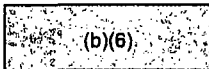

We've just completed a survey of Social Office events that have been arranged this year. We all know we've all done a lot of events with many people, but as a result of this survey we really have a clear picture of the dramatic increase this year. Compared to 1992, we've had a 279% increase in the number of events and 432% more people attended events than in the first nine months for President Bush. We've done 304 events with 53,057 people. This does not include the Easter Egg Roll of 23,000 people.

Even if we use 1991 as a comparison (since this was not an election year), attendance increased by 39,000 people in 1993.

For the holiday season, I am requesting that we have detailed to us at least one, if not two, Computer People and one Calligrapher. Luckily, we have good volunteers, but the day we don't have them, we will be in trouble. The holiday work load is more dramatic than the first nine months.

My request is to be considered for an invitation, for my wife Alla and me, to the President's state dinner for President Leonid Kravchuk and Mrs. Kravchuk at the White House. The Kravchuks will be on a state visit March 3-4-5, 1994, as official guests of the President, and will be staying at Blair House.

I make the request as a fully accredited White House correspondent and a long-time reporter on national and world affairs (resumé and short biography enclosed). I have written extensively on Ukraine and Ukrainian-Americans and know the Kravchuks.

My wife has entertained Mrs. Kravchuk at her Alla Rogers Gallery in Georgetown. It specializes in Eastern European and Washington art. Alla, whose parents were born in Ukraine, is fluent in Ukrainian and Russian. She has made several visits to Ukraine since the breakup of the Soviet Union and has created an art exchange program. Last summer, she led 20 American artists and Washington high school students to Ukraine, where they met and painted with top Ukrainian artists, and, this summer, she is bringing a Ukrainian group here to work with American artists.

BIOGRAPHY:

Warren Rogers is, in the words of one colleague, "a Renaissance man of journalism - he can do it all, from frothy little features that illuminate a hidden truth to deeply analytical interpretations of major events." Another colleague said, "He is what every editor ought to be."

Still another, Helen Thomas of United Press International, the dean of White House correspondents, adds: "He is one of the most astute correspondents I have ever met on the Washington scene. He is brilliant in foreign affairs and knows the national political situation as a veteran observer. His credentials are excellent as a non-partisan reporter. He draws a straight line, always."

Rogers writes WHITE HOUSE WATCH, the weekly column distributed nationwide by Associated Features. He created, staffed and edited The Georgetown COURIER, a much-applauded weekly published in Washington in 1991-92. He contributes to the Philadelphia INQUIRER, the Los Angeles TIMES, the Washington POST, WASHINGTONIAN Magazine and others, and does lectures and radio and television commentary. In 1991, he conducted three weeks of workshops in Nigeria for reporters and editors, preparing them for Nigeria's transition from a military to a democratic government through a presidential campaign and elections.

Rogers holds many honors, including the Overseas Press Club of New York Citation for Best Reporting from Abroad for his Vietnam War coverage, and was President of the National Press Club in 1972. He was elected to the Gridiron Club, the honors group of top Washington correspondents, in 1966. He won the Public Relations Society of America's Thoth Award in 1975 and its Silver Anvil Award in 1976. He is a founder and board member of the National Press Foundation, which awarded him its 1991 Distinguished Service Award. He holds numerous National Press Club citations.

Rogers was born in New Orleans, La., on May 6, 1922. He studied at Jesuit High School and Tulane and Louisiana State Universities, served in the U.S. Marine Corps in combat at Tulagi and Guadalcanal in World War II, and began his career on the old New Orleans Morning Tribune as a 16-year-old copyboy. He joined the Associated Press in 1947, mostly covering Louisiana politics and government until 1951, when he was called to Washington. His regular beat was the State Department, but he also covered the White House, Congress and national politics for AP, including the 1952 and 1956 Presidential conventions and campaigns.

Rogers Biography -- page two

In 1959, he joined the Washington Bureau of the New York Herald-Tribune, specializing in military and foreign affairs, the presidency and national politics, including the 1960 conventions and campaign (his "Our Man On the Bus" series being nominated for a Pulitzer Prize, as was his series from Vietnam on the Army's Special Forces [Green Berets] in combat, in 1962). He covered the civil rights disturbances in the South throughout the 1960s, including Little Rock, Selma, Birmingham, Oxford, Tuscaloosa, Jackson and so on.

He became Hearst Newspapers' Washington Bureau chief in 1963, moving on to LOOK Magazine in 1966 as Washington editor. With the demise of LOOK, Rogers joined the Los Angeles TIMES' Washington Bureau and, among other major events, covered the courtmartial trial of Lt. William Calley for the My Lai massacre for the Times. His column, COUNTDOWN, was nationally syndicated by the Chicago Tribune-New York Daily News Syndicate. His coverage during this period included the 1964, 1968 and 1972 conventions and campaigns. After that, he concentrated on newsletters, overseeing 23 newsletters for PLUS PUBLICATIONS and then writing his own THIS WEEK IN THE WHITE HOUSE, and his syndicated column THIS WEEK IN WASHINGTON, including reporting on the 1976, 1980 and 1988 conventions and campaigns. He covered the 1992 campaign and conventions through his syndicated column, PRESIDENTIAL COUNTDOWN 1992, distributed nationwide by Associated Features, now distributing his WHITE HOUSE WATCH weekly column.

Rogers has written five books, including one on the Vietnam War, which he covered extensively, and two on Robert F. Kennedy. The newest Kennedy book, "When I Think of Bobby: A Personal Memoir of the Kennedy Years," was published by HarperCollins in 1993. Rogers was a close friend of Kennedy. He was with him when he was shot in 1968 and rode with him in the ambulance to the hospital. He and 14 other Washington journalists founded the Robert F. Kennedy Journalism Awards, now drawing hundreds of entries each year. His other books include "The Floating Revolution" in 1962, "Outpost of Freedom" in 1965, "An Honorable Profession: A Tribute to Robert F. Kennedy" (with others) in 1968 and "Sea Shepherd" in 1982.

Rogers married Hilda Kenny of New Orleans in 1943. (She died in 1969. He married Alla Bilajiw of Philadelphia, Pa., in 1973. They make their home in Georgetown in Washington, D.C. Rogers has two children, Patricia Rogers Wagaman, NationsBank public relations manager, of Davidsonville, Md., and Sean J. Rogers, a lawyer, labor mediator and director of personnel relations for Montgomery County, Md., and a granddaughter, Margot Hilda Cerutti, a senior at Severn Preparatory in Annapolis.

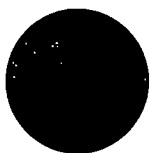
