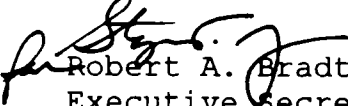

Recently our nation was saddened once again by a very untimely tragedy affecting the Kennedy family. the deaths of JFK Jr., his wife, and sister-in-law left America in a state of deep mourning.

As I watched and waited for any news of the recovery of the bodies and wreckage I couldn't help but notice how our government took every effort to recover the remains. The Coast Guard and all involved personell are to be commended for their tireless efforts in bringing this mystery to a close.

Major Robert Rosenbach was returning to Tuy Hoa airbase in South Vietnam on 05 March 70 when his F 100 Super Sabre disappeared from radar. It is believed that his plane went down in the South China Sea approximately 20 miles off the coast of South Vietnam.

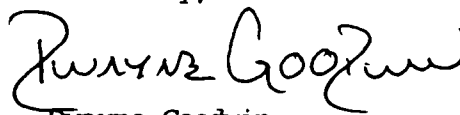
I continue to believe that Major Rosenbach could have rafted to shore after his aircraft went down. There he was picked up by Vietnamese unfriendly to the United States. Major Rosenbach was equipped with standard survival gear. That is how I form my opinion that he survived and rafted his way to shore.

I am asking you and all your cohorts to take all necessary measures to search the bottom of the South China Sea in search of Major Rosenbachs plane and wreckage from other pilots who were lost at sea.

These men put their lives on the line for our great nation and they deserve to be returned home to the nation they helped keep standing tall and free.

If these efforts can be done for JFK Jr., they can also be done for our veterans. I hope to hear from you on this very important matter.

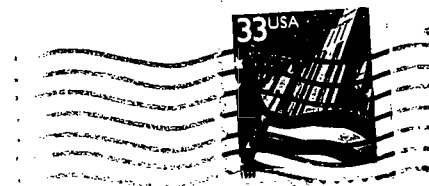

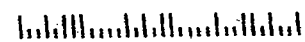
