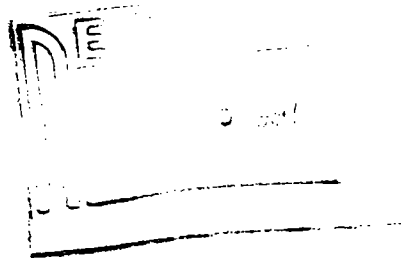

Dear Mr. President,

I understand that you have pledged your support for a vaccination to be developed for AIDS within the next ten years. It is a good feeling knowing that a President would come out and give his support. But, Mr President, if all men are created equal under our Constitution, does that also mean your support should be equal for all diseases.

I hope your Aide shows you my letter. I have spilled my heart out many times with no response of positive concern. I have enclosed the letters and articles dealing with my heartache.

My family has been devastated by a disease that is deadlier than AIDS. This disease is known as Bacterial Meningitis; Where AIDS may take years to kill a person, Bacterial Meningitis takes hours. My nephew, Michael Skowronek, was killed by this disease

Bacterial Meningitis seems to develop in young children to young adults. Mainly, College students since they live in close quarters. Young adults, like Chelsea, Mr President,

Every year many College students like my nephew fall victims to this disease. Some do survive, but they suffer from very different types of disabilities, loss of limbs, fingers and mental retardation.

I have to tell you about Michael, our HERO. Michael had just turned 19 years old on Sept 30, 1996. A lot of changes were happening in his life. He just started college, Drexel University, which was his father's Alma Mater. He was living away from his home for the first time in a Dorm. Michael just voted in his first Presidential Election.

Thinking back over Michael's lifetime with us, I would call him an "achiever". Michael had a learning disability. He struggled through Elementary school and fought hard for all the success that he accomplished.

In middle school, Michael developed an understanding for the Computer. He was a "WIZ" with them. He also developed a 6<sup>th</sup> sense for fixing broken down items.

In High School, Michael was elected to Student Council. He was liked by his fellow students and teachers. His accomplishments grew with the Computer. He developed a "teaching program".

I do not have to explain to you the pain that my brother, Carl and sister-in-law, Linda are feeling. They watched as their first child (my mother's first grandchild and my first blood nephew) slip away in the hospital and they could not help him.

I plead with you to use your Presidential power as well as being the Commander of our military to have the vaccine that is used by the military for all your fellow Americans to use. Please do not say we need to test this vaccine. Bacterial Meningitis was known as "Baricks Disease" A Vaccine was developed in 1911, Twenty-five years ago.

I cannot help to think that if Michael had joined the military he would be here today. But instead my brother and sister-in-law are trying to make other parents aware of this deadly disease.

Many families seek closure in the death of a loved one. My family cannot. We are wondering "why" Michael was discriminated upon because he decided on a College education and not the military. As you know Mr President, it is not just the military that makes a country great.

Dear Mr. President:

As you know, the AIDS epidemic continues to ravage our nation. With AIDS now the leading killer of all Americans between the ages of 25 and 44, we cannot retreat in the battle against this epidemic.

Through many important legislative initiatives, we have made great progress in combating this deadly disease. By funding the National Institutes of Health, we have given people with HIV/AIDS new hope. Through the Ryan White CARE Act, we have provided humane health and supportive services to AIDS patients. And through public education campaigns in our schools, we have heightened awareness about the virus and given our young people smarter and healthier strategies to protect themselves. Now it is time to address the spread of AIDS among intravenous drug users.

Through June 1996, approximately one-third of all reported AIDS cases were directly or indirectly related to intravenous drug use. And more than half of all children with AIDS contracted the virus from mothers who were intravenous drug users or the sexual partners of intravenous drug users.

The only way we can slow this alarming trend is to keep intravenous drug users from sharing needles, and this is best accomplished by supporting needle exchange programs. Scientific evidence has shown that these programs work. In a 1995 study commissioned by Congress, the National Academy of Sciences found that needle exchange programs reduced the spread of AIDS. Another recent study showed a two-thirds drop in HIV infections among needle exchange participants in New York City. The Congressional Office of Technology Assessment, the National Commission on AIDS, and the US General Accounting Office have all reviewed studies on needle exchange and have endorsed the finding that needle exchange programs are effective in slowing the spread of AIDS. Needle exchange programs are also supported by leading health organizations including the American Medical Association and the American Public Health Association.

The evidence also makes clear that needle exchange programs do not lead to higher drug use.

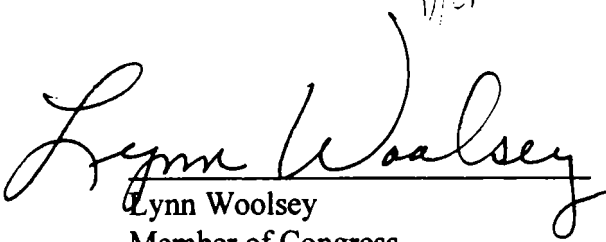
The National Academy of Sciences study found that these programs do not encourage more illicit drug use, and no evidence exists to suggest that needle exchange programs lead to increased drug use by exchange clients or in the wider community.

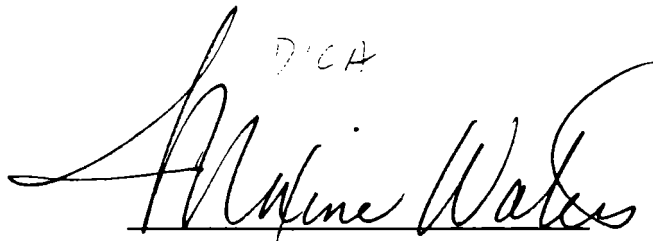
Needle exchange programs not only save lives, but they save money. A clean syringe costs ten cents. The lifetime cost of treating a person with AIDS totals over \$100,000.

Contrary to popular belief, the American people overwhelmingly support needle exchange programs. In March 1996, the Kaiser Survey on Americans and AIDS/HIV found that 66% favored making clean needles available to intravenous drug users. The public is ready to see community-based needle exchange added as a weapon in our AIDS-fighting arsenal.

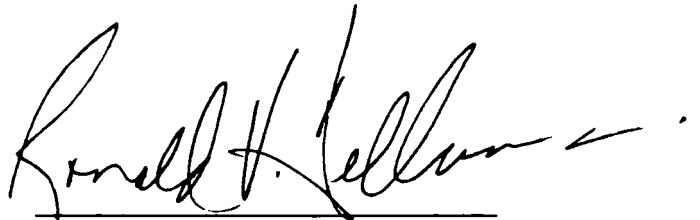
We hope, Mr. President, that you will continue your leadership on this issue, and lift the ban on federal funding of needle exchange programs. We in Congress are looking forward to supporting you in this effort.

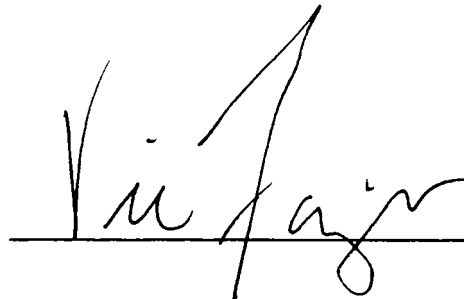

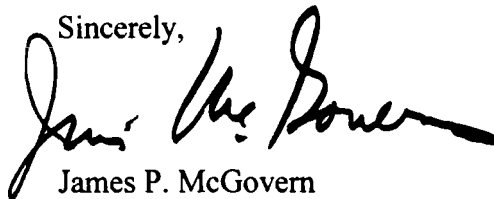

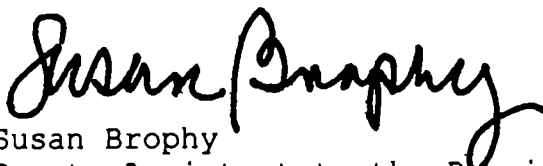

Mrs Clinton:

I need your help in raising the level of awareness on a very crucial issue.

On May 11, 1998, the Congressional Black Caucus (CBC) in Washington, DC called for a STATE OF EMERGENCY concerning HIV/AIDS and the African American population. The CBC has also asked Secretary of Health and Human Services, Donna Shalala and our President William Clinton to call for a NATIONAL STATE OF EMERGENCY. To date there has been limited press and no action on the administration's part.

According to the Kaiser family Foundation, blacks now represent 35 percent of all reported cases and 43 percent of all new cases of HIV/AIDS, even though blacks make up only 12 percent of the US population. The annual AIDS case rate for Black men is 6 times that of white men and for Black women it is 16 times that of white women.

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has reported that based on recent estimates, the nation can expect 4 people to become infected each hour with the virus that causes AIDS and at least 2 of them will be African American. What's more, AIDS is attacking our families: Black women account for 56 percent of the total number of women reported with AIDS and even more alarming, 58 percent of the Pediatric AIDS cases are African American children.

35% of all AIDS cases are among people between the age of 12 to 24 and over 63% of those reported are among the African American and Hispanic populations. One out of four people infected with HIV is a teenager, and even more alarming, one teenager is infected every hour; that's 24 teens a day, 365 days a year.

I know that you are a believer in the village concept, but children are not the only ones who make up the village- adults do too. I am doing my part daily through education and support, please help to see that those who are charged with the task of monitoring the nation's health do so. Thank you for your assistance.
