PLEASE ACCEPT, MISTER PRESIDENT, THE ASSURANCES OF MY HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.

"Rome, July 19, 1999

Dear Mr. President

As hopes begin to dim, I wish to express, with the request that you kindly convey these sentiments to the grieving families, how deeply saddened I have been by the distressing developments in the disappearance of John Kennedy, Jr.

This tragic circumstance has awakened an outpouring of emotion among the people of Italy no less overwhelming than in the United States. Clearly, it is a spontaneous reaction to the warmth for our country that the family has harbored over the years. Yet as painful as each tragic chapter of the family's history has been, it has also served to rekindle the idealism that its finest members have offered to the American people and to remind of the grand and noble contributions of American tradition to our world.

I know how much inspiration you drew from the image of the late President Kennedy and its effect on your own political life. Moments such as these give pause for similar reflection to all of us who stand by principles rather than expedients and values rather than speculation.

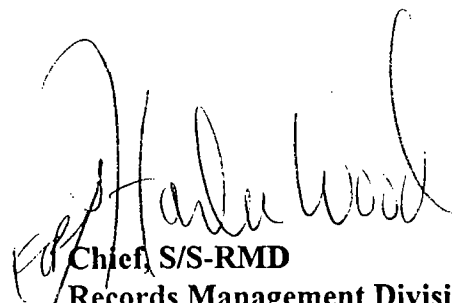

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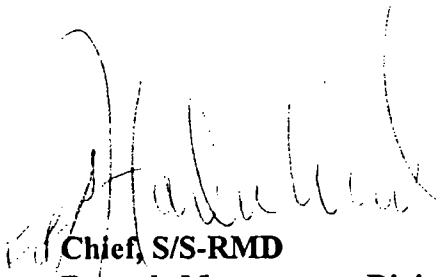
