED IN THE GULF WAR AS A RECONNAISSANCE HELICOPTER PILOT AND CARRIED OUT A RECONNAISSANCE FLIGHT MISSION.

I RECEIVED FLIGHT TRAINING IN THE STATE OF TEXAS FROM 1 APRIL 1994 TO THE END OF OCTOBER 1994 TO COME TO SOUTH KOREA, AND WAS DISPATCHED TO SOUTH KOREA IN EARLY NOVEMBER.

AFTER ARRIVING IN SOUTH KOREA, I CARRIED OUT RECONNAISSANCE FLIGHT [CHONGCHAL PIHAENG] MISSIONS ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS AS A RECONNAISSANCE HELICOPTER PILOT.

I LEFT CHUNCHON AIRPORT ON 17 DECEMBER, FLYING WESTWARD VIA THE LOCATION OF SOHYANGGANG DAM 0295 SINNAMDAE, 0418 NO. 84 LOCATION, YONGCHON 3928 NO. 84 LOCATIONS, AND RECEIVED AN INSTRUCTION ON CARRYING OUT A SURVEILLANCE RECONNAISSANCE MISSION [KAMSI CHONGCHAL IMMU] RETURNING TO CHUNCHON FLYING EASTWARD AGAIN FROM NO. 32 LOCATION, CHONGOK-RI 1230.

AFTER BEING GIVEN THE FLIGHT MISSION, I MADE A PRE-FLIGHT CHECK, BOARDED AN OH 58A/C 7120796 RECONNAISSANCE HELICOPTER WITH CO-PILOT CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER DAVID MICHAEL HILEMON, AND TOOK OFF FROM CHUNCHON AIRPORT AT 1000.

FLYING ALONG THE AIR ROUTE, WE DEVIATED FROM THE DESIGNATED AIR ROUTE AT THE WONTONG-RI BORDER AND CROSSED THE MILITARY DEMARCATION LINE [MDL].

REPATRIATION OF CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER BOBBY HALL

On December 29, 1994, representatives of the United States and the DPRK reached an understanding on the incident involving a U.S. Army helicopter which accidentally strayed into North Korea on December 17.

In the understanding, the U.S. expresses sincere regret for this incident, and agrees to contacts in the appropriate forum designed to prevent such incidents in the future.

As of result of this understanding, Army Chief Warrant Officer Bobby Hall will be returned by the North Korean People's Army at Panmunjom ~~on the morning of December 30, 1994.~~ <

Chief Warrant Officer Hall will then proceed to the Yongsan military base in Seoul for medical evaluation and debriefing.

The U.S. welcomes the <sup>(understanding on the)</sup> release of Chief Warrant Officer Hall, and also extends its condolences to the family of Chief Warrant Officer David Hilemon, who died when the helicopter he and Hall were piloting was brought down after straying north of the Demilitarized Zone, and whose remains were returned on December 22.

EAP PRESS GUIDANCE  
December 29, 1994

Q: Can your release the full text of the U.S.-DPRK Understanding?

A: -- THE TEXT OF THE UNDERSTANDING WILL NOT BE MADE PUBLIC UNTIL AFTER CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER HALL'S RELEASE.

A: Are you certain the DPRK will actually release Hall tomorrow?

A: -- HIGH-RANKING OFFICIALS OF THE DPRK GOVERNMENT HAVE ASSURED DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY HUBBARD IN PYONGYANG THAT, WITH THIS UNDERSTANDING, HALL WILL BE RELEASED ON THE MORNING OF DECEMBER 30, KOREAN STANDARD TIME.

-- THE SIGNED TEXT OF THE UNDERSTANDING WILL BE HANDED OVER AT PANMUNJOM AT THE TIME OF HALL'S RELEASE.

Q: Does the understanding refer to "espionage"; is it an apology?

A: -- AS WE HAVE SAID MANY TIMES BEFORE IN MANY DIFFERENT FORA, THE INCIDENT WAS AN ACCIDENT; THE RESULT OF A NAVIGATIONAL ERROR -- NOTHING MORE.

-- THE U.S. CATEGORICALLY REJECTS ACCUSATIONS THAT THE HELICOPTER WAS ENGAGED IN ESPIONAGE.

-- IN THE UNDERSTANDING, THE U.S. EXPRESSES SINCERE REGRETS THAT THE HELICOPTER STRAYED INTO DPRK AIRSPACE.

Q: After making public charges of espionage and calling CWO Hall a criminal, why do you think the DPRK agreed to release Hall without a U.S. apology for espionage?

A: -- I CANNOT SPECULATE ON DPRK MOTIVES.

-- HALL'S RETURN WILL FOLLOW ON TEN DAYS OF INTENSIVE EFFORTS ON THE PART OF THE U.S. IN A VARIETY OF CHANNELS, INCLUDING DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE THOMAS HUBBARD'S MISSION TO PYONGYANG, MILITARY-TO-MILITARY DISCUSSIONS IN PANMUNJOM, DIPLOMATIC CONTACTS VIA CONGRESSMAN BILL RICHARDSON, WHO WAS VISITING PYONGYANG DURING THE FIRST DAYS AFTER THE INCIDENT, AND THE DPRK MISSION TO THE UN IN NEW YORK.

Q: Is the incident over now? What about the helicopter?

A: -- THE RETURN OF CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER HALL IS ANOTHER IMPORTANT STEP TOWARD PUTTING THIS UNFORTUNATE INCIDENT BEHIND US.

-- THE HELICOPTER IS U.S. PROPERTY, AND WE WILL CONTINUE TO PRESS FOR ITS RETURN THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE MILITARY CHANNELS.

Q: How will this incident affect efforts to improve U.S.-DPRK relations?

A: -- THE U.S. GOVERNMENT BELIEVES THAT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE U.S.-DPRK AGREED FRAMEWORK OF OCTOBER 21 IS IN THE INTEREST OF THE U.S., OUR ALLIES, A WORLD COMMUNITY CONCERNED ABOUT THE PROBLEM OF NUCLEAR NON-PROLIFERATION, AND THE DPRK.

-- WE HAVE ALWAYS STRESSED THAT THE FRAMEWORK IS BASED ON A SET OF INTERLOCKING STEPS. TO DATE, THE DPRK HAS FULFILLED ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FRAMEWORK.

-- WITH CHIEF WARRANT OFFICER HALL'S RELEASE, WE BELIEVE IT WILL BE APPROPRIATE TO TAKE FURTHER STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE FRAMEWORK.

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**136. North Korean Document Signed by the United States,  
Panmunjom, December 22, 1968**

To the Government of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea."

The Government of the United States of America,

Acknowledging the validity of the confessions of the crew of the USS Pueblo and of the documents of evidence produced by the Representative of the Government of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" to the effect that the ship, which was seized by the self-defense measures of the naval vessels of the Korean People's Army in the territorial waters of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" on January 23, 1968, had illegally intruded into the territorial waters of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea."

Shoulders full responsibility and solemnly apologizes for the grave acts of espionage committed by the U.S. ship against the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" after having intruded into the territorial waters of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea."

And gives firm assurance that no U.S. ships will intrude again in the future into the territorial waters of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea."

Meanwhile, the Government of the United States of America earnestly requests the Government of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" to deal leniently with the former crew members of the USS Pueblo confiscated by the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" side, taking into consideration the fact that these crew members have confessed honestly to their crimes and petitioned the Government of the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" for leniency.

Simultaneously with the signing of this document, the undersigned acknowledges receipt of 82 former crew members of the Pueblo and one corpse.

**137. United States Statement on the American Reconnaissance  
Plane Shot down by North Korea, Panmunjom  
April 17, 1969**

General Yi: Three days ago your armed forces committed an unprovoked attack on an unarmed U.S. aircraft. An EC-121, flying a routine reconnaissance track parallel to North Korea over the Sea of Japan, was reported missing at around 1400 hours, Korean time, on April 15. About 2 hours later, at 1555 hours, April 15, your radio announced that North Korean military forces had shot down a "large-sized plane of the U.S."

A toughly-worded dispatch contrasted with a Washington announcement earlier that the United States is sending a diplomat to North Korea at Pyongyang's invitation to help speed up the release of a captured U.S. Army helicopter pilot.

Envoy Thomas Hubbard's mission is to seek a prompt return of Chief Warrant Officer Bobby Hall, whose OH-58 scout helicopter crashed or was shot down on December 17 in North Korean territory. The other crew member, Chief Warrant Officer David Hilemon, was reported by North Korea killed in the crash.

U.S. officials have blamed the intrusion on a navigational error.

But the KCNA dispatch said an official investigation had shown that this was clearly not an "accidental case" caused by a "mistake" in a training flight, but a deliberate act of espionage. "Detaining and investigating criminals is a matter related to our dignified sovereignty," it said.
