John -- Last Friday a cross-section of Federal Credit Policy Working Group members met with Steve Malphrus at the Federal Reserve to begin discussions on the potential impact of Y2K on the lending industry and how that could affect Federal credit programs. Representatives from Education, HUD, SBA, Treasury/OCC, and VA attended the meeting.

The lending community originates about \$150 billion annually in loans that are Federally guaranteed. The community is servicing over \$750 billion in outstanding guaranteed loans. Here at Education, about 65% of our student loans are made by the lending community.

I understand that you have asked Steve to head the Y2K effort for the

financial / guaranty agency sector. The secondary markets (e.g., Fannie Mae, Sallie Mae, etc.) should be added to this group.

The members of the Federal Credit Policy Working Group who met last week look forward to working with Steve to ensure that Federal credit programs are not adversely affected by Y2K.

We are writing in reference to your letter to Secretary Riley, July 7,  
regarding the decision to set an interest rate on Direct consolidation  
loans  
comparable to the interest rate currently available on new Direct and FFEL  
loans.

Contrary to your assertions, the actions of the Secretary with regard to

the interest rates on consolidation loans are clearly consistent with the actions and positions of both the Congress and the Administration in lowering the interest rates on new Direct and FFELP loans. Your strident opposition to lower interest rates place you squarely at odds with the best interests of students.

The student community has been extremely supportive of the level playing principle, and has at no point asked lenders to do the impossible. We believe that there is merit to the case that it would not be profitable to consolidate loans at the 90 day + 2.3 interest rate so long as the 105 fee is maintained in its entirety. We understand that, as profitable as consolidation loans are, this fee places a real obstacle to participation by your industry in the advent of the lower interest rates.

It has also been our consistent position that student benefits in any program should not be sacrificed solely to establish an artificial parity for any lender. To the extent that the lower interest rates for FDLP consolidation loans creates a problem for your industry, the solution is more appropriately focused at providing your industry the opportunity to compete at the lower rate.

In stark contrast to this position, your reaction to the Secretary's decision ignores alternatives that would maintain involvement by the private sector in consolidation loans while still maintaining the lower interest rate for students.

Rejecting this position, as you apparently have, suggests that you have no interest in reducing the fee, and may have no interest in a level playing field. Most observers might consider this to be contrary to the traditional position of the lending industry, but maybe this is not so for a competitor that has already relinquished its interest in this area of service to students.

We remain interested in exploring options for reducing the 105 basis point fee on consolidation loans in such a manner that will ensure a yield commensurate with the yield that lenders still consolidating loans currently receive. We write to express our disappointment at the position you have taken and remind you that this is still a consumer driven business venture. While you may have certain legislative entitlements, these are entitlements which are dependent on the decisions of consumers . We are extremely committed to the lower interest rates that have been set, including ensuring that students are able to get that same rate when they consolidate their loans.
