Dear Mr. Battaglia:

This letter confirms our conversations by telephone on Monday September 23. At your request, the executive branch reviewed for classification two documents, "Draft Dissenting Views" and "Additional Views of Senators Kerrey, Baucus and Robb," which you shared with this office on Friday, September 20. After review of the material by representatives of the State and Defense Departments as well as the CIA and NSC, I can confirm, on behalf of the executive branch, that the two documents as reviewed are unclassified. This review did not address the content of the documents. Neither does this letter.

I would like to reiterate that the NSC staff and relevant executive branch agencies appreciate the effort the SSCI has made to work with the executive branch regarding matters of classification.

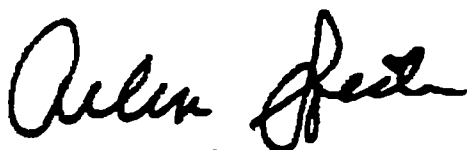
Dear Secretary Perry:

We are writing to invite you or your designee to testify at a hearing on Thursday, September 5, at 9:30 a.m. The purpose of the hearing will be to examine the need for legislation or improved procedures for notifying Congress of significant changes in U.S. foreign policy that are contrary to, or reflect a significant departure from, publicly acknowledged U.S. policy. The hearing stems from this Committee's concern that Congress was not notified of the Administration's decision in 1994 to acquiesce in Iranian arms shipments to Bosnia.

The Committee will also be interested in your views regarding whether Sections 501 and 502 of the National Security Act, which require the President and all department heads to keep the intelligence committees fully and currently informed of the intelligence activities of the United States, obligate the Intelligence Community to inform the committees of significant substantive intelligence collected by U.S. intelligence agencies.
