Dear Mr. President:

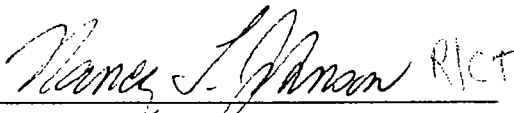
We agree with you that the American people have a right to expect an anti-crime bill from the 103rd Congress and, with our votes last night, we showed that we are ready to send a meaningful bill to you for signature. Nevertheless, it is clear that substantial work remains to be done if a new bill is to be successful.

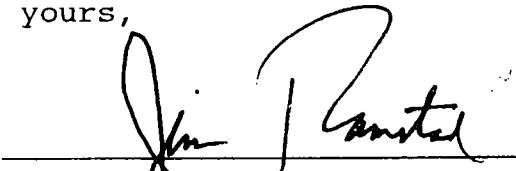
A strong, bipartisan crime bill could be approved overwhelmingly if at least the issues regarding rape penalties, sexual predators, and overall cost are addressed. The latter problem is clear to most observers because the original House bill authorized \$22 billion, the Senate cleared \$26 billion, yet the conference report surpassed them both at \$30 billion. Surely there is an opportunity to do a better job of integrating new programs with existing efforts in order to reduce the overall cost of the legislation.

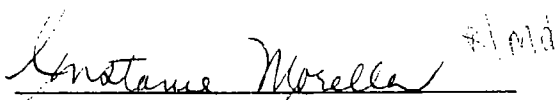
Finally, many Members rely on the written conference report and the statement of managers for complete information on the bill before them and rightfully demand that they be available for review at least one full day in advance of the expected votes.

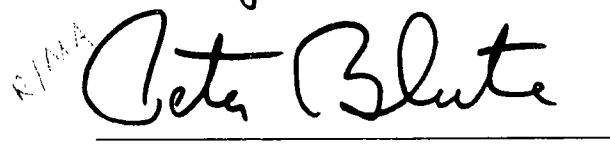
We strongly urge you to press the conference committee to reconvene soon and stand ready to continue working with your Administration to accomplish our shared goals.
