TALKING POINTS FOR SHORT TERM OUT-REACH

- We are working hard to put the President's plan together.
- We believe that our out-reach efforts to date have been tremendously effective. The White House Conference -- attracting some 800 participants -- gave us literally hundreds of valuable ideas to consider. Follow-up meetings that have been held by the working group chairs have been instrumental in further fleshing out those ideas.
- A final decision has not yet been reached on when the plan will be released, but our best assessment at this point is that it will not be final by the end of August.
- The delay reflects our desire to ensure that the plan is based on the most thorough economic and environmental analysis.
- We have achieved tremendous progress in putting this plan together thus far, and we believe we have identified some programs and initiatives that can lead to significant reductions in emissions and help us to meet our goal of reducing emissions to 1990 levels by the year 2000.
- As to our guiding principals: We are taking quite seriously the President's charge that our efforts should not be built on more bureaucracy or command and control, but should be an effort to bring all parties together to find win-win situations. We are trying to foster efforts like EPA's green programs that help the environment and corporate bottom-lines. We want to drive technology; we want to improve efficiency and reduce waste. But, we want to try a cooperative approach to reaching these objectives.
