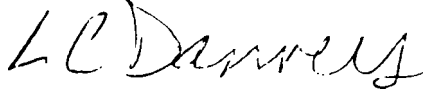

Dear Mr. Chairman:

To assist the Committee's inquiry regarding arms transfers to Bosnia from Iran, we previously provided you an index of 73 responsive NSC and third-agency documents that we are prepared to brief or show you and the Ranking Member of your Select Subcommittee. Subsequent to preparing the August 6, 1996, version of this index, three additional State Department documents involving the confidentiality interests of the executive branch, have been identified to the White House. Accordingly, I am now providing a revised copy of the index, dated September 9, which describes these additional three documents, listed as Document Numbers 4, 5, and 31.

Also, as part of our ongoing search for responsive documents, we have located an additional NSC document that we are prepared to show committee staff. Please ask your staff to contact Mr. Leary of the NSC staff to make arrangements to review this document.

HPSCI Document Requests

Background: On June 6, 1996 HPSCI requested access to all State documents regarding the provision of arms to Bosnia by Iran, including all documents that have been or will be provided to SSCI and the Intelligence Oversight Board. The Department is prepared to make available all documents provided to SSCI, and a response to this effect will be delivered to HPSCI shortly. In order to preserve the independence and integrity of the President's Intelligence Oversight Board, the Department will not respond to the HPSCI request to make available documents collected for the IOB. We believe that SSCI document requests largely include the same universe of information, however.

Points to Make:

We have received your request for documents. Our intention is to be responsive and helpful.

We understand committee staff have come to the Department to review some materials held there; we expect to deliver materials to the Committee shortly.

In the future we plan to make available to this Committee documents requested by and made available to SSCI on this subject .

In order to preserve the independence and integrity of the President's Intelligence Oversight Board we prefer not to respond to requests to replicate information provided to it.

Our intention remains to be responsive and helpful, and we will continue to work with committees to provide appropriate material on the subject under discussion.

We are not prepared to identify material provided to the IOB. We are prepared to provide response to HPSCI need for factual information.
