Question: Do you support efforts to require mandatory HIV testing of pregnant women?

Answer: The real issue is to get women into prenatal care so they can learn their HIV status and, if infected, take treatments that might prevent the infection of their newborn. The Public Health Service has issued guidelines that would make routine counseling and voluntary testing of pregnant women the standard of care in the United States. We should give those guidelines a chance to work before considering measures that might actually drive women away from prenatal care and thus lose the chance to prevent transmission.

Question: Do you support efforts to require mandatory testing of newborns for HIV when the status of the mother is unknown?

Answer: This is a difficult issue that, as I understand it, is now being worked out among House leaders. The central issue is to aggressively implement the Public Health Service's guidelines for routine counseling and voluntary testing of pregnant women -- so we don't face the situation of a newborn whose mother's status is unknown.

"The Right Way to Save
Medicare"

Much has been made in this season of great budgetary debate about the need to "save" Medicare from bankruptcy. Republicans in Congress have proposed \$270 billion in Medicare spending cuts over the next seven years, arguing that they are needed to preserve the Medicare Trust Fund. As trustees of the Trust Fund, we respectfully disagree with that diagnosis and prescription.

To be frank, claims that Medicare is about to go bankrupt are being distorted. Each year, the Medicare trustees examine the Part A Trust Fund, which finances hospital care, to determine its short

-term and its long

-term financial health. Eight times in the last 25 years, the Medicare trustees have predicted that the Part A Trust Fund would be bankrupt within 10 years. Another [how many?] times, insolvency was projected in a somewhat longer

period of time. This is neither surprising nor an indication of some structural defect in the Medicare program. Medicare and the 37 million people it serves are part of a dynamic and constantly changing health care system. So we constantly make changes in the program.

In the past, lawmakers from both political parties got together to pass legislation that moved that date farther away. For instance, in 1982, the trustees projected that the Trust Fund would be insolvent by 1987, only five years away. Legislation enacted as a result of that report created a \$54 billion surplus in 1987. In 1984, the trustees projected insolvency by 1991, but changes made by Congress resulted in a surplus of \$115 billion in that year.

Lately, however, things have been different. In 1993, the Medicare trustees predicted that the Trust Fund would be exhausted by 1999. President Clinton put forward a package of reforms that pushed back that date by three full years. However, for the first time, not a single Republican voted for the package, although the Democratic majority provided the necessary votes to enact the plan into law.

Last year, we, the current trustees, reported that the Trust Fund would be depleted in 2002. Again, President Clinton responded with a package of Medicare reforms that would push back the projected solvency date of the Trust Fund at least through 2005, or 10 years from today. That would be more than enough

time to put together a far

-reaching plan that will address the principle problem created by the aging of the Baby Boom generation. The President's proposal would reduce payments from the Trust Fund to hospitals, nursing homes, and other health care providers by \$90 billion over the next seven years.

Republicans have offered a very different plan. Their proposal calls for cuts of \$270 billion over seven years, with nearly half of those savings likely to come from the pockets of Medicare beneficiaries through higher premiums, deductibles, and copayments. These new charges would increase out

-of

-pocket expenses for the elderly by an average of \$2,825 per person or \$5,650 per couple, thus pushing at least half a million senior citizens into poverty and drastically increasing the medical financial burdens for seniors and their families.

The Congressional leadership says all of this pain is necessary to save the Trust Fund. But it is critical to note here that not one penny of the premiums and physician deductible increases currently being considered would go into the Medicare Trust Fund. All of the money raised would go directly into the government's general revenue fund and could be used for anything Congress chooses. And Congressional Republicans have been quite clear how they want to spend that money -- to help pay for a \$245 billion tax cut for wealthy Americans. That wouldn't help the Trust Fund at all.

As Medicare trustees, we are responsible for more than just the financial solvency of the Trust Fund. We are also

responsible for making sure that Medicare remains a high

-quality

program of medical care for our parents and our grandparents. It is our firm belief that the cuts being proposed by Congressional Republicans would adversely affect the financial health of our senior citizens and could endanger their physical health. The bottom line, here, is that these kind of radical changes are not necessary to preserve the integrity of the Trust Fund and they should not be enacted.

We can, as we have done in the past, work together on a bipartisan basis to develop reforms and savings that will extend the short

-term solvency of the Part A Trust Fund. That would give us the time we need to work out a plan that preserves Medicare's financial health while continuing to protect the lives and health of our senior citizens. In the final analysis, our job is to preserve the Medicare Trust Fund without losing the trust of our nation's senior citizens.

Two new studies regarding the use of AZT in the treatment of HIV infection were reported today. The first study looked at the use of AZT during the initial acute stage of infection. The findings suggest that the administration of AZT at the earliest possible time after exposure appears to delay onset of AIDS-related symptoms. Another study reported today (funded by the NIH) demonstrated that the use of AZT in the intermediate stage does not delay the clinical course of the disease nor prolong survival. Previously reported studies have demonstrated that administration of AZT therapy in the late stage of disease when the immune system is already damaged significantly delays onset of secondary opportunistic infections. The first study reflects an urgent need -- now being pursued by researchers -- for additional research to confirm and extend these observations on the use of anti-HIV drugs during the initial phase of infection.

Anti-HIV Therapy Lowers Risk of AIDS & Death. Late last week, the NIH announced results of a clinical trial that provided the first conclusive evidence that anti-retroviral therapy can reduce the risk of AIDS and death in asymptomatic patients with intermediate stage HIV disease (i.e., persons with CD4 cell counts between 200 and 500). The study of nearly 2,500 HIV+ patients found that ddI alone, ddI+AZT, and ddC+AZT were each superior to AZT alone in preventing complications of HIV disease, irrespective of the patient's previous treatment experience with AZT. Bullets for September 19th

? The House passed the Ryan White CARE Act reauthorization yesterday by voice vote. The Senate acted in late July. The only substantive differences between the House and the Senate bills relate to formulas to the states receiving funding. These should be resolvable before the current authority expires on October 1.

? The National Academy of Sciences released a report today on the role of sterile needles and bleach in preventing HIV transmission. HIV transmission through injecting drug use is a significant and growing part of the AIDS epidemic. The proportion of new cases of HIV infection involving people who inject illegal drugs has increased from 12 percent in 1981 to 25 percent in 1994. The report contains two principal recommendations:

(1) The Academy calls on the Surgeon General (i.e., HHS) to lift the Congressionally

-imposed restriction that forbids states and localities from spending federal dollars on needle exchange programs. This would permit jurisdictions -- at their option -- to use federal funds for such programs. The Academy found that needle exchange programs reduce HIV transmission, do not increase drug use, and often bring many drug users into treatment. The Centers for Disease reports that there are 68 syringe exchange programs in operation in localities around the nation.

(2) The Academy urges states to lift restrictions on the over

Subconference #1: AGRICULTURE

? Republican leaders have reportedly settled on \$13 billion in agriculture cuts. House bill had cut \$13.3 billion, while the Senate bill had cut \$12.7 billion.

Subconference #2: BANKING

* [From Julie J. Sonier/HTF:] Our latest information on BIF/SAIF in the reconciliation conference negotiations indicates that the Senate language will be taken as a starting point. The issues of the future of the thrift charter and the Office of Thrift Supervision will be addressed in separate legislation; these provisions, which were included in the House bill, had no budget impact.

The Senate's BIF/SAIF provisions were originally scored by CBO as saving \$2.2 billion, but some changes are likely to be made which would bring the total down to about \$900 million (the amount originally scored for the House BIF/SAIF provisions). The changes are considered necessary to avoid a potentially large PAYGO problem for the subsequent charter/OTS legislation.

We also learned last week that the Community Reinvestment Act provisions are likely to be struck due to Byrd Rule problems.

* [Reported by BNA:] Staffs Narrow Key Banking Reconciliation Differences. As House and Senate Banking conferees prepared for a final meeting today on budget reconciliation, staff negotiations into this morning had worked out all but three key differences between the chambers. Sources close to the talks said staff were still discussing the conditions for placing a cap on the federal

deposit insurance funds, so that the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp. would have to rebate excess bank and thrift deposits in most cases. A Senate offer made Monday would require all but the lowest risk institutions, under the regulators' risk-based capital systems, to continue to pay premiums when the funds are fully capitalized. While this would mean that about 95 percent of the industry would not pay premiums when their funds were fully capitalized, the House counteroffered to lock in certainty that the FDIC could not expand the categories of risk, thereby requiring premiums of more banks, sources said.

A second issue still on the table concerns so-called Oaker banks -- banks that purchased thrift deposits under a special agreement with the government during the savings and loan crisis. The Senate proposed Monday to give Oaker banks a 15 percent discount on the one-time special assessment on all thrift deposits required under the reconciliation bill to recapitalize the Savings Association Insurance Fund. The House counteroffered today with 20 percent. The House and Senate bills proposed a special assessment of 85 cents per \$100 of thrift deposits to bring the fund up to its reserve ratio. But an FDIC official said Monday the special assessment is likely to drop to 78 cents or 79 cents, due to unexpected thrift industry profits over the past

few quarters. The third issue under discussion is a House plan to redistribute between the Federal Home Loan Banks their so-called REFCORP debt, also left over from the S&L crisis. The Senate wants to drop the provision unless the House agrees to raise the loan limit for banks and other non-thrift FHLBank System members, sources said.

* [REPORT FROM BNA:] GOP Senators, Governors Make Headway On Medicaid. The Senate Republican Medicaid task force met today with GOP Govs. Mike Leavitt of Utah and George Voinovich of Ohio, and moved closer to a consensus on how to proceed in conference on two major outstanding issues, including an apparent agreement to keep federal nursing home standards. "I am confident this bill will have federal nursing home standards," Leavitt told reporters after a late morning meeting with Sens. John Chafee, R-R.I., James Jeffords, R-Vt., Olympia Snowe, R-Maine, and Charles Grassley, R-Iowa. The Senate-passed Medicaid plan would keep federal standards, but would allow states to seek waivers to set their own nursing home standards. Grassley said nursing home standards "will stay at the federal level" and the other major issue, the Senate bill's federal entitlement for children, pregnant women and the disabled, "will stay the same."

Leavitt said the governors seem to agree with the Senate that states should provide Medicaid coverage for pregnant women, disabled and children, but they disagree with the set asides in the bill. "The big issue is whether you're going to have both entitlements and set asides," Leavitt said. Jeffords complained that the governors were making "too many distinctions" and getting caught up in "labels." Leavitt also said the governors and senators "are coming together on spousal impoverishment," the issue of whether states should be allowed to require adult children to pay for the nursing home costs of their elderly parents. The senators and governors were scheduled to meet again later today to try to resolve outstanding issues before House and Senate Medicaid conferees meet. Snowe expressed optimism all problems would be resolved today.
