CLINTON TO PRIME MINISTER K.P. BHATTARAI AT AN APPROPRIATE
TIME. THE WHITE HOUSE DOES NOT PLAN TO RELEASE TEXT OF
MESSAGE BUT HAS NO OBJECTION IF GOVERNMENT OF NEPAL WISHES
TO DO SO. THERE WILL BE NO SIGNED ORIGINAL.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR MR. PRIME MINISTER:

THANK YOU FOR YOUR KIND LETTER OF CONDOLENCE REGARDING THE
UNTIMELY DEATH OF JOHN F. KENNEDY, JR., HIS WIFE, AND
SISTER-IN-LAW. AS YOU SO RIGHTLY REMARKED, THE KENNEDY
FAMILY HAS IDEALIZED PUBLIC SERVICE. JOHN F. KENNEDY, JR.
CARRIED ON THAT TRADITION OF SERVICE WITH TREMENDOUS SKILL
AND GRACE, SENDING A MESSAGE OF HOPE AND PROGRESS TO THE
MANY LIVES HE TOUCHED. AGAIN, YOUR WORDS OF SYMPATHY ARE
GREATLY APPRECIATED.

THE KENNEDYS, WHO HAVE IDEALISED THE PUBLIC SERVICE, HAVE TO ENDURE YET ANOTHER TRAGEDY IN THEIR FAMILY. I WOULD LIKE TO EXPRESS MY PROFOUND CONDOLENCES AND SYMPATHIES TO YOU AND THE BEREAVED FAMILY AT THIS HOUR OF GRIEF.

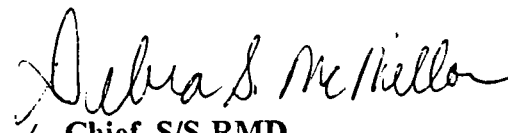
