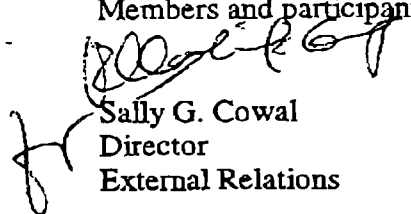

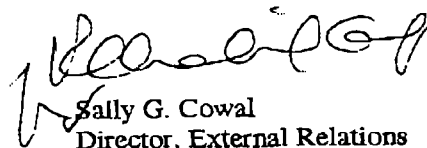
Dear Ambassador Shelton-Colby,

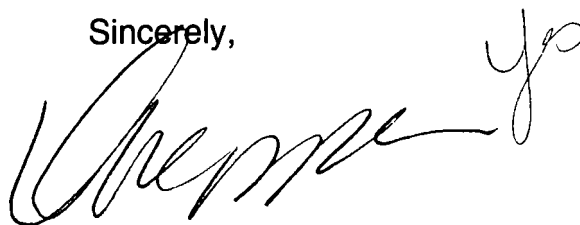
Dear Sandy:

## Mission Statement

*Jerusalem House is a warm, caring home for homeless people with AIDS  
that allows them to retain their independence and dignity.*

## AIDS & Homelessness

- ✦ On an average night in Atlanta, there are 11,500 homeless men, women and children. An estimated 9% of the area's total homeless population is HIV-infected and 4% has AIDS.
- ✦ Approximately 75% of all male, 54% of all female and 50% of all children with AIDS in Georgia live in the metro Atlanta region.
- ✦ People infected through heterosexual contact are the fastest growing group infected with AIDS.
- ✦ Throughout the world women are being infected with HIV at a rate four times higher than men. In Georgia, AIDS is the leading cause of death among African Americans ages 20-44.
- ✦ Four of five Georgia women who are reported as living with AIDS are of childbearing age. If an infected woman becomes pregnant, there is a one in five chance that her baby will be infected with HIV during pregnancy or delivery.

## Jerusalem House Responds

- ✦ In 1988, Jerusalem House was the first organization in the state to offer permanent housing to men and women with AIDS who would otherwise be homeless. The agency currently provides 23 efficiency apartments with support services for men and women with AIDS. This year we will meet another unmet but desperate need by opening a second home, one which will offer a place where homeless mothers with AIDS and their children can create a secure home and live together as a family.
- ✦ To avoid the unnecessary duplication of services, Jerusalem House works in collaboration with more than 27 local organizations to provide a variety of support services for our residents. With these partnerships, and with the support of volunteers and staff, residents can access vital services like substance abuse recovery programs, legal counseling, meals, mental health counseling, transportation and social activities.
- ✦ Jerusalem House is fortunate to receive funding from a variety of sources, including government agencies, corporations, employee giving programs, foundations, religious organizations, special event proceeds and generous individuals.



## JERUSALEM HOUSE

*A Caring Home for People with AIDS*

### **Background: Jerusalem House, Yesterday and Today**

In 1988, a remarkable coalition of community leaders emerged in response to a growing number of people struggling with the dual crises of AIDS and homelessness. This group, a blend of Atlanta's business, religious, civic and medical communities, decided to proactively address the situation.

Their efforts resulted in Jerusalem House: a warm, caring home for homeless people with AIDS that allows them to retain their independence and dignity. In October 1989, Jerusalem House began providing a home with support services for six men and women. Today, a renovated and expanded facility serves 23 residents at a time.

In 1994, Jerusalem House elected to extend its program to others with dire need for housing. After a year of evaluation and groundwork, the board of directors voted to open a second facility, this one devoted entirely to homeless single women with AIDS and their children. Known as "The Family Program," it is a place where a mother and her children can create a secure home and live together as a family.

The new home opened in October, 1997, and is located in a residential neighborhood with easy access to the grocery store, drug store, public transportation, and medical facilities. The property includes 2.35 acres and three buildings containing 28,470 square feet of space. It is a safe, secure environment for residents and volunteers.

The campus is designed to serve two purposes. First, residents have the privacy of their own homes in which to carry on their lives, and a place to which they can retreat if their illness becomes overwhelming. Second, common areas offer spaces and activities for residents where they can support each other through times both good and bad. The common areas and programmatic aspects of the site will also address the needs of the special population. These areas include an indoor recreational space, a playground, and an interactive learning center, as well as space for support groups and meetings.

The first building consists of six (6) three-bedroom apartments, five (5) two-bedroom apartments and one (1) one-bedroom apartment. The second building houses the Stephanie Blank Activity Center and a learning center used for educational and recreational activities. Volunteer and group activities take place in the Candler House, the third building.

During research for the new program, focus group participants told us that they were concerned about both their physical and emotional safety. So these issues were considered in the program and facilities design. We wanted to ensure that the mothers and children living there do, indeed, feel safe and can focus on becoming healthy and rebuilding their lives, both individually and as a family.

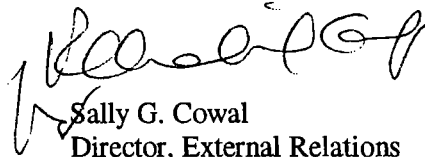

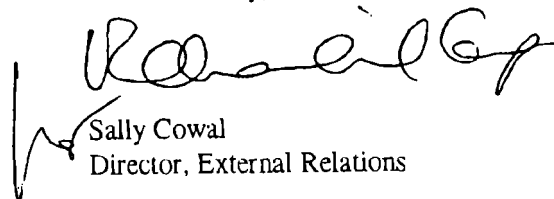

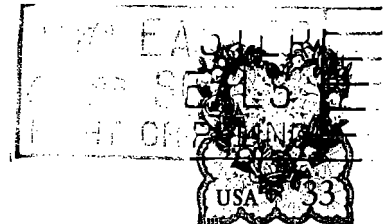

My name is Jeffrey Basinger, and it was a great pleasure to have the opportunity to meet you, and speak briefly, at the Leadership Awards for AIDS Action. You might remember I am one of AIDS Action's newest members of the Board of Directors, and bring Ryan White Title II rural frontier issues to the table. I am very excited, and honored, by this opportunity, as well as challenged by the magnitude of the work ahead of us as we enter the third decade of the pandemic.

I am writing to you as a follow-up on a comment you made, and an invitation to you. When I revealed that I was from Grand Junction, Colorado you stated, having been to Denver several times, that you would like to visit western Colorado. Every autumn Colorado's Governor's Advisory Committee on AIDS meets in Grand Junction in an effort to be truly inclusive and statewide in perspective. It is also a time when the Denver EMA folks discover that there is much more to Colorado than their backyards on the front-range.

I am inviting you to come visit Grand Junction, Colorado during this meeting, which is on Monday, October 4, 1999. I believe it would serve several purposes. It would give you the opportunity to comprehend the Western Colorado AIDS Project's service region (twenty-five counties, 40,000 square miles of mountains, valley, canyons, rivers), and how five staff persons attempt to deliver services. It would give you a very clear idea of our challenges, barriers and gaps. It would also be an opportunity for the three other Title II agencies in Colorado (four total) to have a dialogue with you about national and international issues. It could also be very useful to have your presence to draw attention to the facts about rural HIV/AIDS in communities that are steeped in denial and stigma, still.

Please consider this invitation and opportunity. We would be truly honored, and I believe it would be very beneficial for all concerned parties and individuals. ## WHO IS AT RISK OF GETTING HIV?

People get HIV infection from:

- Having unprotected sexual intercourse with an infected person, male or female.
- Sharing a needle with an injecting drug user who has the virus.
- Mother to child transmission during pregnancy, during birth, or through breast milk.
- Contaminated blood or blood products (blood/blood products have been screened since 1985, making this risk very, very low).



## HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF:

- Avoid sharing body fluids, especially blood, semen, vaginal secretions.
- Prepare yourself before sex, by using latex barriers (male and female condoms, dental dams, gloves, etc.) and water-based lubricants.
- Do not share needles or works if you inject drugs.
- Use universal precautions (latex gloves, bleach) when handling body fluids and secretions.

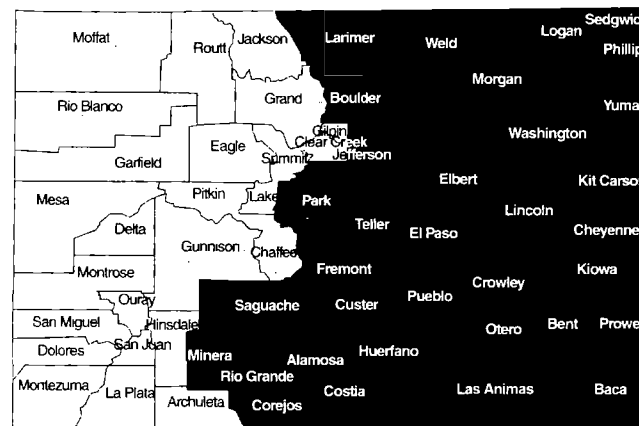

## TO BE TESTED:

1. Call WestCAP's trained staff at 243-AIDS (or 800-765-8594) for information about confidential and/or anonymous test sites.
2. Call the test site and request an appointment. (Just use a first name.)
3. Go to the test site (e.g. county health department) for your appointment.
4. The test counselor should discuss HIV information with you and then draw a blood sample. The blood will be sent to a laboratory.
5. It's important to make an appointment for your test results. (It should take about two weeks. The results will only be given to you in person.)
6. If the test shows that you do not have HIV, contact WestCAP staff to find out how to keep yourself from becoming infected. Do not put yourself at risk again. If your test shows that you do have HIV, contact WestCAP Client Services staff for assistance and support.

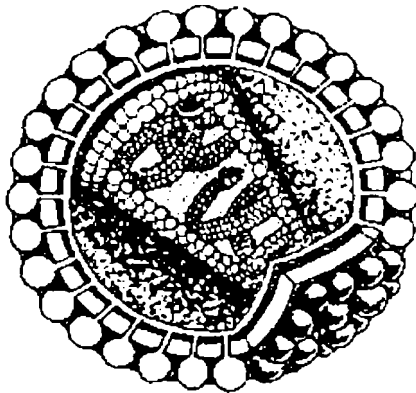

I am writing to request your presence at this year's AIDS Vaccine Day events being held on Tuesday, May 18<sup>th</sup>. The day's events are being sponsored by The Johns Hopkins University Center for Immunization Research (CIR), an international leader in the search for a preventive HIV vaccine since the first candidate HIV vaccines trials began in the mid-1980's.

As a specialist in Infectious Diseases, I have experienced both the trials and the triumphs that have occurred in the HIV treatment arena. In 1996, I shifted my primary focus to prevention and became the CIR Medical Director, as I began to fully understand the challenges inherent to preventive HIV vaccine development. Among the many milestones reached since joining the CIR, we have established a satellite vaccine testing unit at D.C. General Hospital for preventive HIV vaccine research. I am currently the Principal Investigator for VaxGen's Phase I/II study site in Baltimore, and VaxGen's Phase III study site in Washington, D.C. The latter trial is of great interest to the media due to its historic nature as the first large-scale HIV trial in the world, and the one to which you are being invited to support.

Last May, my staff and I collaborated with many others across the country to launch the first AIDS Vaccine Day, commemorating President Clinton's 1997 announcement of the national goal of finding an AIDS vaccine within a decade, where he said: "... It is no longer a question of whether we can develop an AIDS vaccine, it is simply a question of when. And it cannot come a day too soon." The first AIDS Vaccine Day, last May, was an important media/public education event. Governors, mayors of major cities, city councils and your office signed proclamations honoring HIV vaccine volunteers and researchers for their contributions in the fight against AIDS. You have most succinctly stated the fact that: "We'll never end this epidemic unless we have a vaccine."

April 26, 1999

If President Clinton's goal is to become a reality, vaccine development, public awareness and volunteer participation need to be expanded. The primary goals of AIDS Vaccine Day are to educate the public about the potential for preventive HIV vaccines, while encouraging volunteer participation in related clinical trials.

With this in mind, it is a privilege for me and my staff to host this year's National AIDS Vaccine Day event on the 18th of May, 1999 at our D.C. General Hospital vaccine testing unit. You, Senator Kerry, Congresswomen Nancy Pelosi and Eleanor Holmes-Norton, and Congressman Rangel are invited to be present at a Phase III vaccination at 9:00 am, where volunteers from earlier phase trials will also be in attendance. Later that day, we will sponsor a reception on the Hill at 6:30 p.m., at Caffè Italiano, 1129 Pennsylvania Avenue, SE. We are hoping you could join us for at least one of these events.

Dr. Francis, one the founders of VaxGen, the sponsor of the AIDSVAX trial, noted that this media opportunity affords "the perfect opportunity to combine the importance of legislation that provides industry incentives for vaccine research with another essential component of vaccine development: *volunteer participation*."

I very much hope that you will accept the invitation from AIDS Vaccine Day planners to join us at this year's event honoring vaccine recipients. Your participation will bring this worthy cause to a new and necessary level. If I can be of any assistance in your acceptance of this invitation, please feel free to call me or my Project Director, Margaret McCluskey, RN, MPH at 202-675-7677.
