Dear Conference:

We write to urge final passage of the Work
Incentives Improvement Act before Congress adjourns.

We remain concerned that the current version of
the Conference Report contains inadequate funding
for the Medicaid demonstration portion of the legislation.
The original proposal was for \$300 million over
five years and we understand the Report language is
for \$100 million.

We are also opposed to some of the current offsets in
the Report. We believe the FHA mortgage and student
loan offsets are especially troubling as they impact on
others in need. We understand negotiations have
produced alternative offsets and we urge your support
for some for a fully funded bill.
We urge you to work with the President to ensure the

passage of a meaningful and well crafted work
incentives bill that is paid for and adopted
in this session of Congress.
