TITLE Collaboration in Policy Analysis

I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The DHHS Office of AIDS Policy is responsible for review and advice to senior Department officials on the appropriate and timely development of HIV/AIDS policy; the establishment of critical priorities for the Department and within HIV/AIDS programs in the health agencies to address the Secretary's and Administration's expectations for conducting a strong, comprehensive national response to the HIV epidemic; and, promoting coordination and collaboration among the Department's health agencies in areas such as research, prevention, substance abuse and treatment, provision of health care and services, and issues related to HIV/AIDS infected and affected children and families. The HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB) of the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), administers the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency (CARE) Act which was enacted to improve the quality and availability of care for people with HIV/AIDS and their families. The Bureau's programs benefit low-income, uninsured and underinsured individuals and families affected by HIV/AIDS.

This agreement provides support for a collaborative effort to analyze a broad range of policy and program issues related to HIV/AIDS and specifically their impact on HAB and the Department in the administration of CARE Act programs. It is expected that this analysis will include current research and educational activities related to HIV/AIDS in both national and international public and private sectors.

II. AUTHORITY

Authority to enter into this Agreement is found under 31 U.S.C. 1535 and under Section 601 of the Economy Act of 1932, as amended.

III. FUNDING

The total funding, under this agreement is \$32,600. Of this amount, \$8,200 will be available in FY 1998 and \$24,400 to be made available in FY 1999.

FY 1998 funds shall be transferred from HRSA to OPHS, citing the following accounting information:
