The NAACP wants the support the Administration but feel they have compromised enough. They have agreed to barring retroactivity so the 2,000 inmates currently on death row won't be affected. Similar to the Civil Rights legislation passed in 1991, no quota language was agreed to. Wade feels strongly that the Administration should approach DeConcini and ask him to offer compromise.
