MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE

SUBJECT: Bosnian Compliance on Withdrawal of Foreign Forces
and Terminating Intelligence Cooperation with Iran

Pursuant to Public Law 104-122, I hereby determine and certify that:

- the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina has complied with Article III of Annex 1-A of the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina concerning the withdrawal of foreign forces; and that
- intelligence cooperation on training, investigations and related activities between Iranian officials and Bosnian officials has been terminated.

You are authorized and directed to report this determination and certification to the appropriate committees of the Congress and to publish it in the Federal Register.

Thank you for your letter regarding the Intelligence Oversight Board's (IOB's) report on Guatemala. In that letter, you suggest that the Government's treatment of the Guatemala report is may be inconsistent with its treatment of the IOB's Bosnia report. In fact, consistent with long-standing practice, the IOB's report to the President was not made publicly available or available to the Congress in either instance. Indeed, I know of no precedent for providing IOB reports to the President to the Congress in this or any other Administration.

What has been made available is an unclassified version of the Guatemala report in response to the President's directive, at the outset of the IOB's review, to make as much information as appropriate publicly available following the review. As a matter of comity, however, this Administration has sought to accommodate interest in the work of the IOB. Notwithstanding, the Board remains a Presidential oversight mechanism. I am sure you would agree that the public interest is best served by ensuring that the President's senior advisers, such as the Chairman of the IOB, on intelligence oversight matters, can provide frank and forthright advice and information to the President, without restraint. Both the IOB's report to the President on Guatemala and that on Bosnia are testimonies to that. Without a reliable expectation of confidentiality, Board members will not be as candid in their comments to the President; employees will no doubt be less willing to talk to the board freely; and, Administration officials likely will be less willing to turn to the board to address matters of concern.

This public report was not, of course, identical to the classified report to the President on the same topic, because the disclosure of those classified portions of the report would harm the national interest.

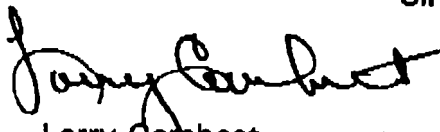

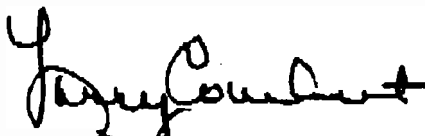

Mr. Chairman, I realize that anyone saying a few kind words about Executive privilege after the events of the last few years is in a position somewhat akin to the man preaching the virtues of water after the Johnstown flood, or the utility of fire after the burning of Chicago. But fire and water are, for all that, essential elements of human existence. And Executive privilege is indispensable to the functioning of our system of checks and balances and separation of powers. I hope that, whatever action your Committee takes with respect to the present legislative proposals, you will not seek to eliminate a vital element of our system merely because it may sometimes have been abused.

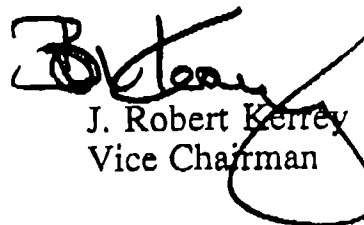

Dear. Rep. Combest

Your June 24 letter raised questions about (1) your requests for information concerning Haiti, and (2) the security situation.

Before responding, let me express my appreciation for your reassurance concerning the Committee's motivations. As I said in my (date) letter, I am confident that an objective review of the Administration's efforts will demonstrate that we aggressively sought out information about political violence in Haiti, and used it to secure the removal from government position of several individuals suspected of involvement in it. I believe the recent report of the CIA/IG should help dispel your concerns about politicization of intelligence collection.

On documents, I understand your frustration at the pace of production. However, I would ask your understanding of the process required to identify, review, and make available information. These are time-consuming matters, particularly as the same staff is handling document production and declassification requests on such diverse matters as Guatemala, Bosnia and Haiti. The NSC staff has nonetheless endeavored to respond promptly to requests from your committee, and the House International Relations Committee, concerning Haiti. I understand that to be true of the State and Defense Departments as well, but I will reinforce with them the importance I attach to getting you the material you need to conclude your inquiry.

In our last letter to you on the documents issue, Counsel to the President Jack Quinn made three undertakings. First, he said that we, and the State and Defense Departments, would ensure that our search for the items emphasized in your (date) letter had been thorough. The NSC staff has done so; we have found only (one) document not previously produced. (It is listed as document # on the list of documents at Tab 1). Second, he agreed to your request that we review for declassification 57 documents identified in your (date) letter. We have done so. Of the (number) NSC documents, we can declassify the (number) of attached documents, although several include redactions. The remainder continue to warrant classification. Finally, he undertook to provide you an index of documents which have not been made available to the committees because of the confidentiality interests of the Executive Branch. He also offered to consider ways to accommodate the legitimate informational needs of the committees concerning those documents on the list which you identify as of interest. If, upon reviewing the list, you identify documents of particular interest, please contact his office.

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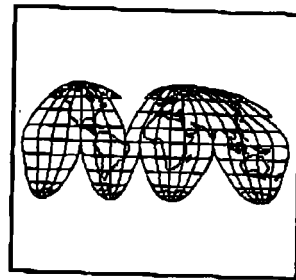
