Through a team of two nurses, two social workers, and an HIV/AIDS physician specialist, we provide medical and psychosocial case management for people with HIV/AIDS and direct medical care through an outpatient clinic. Through two contracts with the State of California, Department of Health Services; Ryan White HIV CARE consortium funds; and a great deal of successful fundraising, we are able to provide services in both English and Spanish to anyone who is HIV+ at no charge.

I called your office and left a message with your secretary Cheryl Bowerly. Cheryl returned my telephone call and informed me you are in New York today. I would like to extend an invitation for you to attend and participate in the Monmouth/Ocean HIV/AIDS Consortium, funded by Ryan White Title II any time your schedule would permit.

We meet from 1:00PM to 3:00PM the second Friday of each month, (except September 1999, we are meeting on the third Friday in the morning). A copy of a typical agenda is enclosed. Part of our regular agenda is to educate our membership about an ethnic group or sexual orientation struggling with the HIV/AIDS virus. Typically we have a speaker or speakers address the consortia about issue(s) relating to improved service and cultural sensitivity issues for service providers to be aware of in discussing treatment options for the population being discussed. We usually allocate thirty minutes for this discussion. We are struggling with the mandate to diversify the consortium and our ongoing diversity training is part of our learning and reaching out efforts. We review the operations/service delivery of the subgrantees and report on the standing committees.

We would welcome the opportunity to have you participate at our meeting. We are very proud of the network of providers that have become consortia members. We have worked diligently to bring all of the players to the table and we continue to reach out to clients and providers.

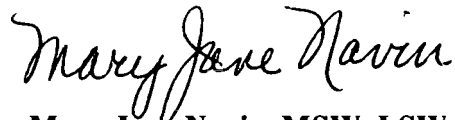

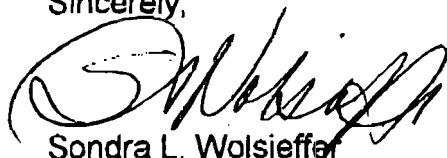

Geneticist David Suzuki states that it is bad science to conclude from a research which found differences in the brains of gay and straight men that homosexuality is genetically determined. What the research has shown is that there is a correlation, but that does not mean that there is a genetic cause.

Dr. Suzuki gives the following as an example: "Suppose you and I decide to do an experiment. We autopsy all people who die of lung cancer. And we discover that 90 percent of them have teeth and fingers that are stained yellow. Now that is a correlation. It would be absolutely wrong to conclude that stained yellow teeth and fingers cause lung cancer.

God loves us and wants what is best for us. Just as a loving parent will not let his child have his own way if he wants to play on a busy street because of the danger of getting killed, God has said no to certain desires, among them homosexuality. It is easy to be permissive, but permissiveness reaps bitter fruits such as disease and death. We would be wise to follow the advice of Moses: "Observe the commands of the Lord your God, walking in His ways and revering Him."

Male bodies were not designed to have sex with males. Some heed a manufacturer's warning not to use a certain type of fuel in their cars, but they disregard the loving Creator's warning not to engage in homosexuality.

Please tell gays that they can be liberated from harmful practices. With God all things are possible. "He sent his own Son in a human body like ours - ancient that ours are sinful - and destroyed sin's control over us by giving himself as a sacrifice for our sins. So now we can obey God's laws if we follow after the Holy Spirit and no longer obey the old nature within us."

A former gay writes as follows:

He filled the void, and cleansed my soul. All I wanted to do was shout "Glory!" It was real. The joy that filled my heart that night I cannot describe. . . The next day I went out and bought my first Bible. Within a few months I had literally worn it out. . .

Satan fights me daily, but God's love and mercy never cease. He walks with me daily; He never leaves me to fight alone, and together we will win the battle. Life for me now is right. I have a beautiful wife, an adorable young daughter, and another child coming soon.

The universe operates like a precision instrument; the air we breathe has the exact composition to sustain life; and the earth has topsoil without which nothing would grow.

The noted chemist, Dr. Edwin E. Slosson, stated, "The greatest miracle of the Bible is its chemical accuracy! The book of Genesis says that man was made out of the dust of the earth, and this is literally and scientifically true. The ground in the vicinity of the place where life began in the garden of Eden consists of 16 different chemical elements, all of which are found in the body of man. Now how could Moses, Job, and later the psalmist have known this? (See Genesis 2:7, Job 4:19, and Psalm 103:14) Yet long ages before the science of chemistry was born, this truth was declared to be fact. Only God could have inspired the writers to make such accurate statements."

"As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those that fear him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust." (Psalm 103:13,14)

"We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand." (Isaiah 64:8)
"...who live in houses of clay, whose foundations are in the dust..." (Job 4:17-19)

Chemists have discovered that after cremation, the human body's dust contains the same 16 different chemical elements as the dust of the ground. This is significant because there are over 100 chemical elements known to science, but 16 of them are found in man and in dust. "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground..." (Genesis 2:7)

Claims that certain clays selectively absorb the amino acids found in proteins and that certain clays will selectively absorb L-amino acids have been refuted. A University of Maryland team headed by Dr. Ponnamperna have shown that clay does not selectively absorb protein amino acids, and there is no selection of the L- or the D- forms. Marvin Moore raises this question, "If proteins cannot be made without nucleic acids, yet nucleic acids are themselves dependent on other proteins for their own existence, where did the first nucleic acid or protein come from to start the cycle?"

Data from computer analysis of "cytochrome C" also offer no support for the evolutionary theory. Dr. Michael Denton notes, "The only way to save evolution in the face of these discoveries is to make the ad hoc assumption that the degree of biochemical isolation of the major groups was far less in the past... There is, however, absolutely no objective evidence that this assumption is correct." Dr. Colin Patterson asserts that if only the data of molecular homology were considered, then descent from common ancestry, the foundational concept of evolution, was "precisely falsified."

Dr. A. I. Oparin pointed out that the complexity of proteins made their spontaneous formation unlikely. He stated, "To the student of protein structure, the formation of such an atomic arrangement in the protein molecule would seem as improbable as would the accidental origin of Virgil's 'Aeneid' from scattered letter type."

Space is not new to Bible which declared millenniums ago, "He stretcheth out the north over the empty place and hangeth the earth upon nothing." (Job 26:7) Professor Lewis of Yale said, "By using the largest telescope in the Naval Observatory at Washington, man sees a great vacuum which corresponds to the empty space of which Job wrote. This has been discovered in the depths of the northern heavens."

"Behold even to the moon, and it shineth not..." (Job 25:5) -- verified by scientists

God poses this question to Job, "Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades? (now known as 'The Seven Stars') in Job 38:31. Astronomers tell us that Alcyon, the brightest of these seven stars, is the pivot around which our sun with all its attendant planets is thought to revolve.

"Canst thou guide Arcturus with his sons?" (Job 38:32) Astronomers refer to Arcturus as the "run-away star". It is a Constellation of 89 stars.

Scientists tell us that light is weak. Job 38:7 states, "The morning stars sang together..."

Recently scientists have pointed out that there is fire somewhere about twenty-five to fifty miles below the earth's crust. God had revealed this to Job: "As for the earth, out of it cometh bread; and under it is turned up as it were fire." (Job 28:5)

Dr. Laurence M. Gould indicates that the recent finding of a reptile skull near the South Pole strongly supports the theory that most of the Southern Hemisphere was once a single land mass that broke up and drifted into sections. In Genesis 10:23 it is written, "And unto Eber were born two sons, the name of one was Peleg (Division) for in his days was the earth divided."

Scientists inform us that the amount of water on the earth could not be noticeably altered without destroying life. Job 28:25 states, "He weigheth the waters by measure."

Recently with modern equipment, it was discovered that there are springs in the bottom of the ocean. God inquires of Job, "Hast thou entered into the springs of the sea?" (Job 38:16)

The Biblical statement "circle of the earth" (Isaiah 40:22) may seem to be in conflict with the "four corners of the earth" expression in the Bible, but scientists have proved that both are correct. Researchers at Johns Hopkins University reported that a series of military satellites have detected the "corners" in the form of four plateau-like areas "so vast and subtle that they were not observed by ordinary ways of measuring."

"Now the Lord had prepared a great fish to swallow Jonah ..." (Jonah 1:17, In 19:12 Capt. Charles Thompson harpooned a huge mammal which contained a 1500-pound fish that had been devoured whole. Examiners of the catch said that it could have swallowed 20 average-sized men.

"The Walls Came Tumbling Down." (see Joshua 6:20) Archeologist Bryant Wood said that the Biblical narrative of the collapse of the wall and capture of Jericho has "remarkable agreement" with archeological remains. "All Scripture is God-breathed." (2 Timothy 3:16) God revealed His truth to men with suitable abilities and allowed them to write in their styles, but He supervised their minds so that they expressed His truths with infallibility.

The books of the Bible were written in known and written languages and were accepted as God's Word by the people of that generation. God never buried His Word in the earth for centuries after He gave it, and He never put it in an unknown language. Time and time again authenticity of the Bible has been vindicated. Critics endeavored to show that the first five books were not written by Moses but were the product of a number of writers and editors over a period of several centuries, but further study and later archeological finds proved them wrong. "Discovery" science magazine reported that archeologists discovered a pair of tiny silver scrolls while digging in a site in Jerusalem. On each of them is an excerpt from the book of Numbers which includes the word Jehovah. These scrolls date back to about 600 B.C. before the exile to Babylon, and earlier than liberal scholars assumed that the Pentateuch had even been written.

God instilled within the human race a sense of eternity. Voltaire in his last hours asked to receive the sacraments of the church. Thomas Paine begged the Savior for mercy on his death bed, and Charles Darwin voiced regret for his evolutionary theory.

"Race" - Not A Valid Idea, Scientists report

There is no such thing as race in genetics. Extensive research by scientists at Stanford, University of Arizona, University of Pennsylvania, and others demonstrates that what we refer to as "race" is skin deep. A wide range of genetic variation was found in African and non-African groups and the variability shows no link to skin color or other superficial traits.

For example, the sickle cell anemia trait which is found in black people has also been found among some southern Europeans but is not found in some South African tribes. Blood types found in black people are also found in lighter-skinned people. Provided the type is compatible, blood transfusions can be given regardless of skin color or other skin-deep traits. Facial characteristics of Asian people have developed over time in response to freezing weather of Siberian populations.

God has endowed all living things with provisions to adjust to circumstances. Without these provisions, adaptability would be impossible. Melanin, the dark pigment in the human skin is actually sepia in color, but when it appears in large masses, it seems black. People who live in tropical areas acquire more melanin, and have darker skin which copes better with the excessive rays of the sun. The flat nose and eyelid skin folds seen in Asians are adaptations to freezing weather of Siberian populations.

The Bible makes it clear that all the people of the world are blood cousins of the same race. "Adam named his wife Eve(living) because she would become the mother of all the living." (Genesis 3:20) Acts 17:24,26 states, "The God who made the world and everything in it... From one man He made every nation of men; that they should inhabit the whole earth."

As the human embryo develops, there are folds in between the the ridges which grow in from the side and develop into parts of the tongue, lower jaw, and neck, but they do not normally break through into the pharynx and therefore cannot be compared to the beginnings of gill slits. A fish from which humans were supposed to have evolved was found off the African coast. The coccyx in the human embryo does not have its own nerves, muscles, and blood supply like a tail. It is simply the end of the backbone which projects due to differing rates of growth.

Dr. A. C. Gayton states, "The human body is the most beautifully engineered and the most complicated system there is. It works by means of several hundred patterns of control, each affecting the other. A complete understanding of it can hardly be gained without the help of computers with their ability to handle vast amounts of data. For instance the brain has 10 billion nerve cells to record what you learn. The information travels inside you at speeds of up to 300 miles per hour over a network of nerve fibers 100 thousand miles long!" "I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made." (Psalm 139:14)

God did not create us as robots whose actions He could control. He has given us freedom of choice: we can obey the beneficial commands which God has given us because He loves us or we can ignore them. Humans have polluted the earth literally and ethically, and some want to blame God for all the evil in the world which disobedient humans have bred. God is a God of love and of justice. The statements "eye for eye, tooth for tooth" found in Deuteronomy 19:21 are not a call for personal revenge but to eliminate that practice. Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Moses placed the punishing of transgressors in the hands of judges who had the responsibility to be positively fair - neither too severe nor too lenient. Sin violates the holy nature of God and must be punished. God demonstrated His love for us by sending His one and only Son, Jesus Christ, to take the punishment for our sins.

Study Verifies Star In East

LOS ALAMOS, N.M. (UPI) — An astrochemist researcher says computer analysis shows a series of "celestial happenings" almost 2,000 years ago could have created an unusually bright object in the sky about the time the star shone over Bethlehem, signalling Jesus' birth.

Christ was born in Bethlehem as prophesied by Micah (Micah 5:2) of a virgin as foretold by Isaiah (Isaiah 7:14), at the time set by Daniel (Daniel 9:25). Jeremiah foretold the massacre of infants in Bethlehem (Jeremiah 31:15). Hosea prophesied that Jesus would go down to Egypt and return from there (Hosea 11:1). His ministry in Galilee was foretold by Isaiah (Isaiah 9:1,2). Zechariah foresaw Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem riding upon a colt (Zechariah 9:9). His betrayal for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:12), and the return of the money for the purchase of a potter's field (Zechariah 11:13) David describes the crucifixion of Christ in Psalm 22, and Isaiah foretells His rejection and substitutionary death: "He was despised and rejected by men ... Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all." (Isaiah 53:3-6)

The Old Testament and the New Testament make known that there is one God, and that He has eternally existed in three co-equal Persons. "From the time that it was, there am I; and now the Lord God and his Spirit hath sent me." (Isaiah 48:16) "But thou, Bethlehem, ... out of thee shall he come forth ... whose goings forth have been ... from everlasting." (Micah 5:2) "to us a son is given ... And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6)

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth." The word translated as "God" in Genesis 1:1 is from the term "Elohim", a plural name for God is used 2570 times in the Old Testament and suggests plurality of Persons within the one God. This plural name for God is used with singular verbs and often side-by-side with singular terms which show that God is one God and not many Gods. Deuteronomy 6:4 proclaims, "The Lord our God is one Lord". The word translated as "one" is "ehad", the same word in the thirteenth chapter of Numbers describing a single cluster of grapes. It is a single cluster, but there is more than one grape in the cluster. "When he prepared the heavens, I was there" (Proverbs 8:27)

In Genesis 1:26 it is written, "Let us make man in our image", indicating plurality of Persons. The very next verse shows that God is not speaking to angels, but to others who are one with Him in essence and form: "So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them." (Genesis 1:27) This verse also makes known that God created man and woman. They didn't evolve via a long evolutionary process.

Hitler was an avid evolutionist and tried to justify his inhuman acts by his pet theory.

The Nazis on occupying new territories would put those who made public commitments to the Bible in Concentration Camps because they knew that such people would not obey the edicts of a godless dictator. Hitler tried to make the practice of Germany conform to the theory of evolution. He spoke of "lower human types", and he used the German word for evolution frequently in his book "Mein Kampf". Sir Arthur Keith stated, "The leader of Germany is an evolutionist not only in theory, but, as millions know to their cost, in the rigor of its practice."

Evolutionists cannot prove that matter is eternal. They accept this belief by faith. Dr. Colin Patterson addressed a group of scientists with this question: "Can you tell me anything you know about evolution, any one thing, any one thing that is true?" All he received in reply was silence. Patterson, a world renowned paleontologist, said that he woke up and realized that all his life he had been duped into taking evolutionism as revealed truth in some way.

Physicist Wolfgang Smith states, "... the doctrine of evolution has swept the world not on the strength of its scientific merits ... It affirms, in effect that living beings created themselves. which is, in essence, a metaphysical doctrine decked in scientific garb."

Einstein declared, "Everyone who is seriously interested in the pursuit of science becomes convinced that a spirit is manifest in the laws of the Universe - a spirit vastly superior to that of man, and one in the face of which we with our modest powers must feel humble."

Astronomers have discovered that the sun with the entire solar system moves through space in a gigantic orbit. Since this fact was not known in the days of Galileo, his accusers thought that the Bible supported Aristotle's theory that the sun revolves around the earth. The Bible said all along that the earth rotates on its axis and revolves around the sun: "that it (the sun) might take the earth by the edges ... The earth takes shape like clay under a seal: its features stand out like that of a garment." (Job 38: 13, 14)

Dr. John F. Mac Arthur writes, This is in reference to the small clay cylinders anciently used for writing. Archeologists have found these in Mesopotamia and other countries. Before these small cylinders were baked, a small thin rod like a pencil was put through each lengthwise, and then they were rotated while still soft with this rod as an axis to receive the impression from the seals. This is how the earth turns, says the Lord through Job. In other words, it turns on an axis. As the Babylonian cylindrical seals were rolled over the clay, they left the impress of artistic beauty. So, as the earth revolves, it brings each portion of its surface to the sun's light like the gradual unveiling of a beautiful garment. This is a clear declaration that the earth is heliocentric... that the earth rotates on its axis and revolves around the sun"

Everything moves with such clock-like precision that it couldn't just have happened. For instance, if the speed of the earth around the sun on its orbit were increased or decreased, life on our planet would be impossible.

Sir Isaac Newton made an exact replica of our solar system in miniature. A large golden ball in the center represented the sun, and smaller spheres attached at the ends of rods of varying lengths revolved around the sun. An atheistic friend exclaimed, "My, Newton, what an exquisite thing! Who made it for you?" "Nobody!" replied Sir Isaac. "All of these balls and cogs and belts and gears just happened to come together, and wonder of wonders, by chance they began revolving in their set orbits and with perfect timing."

A new study presented in the British journal "Nature" found that galaxies are clumped in a regular pattern over a vast scale. The study was conducted by David Koo of UC Santa Cruz, Alexander Szalay of Johns Hopkins University, and researchers in England. Dr. Koo said, "To find the regularity is just mind-boggling!" "The heavens declare the glory of God, the skies proclaim the the works of his hands." (Psalm 19:1)

Robert Jastrow states, "...The astronomical evidence leads to a Biblical view of the origin of the world."

The discoveries on radiohalos by Robert Gentry suggest a rapid creation of the earth's primordial crust.

Dr. Thomas G. Barnes states, There is nothing more devastating to the doctrine of evolution than the scientific evidence of a young earth age. That evidence is provided by the rapid depletion of the energy in the earth's electromagnetic dipole magnet. The rate of energy consumption is now known, and it can be shown that the magnetic age of the earth is limited to merely thousands of years." Dr. Barnes describes the big bang theory as an inversion of logic: "an explosion ... produces disorder." In harmonizing a young universe with the distances of the outer galaxies, Dr. Richard Miesner points out that God created a fully functional universe so that the stars were seen on the very day of their existence which lends the appearance of age. Plants were bearing fruit; and fish, birds, animals, and humans were created fully mature.

Charles Darwin said that the origin of flowering plants was an abominable mystery". Fossils demonstrate that life appeared suddenly and existed in large areas of the earth at the same time in great complexity. Many kinds of plants and animals are living today, including the one-celled organisms with which evolution supposedly began.

The belief that evolution is a universal law of increasing complexity is not in harmony with the Second Law of Thermodynamics.

Dr. Sidney Harris states, "There is a factor called "entropy" in physics, indicating that the whole universe of matter is running down and ultimately will reduce itself to uniform chaos. This follows from the Second Law of Thermodynamics which seems about as basic and unquestionable to modern scientific minds as any truth can be ... How can the forces of biological development and the forces of physical degeneration be operating at cross purposes?"

A few theorists have offered an explanation, but after reviewing their paper, evolutionist Roger Lewin calls their speculations "heuristic formulations." He points out that even Ilya Prigogine was mystified by the concept that evolution is inevitably produced in a biosphere increasing in entropy, through the mechanisms suggested by Prigogine's non-equilibrium thermodynamics. Prigogine said, "I see how you can do this with molecules, but I don't see how you can do it with species. I don't understand the extrapolation."

Having a clearer knowledge of the behavior of the atom, scientists are theorizing that creation may have been brought about as described in the Bible instead of gradually as some have supposed in the past.

The scholars inform us that whenever the word "day" with a number before it appears in the Old Testament it means a 24 hour day and further emphasis is made in Genesis 1 by the use of "evening and morning". "And God saw everything that he had made, and behold it was very good. And the evening and morning were the sixth day." (Genesis 1:31)

Scientists agree that there was a great flood around 4000 B.C.. Archeologists have dug up cuneiform tablets which tell the tale of a man who survived by building a vessel. Meir Beh-Uri, a foremost designer, has reconstructed the design of Noah's ark following God's instructions to Noah. The design could easily accommodate three decks and provide a capacity for at least 1,000 pairs of animals. Ben-Uri asserts that the Genesis accounts are facts and states, "It is up to us to unravel its secrets." Of like conviction were Newton, Pasteur, Pascal, Faraday, Herschel, Kelvin, and Slosson. Herschel said, "All of human discovery seems to be made for the purpose of confirming the truths that come from on high."

During the 17th and 18th centuries, the majority explanation for the sedimentary rocks and their fossilized contents was that they had been laid down in the great flood of Noah's time. This was the belief of brilliant geologists such as Steno, the father of stratigraphy, and John Woodward whose studies on sedimentary processes laid the foundation for modern sedimentology and geomorphology. The concept that fossils in sedimentary rocks were formed by a great number of local catastrophes scattered through many ages was promoted by amateurs in the field of geology and has no scientific support. The actual facts of geology favor the great flood. Each stratum represents a uniform set of water flow conditions, and such uniformity does not remain very long. Each set of strata in a given formation must have been deposited in rapid succession or there would be many unconformities. No unconformity is world-wide, and such formations invariably grade laterally into other formations.

The actual facts of geology favor catastrophism. Keith Moxon points out that it must have taken a large amount of water running very swiftly to make the huge formations of stalagmites and stalactites found in caves. Tiny drips cannot make huge formations; they make small spindly formations. The ground was fully saturated for a long time after Noah's flood causing fast drippings in the caves. Flood geology can account for the presence of porphyrin in crude oil. Geologist Mc Queen states that catastrophic sedimentation rate would "uproot, kill, and bury organic material so rapidly as to cut the porphyrin off from oxidizing agents which would destroy them in the ocean water."

Hsu of the Geological Institute at Zurich feels that Darwin misunderstood geology. He suggests, "It is time we cry, 'The emperor has no clothes!'"

Experts agree that there is no reliable method of dating rocks and fossils beyond 5,000 years. Modern techniques which date beyond 5,000 years are based on assumptions. Land plants which produce pollen were supposed to have evolved millions of years after Cambrian rocks were formed, but fossilized pollen grains have been discovered in Cambrian rocks. The belief that the Lingula had been extinct about 400 million years was shattered by the discovery of living specimens of Lingula. The presence today of simple forms of life such as the protosoa does not indicate evolution.

Fossils of simple marine invertebrate animals are usually found at the lowest elevations in the geologic strata because they live at the lowest elevations. Likewise, fossils of birds and animals are found at the higher elevations because they live at higher elevations, and they are more mobile.

Gordon L. Ginn states that it cannot be proven that one species is older than the other. The claim that the grasshopper and bee evolved later than the earthworm because of their general structure is not valid: the earthworm has a closed vascular system while the grasshopper and bee have open vascular systems. Human footprints are found in the same rock with dinosaur tracks.

Biologist Cora Reno states that in accordance with evolution, there should be fewer chromosomes in the simple organisms and more as we ascend the plant and animal scale, but such is not the case. A bracken fern has 64 chromosomes, a crayfish has 208, a horse has 60, and humans have 46. Each species has a fixed number of chromosomes. If evolutionary claims were true, there should be hundreds of connective links among the fossils, but even the oldest fossils are easily recognized. A thorough examination has shown the Archaeopteryx to be a bird, having fully developed feathers and other characteristics of birds with no reptile-like connection. "All flesh is not the same: Men have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another, and fish another." (1 Cor. 15:39) This Biblical statement has been verified. Science has become aware of the cytoplasm and nuclei of the cells which distinguish the four kinds of flesh.

The expression "after its kind" is repeated ten times in the first chapter of Genesis. Physician M. R. De Haan stated that this God-given rule is an unsurmountable barrier against all the theories of evolution. Even if in rare cases two very closely related species have had an offspring as in the case of a donkey and mare producing a mule, the offspring is always sterile.

Adaptations to alternate circumstances cannot support the belief that all living things came from one original cell. Mutations are confined within a species and are usually harmful. Without the help of man, the ancon ram, the hornless cattle, and the seedless orange would be extinct.

Pictures showing man developing from apelike faces and forms are purely imaginary. The Heidelberg man was reconstructed from one lower jaw. Dr. J. S. Weiner and others revealed that the lower jaw and the canine tooth of the Piltdown man, declared by evolutionists to be from 100,000 to 500,000 years old, belonged to a modern anthropoid ape. A stain gave them that fossilized look. R. H. Tuttle said that his study of comparative anatomy has shown that all great apes have long, curved fingers and weak thumbs. Man shows no signs of having ever possessed these peculiarities that are helpful for living in trees. Man's unique arms and elbows enable him to use the tools of his technology.

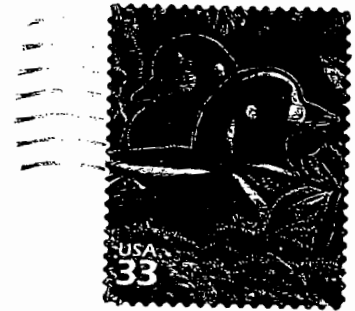

Dr. John W. Oller reasons that if human discourse requires intelligence, how much more must the library of genetic texts that give man this capacity require an intelligent Creator?

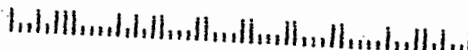

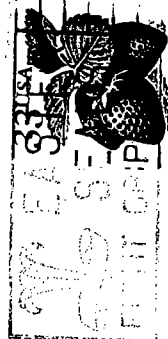

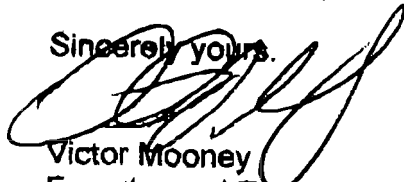

I am married, the father of four children ranging in ages from 6 to 16. I, nor my wife, have been touched personally by this plague. But, as citizens of the world, my wife and I, as writer-producers, feel it a part of our civic duty to make this world a better place for the existing and upcoming generations. To do so, the "Right Thing" must also become the "latest FAD" in order to succeed. We approach AIDS not on the defense, but **ON THE OFFENSE**—taking the fear from the unknown—empowering each and every person with the strength that can only come through **KNOWLEDGE**.

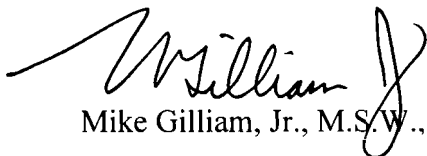

Dear Ms. Thurman:

I am the Director of a special care facility in Corpus Christi, Texas. We are licensed by the State of Texas Department of Health to provide residential, end-stage care to those who are dying from AIDS. This facility opened in 1991, and has a capacity to take care of 7 residents at a time. Since the opening, we have had 111 people die in this facility.

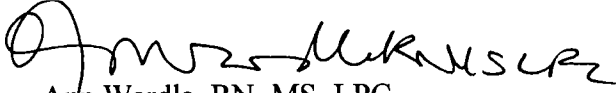
We have seen the statistics change radically. In 1995, the most deaths occurred, with the average stay being 1.57 months. Today, the average stay is 6 months, and the longest stay in the past year was 10 months prior to their death. We attribute this to the fact that the new medications do, in fact allow people to live longer, and possibly better, to some extent. However, we sincerely believe that we are beginning to see what was recently predicted in an article in the March edition of Esquire magazine - - the worst is yet to come. The medications will fail, or the body will be unable to tolerate the doses. The outcome of this disease remains death.

We are trying to prepare for the future, but more importantly, we are trying to survive the funding cuts and reductions in donations and contributions that are a direct result of people thinking the problem is over, and that agencies like ours are no longer needed. We have written so many grant requests that have not been funded, and made so many appeals, only to be told "we thought the new medicines were making things better - - are you (the organization) still needed?"

We truly believe that the worst is yet to come, and that it may likely be very close at hand. However, we grow weary in our attempt to raise the much needed funds just to keep the doors open, and to provide basic services. Planning for any additional, or expanded services will just have to wait.

If you know of any funding sources which provide operating expenses, please advise us of the name and address. We often send copies of the article in the USA Weekend Magazine, and quote your statement, "complacency could kill us." It certainly may kill our ability to continue to operate. Thank you for your commitment. It inspires us to keep trying.

Dear Ms. Thurman,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Diana, Princess of Wales, Mohau Children's Care Centre, which you visited on your swing through Pretoria, South Africa, some months ago. I am sure you were impressed, as I was on my first visit to the Centre, by the spirit of hope that filled the building. That spirit is evident in the bright and cheerful wall paintings of the ward rooms, in the lovely donated furnishings, and in the tremendous support of local and expatriate volunteers, who help Mohau provide for its desperately ill and orphaned and abandoned AIDS children.

As you may recall, beyond the children in the Centre, Mohau (which means *mercy* in the South African language of Sotho) and its parent organization, KERUX, also have provided relief for thousands of other South African AIDS victims and their families. The assistance has included job creation and training, legal advice and human rights services, help with medical expenses, emotional and spiritual counseling, educational aid, donations of food and clothing, and much more.

Unfortunately, the truth behind the splash of colors and good intentions is that Mohau is struggling to keep open its doors.

The Gauteng (Provincial) Department of Welfare is months behind in its promised support of subsidies, particularly for the 22 orphaned and abandoned children who find haven inside Mohau. The department has informed Mohau that no more support will be arriving until the beginning of next year – if at all – due to the South African government's troubled financial state.

The result is that while Mohau has the resources to pay its Children's Home bills (housekeeping expenses, food, and salaries) through October, it will not have the money to continue beyond the end of that month. The shortfall derived from the lack of promised government support for the months of November and December totals R100,000, or about \$20,000.

Charitable donations have helped in the past to bridge the gap between the operating needs of the center and what the government has been unable to deliver. At this time, however, Mohau also is struggling with a shortage of nurses, as the South African government has been forced for financial reasons to cut back on its nursing staff at neighboring Kalafong Hospital.

The good works of the Mohau Centre and its people inspired me to form Mohau Children's Charities for South Africa, Inc. Our organization is working to deliver the news of the AIDS crisis to the American people and to bring financial support to South African AIDS and children's organizations, such as Mohau. At this point, we have become incorporated in the state of Connecticut, but are just in the process of filing for IRS 501(c) (3) status. This puts us in the difficult position of looking for immediate help when we cannot yet promise that donations to our organization will be tax-deductible.

I am writing in the hope that you can provide suggestions of where we may turn for short-term financial support, as well as more long-term solutions. In your position as Director of the White House Office of National AIDS Policy, perhaps you might know of another like-minded nonprofit, a foundation, a government department, or a corporation also interested in helping to bring immediate relief to South African children who suffer with AIDS.

I appreciate that you must receive many letters of this nature, as the AIDS pandemic is vast. Nevertheless, I speak for the Mohau Centre's Project Manager, Rev. Barry-Hughes Gibbs, when I thank you in advance for considering our urgent needs. We pray that you may be able to help us keep Mohau's spirit of hope alive.

Dear Ms. Thurman.

I had the pleasure of meeting and speaking with you here in Denver at a fundraiser for a documentary about the situation of AIDs in South Africa. For me it was a rather glamorous affair with Miss America there yourself and Kelly's Uncle.

I have been attending school for Multi-Media and have the skills needed to supply the graphic arts for the documentary and Kelly and I seem to have kindred spirits so I will continue on with this goal of supplying the films titles and various graphics needed for the final production of the work.

Several years ago the First Lady did me a huge favor.

I had been awarded disability for having aquired AIDs in the Marine Corps and when first awarded i was rated at 30%. I knew immediately that my life was affected much more than that rating and I had only one place to turn as the matters of this machination is out of my hands and knowledge.

I was living in Los Angeles and had within a few months of the award spoken at a fund raiser with the First Lady and a bevy of singing and film stars. It was the second time that a client of AIDs Project Los Angeles had been a part of a fund raiser and I was honestly honored.

I wrote Mrs. Clinton and asked that she grant me the favor of inquiring into the rating system that I had been subjected to.

Within a very short time with a phone call The First Lady had doubled the disability and I was again honored and very thankful for the attention.

It has been many years since that last evaluation of my situation and I know that it is time to reevaluate the percentage.

My mental health is at an all time low having discovered over a year ago that my attitude mirrored those of men who had gone through the Viet Nam war.

Of course my physical status has also suffered over the years and I am dissapointed to say that part of that deterioration has to do implicitly with me and my attitude toward living with AIDs in America.

I am tremendously lucky to have lived as long as I have with only a coma that in itself was life awakening and also life frightening. When one knows that in a twelve hour period of sleep they might slip into a coma with no warning other than crossed eyes a persons outlook is naturally changed regarding life.

I know nothing about the powers that be regarding ratings of disability and the V.A..

That is why I have asked for your help in this matter as the V.A. takes a year to get the process completed and to my knowledge that means that it might be two years.

In a situation such as my own two years is incomprehensible. My confidence in the workings of America is based completely on faith. My faith in William Jefferson Clinton the President of the United States is unshakable.

I have for years thought in the moment after years of prayer to do so. Unfortunately I am unable to break that way of thinking that does not necessarily fit in with the new drug

protocols.

I have for six months now sought out the help of a psychiatrist here in Denver at the V.A. hospital a Doctor Espy as well as one of the most charming women that I have ever met a Jane DiBurro who while volunteering at the hospital I had done data entry for her homeless program V.A.S.H. I was aware that she had moved to head up acute psychology and I knew that she was the person that I wanted to speak to as she worked specifically with men who were dealing with the residue of their service in various parts of the military.

I do believe that I have a personal outlook on disability that is unique as my Mother has been severely disabled since I was eleven and growing up in Pueblo Colorado. It took me a very long time to see beyond the wheel chair and I believe that I have done as well as one might.

Unfortunately my Mom is still dealing with trying to assimilate my disability that is AIDs. She tells the people who live in her retirement home that I have had a head injury. That is not entirely untrue in that my coma left me with scars on my brain. It though too reminds me that I used to say that she had a car accident rather than a cerebral hemorrhage.

I know that I am disabled to a degree that has now surmounted the percentage that I now am entitled to.

The money is an aside as I have since the First Ladies phone call been elevated to a financial status that had actually made my life much more complicated and causes me great distress in that I carry two mortgages and have a huge desire to leave Denver and either go to New York where you do not have to have a car or go to Palm Springs where a dear friend has had to become executor of his Fathers estate and has the rare gift of giving not of the penny but of the spirit.

i have given myself a year to leave here as it has been a horror story since I got here.

I have met no-one except for Kelly and her family that I jelled with. I am sure that a great part of that is my disability and how it makes me view inter personal relationships. It is very difficult for me to conceive of establishing any relationships when I truly have no idea what is going to take me down. As we both know it will not be AIDs that down this human that is me but any one of a thousand thousand virus's that exist in our World. When the new drugs came out that keep me in stasis i realized that I had lost my ability to form interpersonal relationships so I went the AIDs project here in Denver and asked if there might be a way to overcome this fault. I was adopted into a surrogate family of Catholic men and women now called "Rain".

Extraordinarily all of their children had attended Columbine High School and the closest of the "family" to me the Mausers who are closest to my age and are just plain fine people lost their son Daniel to the horror that is Columbine. They are strong people and they are dealing admirably with the atrocity and are thinking of adopting a child from China. We as a "family are all still healing as the number of children in the "Rain" family that attended Columbine is substantial.

When I finally got to the point where I was able to speak of these emotional difficulties it had been six months since I first became aware of the situation. It took me that long to be able to voice my situation to another. Mom went into the hospital about two weeks after for major surgery on her legs to undo arterial blockage and has just this Monday finally returned home from six months of recovery.

I had been attending school by rote as I feel that I must prepare for some future just in case

I left school two weeks before finals because I could not deal with learning about Multi-Media and healing my spirit. My school Red Rocks Community College was more than generous in that they did what is termed a rollover and does not effect my grades. Two weeks later Mom went into the hospital and into surgery causing a delay in my own healing, then Daniel was murdered in his school cafeteria virtually blowing up my support group "Rain".

I would ask for your help with this situation that is out of my hands as I am completely clueless to the workings of the V.A. and such male dominated organizations.

Your help in any way shape or form will be a blessing and I thank you in advance for your kindness.

During one of the periods when Mom was prematurely trying to be home and I was being nurse ratchet, the television informed me of the death of John John and for the second time in my life John F. Kennedy took a peice of my heart to the grave. It seems to me that death follows me like a shadow lover and I do not like this.

For 13 years I have dealt with this anomalous virus that is AIDs. I discovered 6 months ago that for 6 years I have actually been aiding the progress of the virus so that I may no longer have to deal with it. Not by a conscious effort but by an unconscious desire.

I am reduced at this point in time to wearing diapers, an aside to the new pills that are "sustaining" my existence.

My mental and physical status is at a point where I can't see beyond the horizon of the day and rarely attain the attitude that it takes to even deal with the present.

In 1986 when I first got out of the Marine Corps I was living with an old friend in Palm Springs who at that time was managing a hotel there and now is second in command of the St. Regis in N.Y.C..

I will never be able to forget the evening when my dear friend took me out to the complex pool and honestly tried to hold my head under the water.

His frustration was that I seemed to have no desire for life and he just could not understand why I was not attempting something as he was as a Hotel Manager. It made no sense to him that I did not have any drive and thank heaven I had been a life guard in the Corps because I ended the dousing quickly. It was not until I went into a coma that my friend found that I was HIV positive. There had been no need to inform him as we were a platonic relationship. That incident though was the beginning of the end for me as far as spirit. I wanted to achieve as my friend but my psyche would not allow me the leap of faith for from the beginning one was told to accept death as graciously as possible. When dealing with HIV.

Just as I went into the coma figuratively my friend had just returned from NY and had secured a position at the Plaza de Athene. He had to call his Mom in upstate NY to figure out what to do. She of course told him to call an ambulance. He not only had to pack up his stuff but mine and I was left in hospital for 3 months, alone except for a brief visit by my Mother and Brother to more or less say good-bye as I was unable to speak, could not see and had no voluntary movement.

Well I had secured my faith in God several years before and had absolutely no fear as to the out-come of the coma.

I simply held on until I was able to walk and talk and function again to the extreme amazement of my physicians.

I did not loose my faith and have still not but the repeated years of this illness has worn my heart to a hard knot that I can't as of yet seem to untie.

I have heard men speak of being 100 percent disabled in the eyes of the service because their

knees have been injured and my stony heart just flips with anxiety when I compare the two situations.

I have begun the wheels that will reevaluate my percentage of disability. This of course will have most to do with my doctors but I have a great desire to attempt this reevaluation during the term of William Jefferson Clinton, the President of the United States because as a citizen I fear the next term of office.

Pray for me as I enter this evaluation and if you have access to ears that hear please speak. With complete Sincerity,

Gentlesouls.

This is the most difficult letter that i have ever written as it bares the soul that i would not have and brings light to the soul that i must reattain.

About 4 months ago i began work-study here at the Regional Office.under chapter 31 as i am a person living with service connected AIDs, a full time student at Red Rocks Community College, the son of a woman with the blood of the "Real McCoys" as in Hatfields." for the third and final time reread this letter". this is the last hopefully several months later.

It had been a year since i had been to school or more so that i might experiment what a working environment and my unusual headress that are tattoo's, would mean as far as freedom to work without wearing a wig and the reactions that i would garner fromt the experience, i did not return to Voluntary Service and Pastoral Care as it truly is the Pasture.

I was given the job of copying files of soilders for families interested in any more information they might attain about that specific Man or Woman, who had served .

I was a dreadful copy boy as i was constantly getting the papers caught in the machine and having to keep the related papers in order and relatively non-mutilated it was truly a chore.

Well i had dared myself to take a full load at school, acrued as many work hours through the work-study program as i possibly could I thought it might snap me out of whatever was the wrench. I promised myself that i would not read any of the files as I thought it would be creepy and snoopy, not realizing the condition of the majority of the tombs.

Then the enevitable happened, i began to read some of the information that was in these files. It was not something that i did with glee and was actually something that i had been trying to avoid our of respect as when beginning the related job i had never thought that the majority of the people in the files were dead, or that i would be dealing so closely with the histories of the dead.

What struck me most harshly and is the reason for the writing of this letter is the fact the a large majority of the files that i read were written by Soilders and their families about their reaction to life after returning home from Viet-Nam.

I could not at the time piece together all of the feelings that i was feeling reading these letters about the lives of dead people and the fact that their lives were mine, except that i was alive, living, and did not want to become one of the Dead Letter People.

After nearly ten years of just fighting for survival knowing that death was at my door because of my fellow fallen humans i have not been able to make the adjustment to the thought of liviing to live.

there is a vast difference between the struggle to live and the struggle to fight against death.

my daily thoughts are filled with turmoil as that is what comes of this constant struggle where virtually every decision made is weighed against the tolling of the bell, that big black bell that can't be seen yet instinctually hangs over all of our human heads like the Damacles pen knife.

every instinct inside my thinking mind is to live but this struggle for survival against an enemy that is invisible has left that instinct used and heightened to a

degree of Survival/Flight.

the Flight instinct being every bit as strong as the Survival.

thr Flight of course is self deprivation to avoid the fear of the "unbearable lightness of being".

these are the second course of words that i have been able to write in the past 4 or 5 months. these i will save and continue on with as the reality of this situation for me comes to me slowly and with no great ease. instead of going to school and doing a project that i need for Monday of next with the only lab time tommorow i have slept until near the setting of the sun like some sort of creature rather than the human that i am.

this evasion is a part of the deprivation because how can someone who has dealt with the horror of this little virus for so many years actually be allowed into the minds of others as to my mind it would scare them to the bone and flee as have most of the relationships that me has garnered in my 40 odd years of life.

I am a singer. that is all that i could ever really do and that is what i have always wanted to be. I will be if it has to be with wings.

To Whom it may concern.

My name is [REDACTED] (b)(6)

3 days prior to spring break an awakening happened in my consciencenous that has caused me to be unable to continue school at this time.

This awareness is of a condition that I have been keeping from myself for six years and is direct conjunction with a physical condition that has been a part of my life for 11 years. I have been seeking quidance and treatment through the Veterans Administration Hospital in Denver for the last month and a half.

It would never have occured to me to experience this at such a late date in the semester and it has nothing to do with my work in school prior to my

knowledge of this situation that I now find myself in.

I sincerely appreciate the consideration taken to this predicament and hope to resolve the issue as quickly as possible.

It is now 7-7-99

this is my fourth and hopefully last briefing of a letter that is to me a festering that needs to be sent away from me and has been that way from it's conception.

the letter that I presented to Dr. Espy is not in my files but it occurred a few days before Spring Break that I had to write it as it was my first appointment with him.

The gist of the letter was that I had discovered that at my core my will to survive is gone and my will to destruct is foremost.

This is my first attempt at organizing my thoughts regarding this matter. They were presented to a Dr. Espy at the V.A. Hospital here in Denver on this last Monday the 15th of March.

I knew that I was experiencing the same symptoms as those who have been diagnosed with P.T.S.D, post, traumatic, stress, disorder, yet could not understand how that could be and am still not sure that is the correct description.

I was angry, confused, and struck dumb for several months.

I knew that I had found the major answer to my daily dilemma yet could not sit down as I am doing now and write about it.

My journey began with a visit to my old work-study at Voluntary Service and Pastoral Care here at the V.A. Hospital.

My coworkers had gone for the day but I spied a priest who I had worked with in the above mentioned position who had struck me as keen and so I sat down to speak with him about the situation that I was facing and how it was so akin to this Post Trauma label. It turned out that Father Woerth had been working with people with this situation for years and thus began my climb to this point.

When I had decided that I needed to speak with someone about this a Jane Diburro who works in acute psychology was my first choice. I had worked for her while she was working with the V.A.S.H. program for homeless veterans.

I began seeing her about a month ago and just saw the psychiatrist Dr. Espy on Monday.

The reason for seeing Dr. Espy was to discuss the use of some medicine for the brain to get me out of the downward spiraling that is my life.

It is zero dark thirty and although my day was full and i am fed my mind is at turmoil. This is my spring break from school. It is my second semester since my failed attempt at copy-boy. I had to leave after the second week as i could not take any more information about the humans that were recorded in those files. I began work again at the V.A. Hospital for Voluntary Service and Pastoral Care but soon found that i was unable to carry the load at school and sustain in the working environment.

School is a task that is "easy"? for me in that when my mind is made up it takes a rock to fall on my head before i will relinquish that task.

My chosen field of study is multi-media. Three years ago when the new medications came out for AIDs i was so full of vigor that it thrilled me to find this field. It is not defined and still allows me the fantastical ideal of becoming a singer.

Have secured the graphic arts on a documentary about AIDs in South Africa that is being held only by the purse strings as the producers Uncle is the Ambassador to that Country and Sandra Thurman who is the Presidents Chief Council on AIDs has backed the project from the get-go.

You may wonder as i that if my thoughts are so cluttered and mulled how is it that i can accomplish these above mentioned things and still consider myself handicapped. It is clear from inside of this mind.

From the first day that i was told on Okinawa that i had HIV i began a journey of survival. I ran out of oomph about 3 or less years ago 3 or 4 months after the new "Wonder Drugs" were released. sure i can muster when i need to but the chaos that accopanies the payoff is so unimaginable that the only way that i might describe it would be to liken it to a war. It is my belief that this is why when reading those thoughts written by long dead hands that I was made to become aware of my situaiton. I will never compare myself to a soilder who has had to go through the unimaginable horrors of Viet-Nam as i am personally related to two and know another too well to ever compare myself to the strength and courage that had to be attained, maintained and sustained through that battle. Yet i also know that this "War" that i am living through now can also never be likened to another.

When three years ago as above mentioned i was given a reprieve and told that i was not on the path to the dark river, but on the road of life again i was thrilled and elated this "reprieve", the new medicines that were able to further stop the spread of the diseases effect on the immune system. Unfortunately i ran into someone who had been in the above mentioned War of Wars in that jungle so far away and for whatever reason the man felt he should mislead me in my path towards the reeducation that i was seeking.

I began my study of Multi-Media at the Colorado Institute of Art on the advice of this "counsellor" who i shall not mention again as i have no grudge against the man. I had no clue as to the cost of the Institute. I only knew that i had lived on the same street upon moving back to my home State and that it was the closest of two schools in the area that offered this field on the Machintosh. A computer that i had gained familiarity with in the previous years. I blindly followed this fellows advice becuae i trusted him. he was working out of the V.A. Hospital as a career cousellor and I had no reason to doubt his truthfullness. He told me repeatedly that it was my right under section 31 of the "code" of education to go to any school that i wanted. So in my blindness i took out student loans to attend a school that cost 20000 dollars a year. By the middle of the first semester the truth had been revealed to me after much scrambling around trying to rouse the truth out of somewhere. Finally it was made clear to me that i had one choice in schools a fine choice but one that i had avoided as my driving

experience had been limited as i only began to drive in my early 20's and then sparingly and have no love for the sport. This too was another road block that this counsel had thrown in my path. He told me that if i felt that i was unable to drive the distance to school that the V.A. would take care of it. This culminated in a letter, unsigned from my doctor at the time that would revoke my driving privileges and thus make school fairly completely inaccessible. I have already done damage to the unmentioned soldier inadvertently as i wrote to my congresswoman at the time of this horror that i was experiencing but the Honorable Schroeder was on her way out of office and am not sure that i was making myself clear. I left the Colorado Institute of Art, have since paid my school loans and am properly ensconced at Red Rocks Community College, the one school approved by the V.A. for vocational rehabilitation for this Study as the Colorado Institute of Art, although once the school of choice is not used because of its expensiveness.

The gist of this digression is that by the time i finally got the situation cleared up. I honestly had lost contact with that initial feeling of elation in truth that was given to me by the knowledge that my trial of death had been interrupted for an indeterminate amount of time thus i began a downward spiral of thinking that death was the only thing to look forward to for when another human is so disturbed by your life situation that they lay stumbling blocks in your path for whatever reason it is difficult to discern a path that is free of debris except for the one that we must all travel to and that is the grave. Please pardon my morbidity.

What most disturbs me is that i am going to be giving up "to my mind", my mind to the chemicals of a pill that may balance this turmoil so that i might reverse this road that i am on. psychotropics are not new to me it is just that a very large part of my psyche believes in me and my own thought process. Especially when i now know that for the last three years i have hobbled myself in the living process because it became obscured to me that i actually had been given a second chance, most importantly this glorious gift was lost in the blinding fears that are my daily life living with this "virus".

Those blind spots are slowly becoming clear to me and they hurt very deeply, as deeply as i can think and further for the repercussion of just speaking of this situation are devastating. It is not an easy thing to admit this desire for death, especially for someone whose goal has always been to be an entertainer and to garner all things into their being so that they, me, might share myself with others, when not only the "others" have become the enemy but also my subconscious self.

I will continue on with this pursuit until it is solved.

I look to the only place for help that i can look at this late date and that is through my government of the United States of America that i am bound to serve until i am no longer.

I have unfailing trust in our America, the Veterans Administration, my President and First Lady, my elected officials and myself.

I have spent the last several days with my Mother and had to return home as it is Saturday, School begins again on Monday and I am in a worse place than when last i wrote.

In my speaking to Miss Jane Diburro we discuss my fear at how people will react to my situation of being a person living with AIDS. I could not leave the thoughts of what happened to me immediately after i was given the new drugs that keep me in a sort of health stasis.

On my immediate attempt to begin a new life by attending school and i must tell you that my enthusiasm at that time was unbounded and quite wonderful, i encountered an individual among

those who since i entered the Marine Corps i had and have always will consider not only my brothers and sisters but my true comrades at arms. that is why i was so confused when this person in a position of power at the VA hospital was telling me one thing and i had no reason to doubt his word as he not only was a career counselor at the VA, but he worked for the State. From that incident on i lost my drive and enthusiasm and have since always equated myself with those that are challenged. it is quite true that in many ways and on many days i do encounter situations that are difficult but that is nothing new to me.

My Mother has been paralyzed for over 30 years. She was in Hospital and Nursing Home for 7 of those years and returned back to my life when i was a junior in High School. This is the woman who taught me. She is the Daughter of a true McCoy of the Hatfields and McCoys and from her I learned the strength to put on a mask in front of people no matter what the situation. We of course as Mother and Son can let our hair down around one another but as far as outside of our small circle of two that is a No No.

Weakness is something that my Mother taught me from the time of my sentence as something to never allow anyone else to see.

For myself that weakness is usually silence and avoidance, as i have avoided this issue of my Health for these past three years.

I take my "AIDs Cocktail" without fail as it is my life line but i lost that what was my favorite pursuit in life and that was the betterment of myself in all ways that i could garner were beneficial to the body and spirit of a human.

I have from the time i discovered that my power is in my voice also understood that the voice is the tip of the berg and Health and all things related were the anchor and from that time beginning around 16 my pastime, the pursuit of bettering my self began.

1 I joined the Marine Corps for 3 reasons.

2 I have 2 cousins who were in Viet Nam in the Corps and to my mind embody the attributes that i in my knowing them as men wanted to possess also.

3 On the eve before joining watched the Tony Curtis, James Franciscus movie about the raising of the flag at Iwo Jima.

Immediately after the movie was the first multi-media commercial that i had seen on television and the next morning i called and asked if i was too old to join.

Recently i have found that a woman here in Golden Colorado who has been a friend of my family for as long as i have been around has a Son who served as a Navy Seal and suffers from P.T.S.D.

I have not spoken to Ed who now goes by another first name as i related earlier in this huge letter i am not able to equate myself to those men from Viet-Nam in that i cannot help but place them in a place in my heart and soul that is very deep and reverent.

I do know another Vet who i became acquainted with. His name is also changed. It is now Rip Clark. His brother is or was last term very high up in National Defense, i believe it was undersecretary. Rip was another who served in special forces. He was taught to jump into the jungle in the night and do what he was ordered to do.

Unfortunately he snapped before he left the service and is now ignored as being a veteran. He suffers from P.T.S.D. more so than any other person that i have ever imagined. From the time that i met Rip i knew that inside of the man was a wild beast. Controlled by his training and also cursed by the same.

He embodies that what to my limited understanding is the worst of the suffering that the Viet Nam had to give. When i first met him he was living in New Mexico, having left Los Angeles with the intention of going somewhere to die. There he found a woman who took him in to her home that is within view of the first of our Nations established posts of government in a town called AlCalde. when I entered his sleeping room i was taken into the jungle. I know that this choice of decor was his own and that is where his mind is still. We immediately understood one-another although i must admit that my guard is always up around the gentleman.

I do not want to become one of the dead letters that lives in some Regional Office trying to explain my situation in this matter of surviving the dual with an invisible enemy and ignored by those in position of power for whatever reason.

I can only equate my situation to Post Traumatic Stress Disorder as again it is the only explanation that i have ever encountered that was so close to home that i was dumbstruck.

The DAV, the VFW and the American legion are all organizations that i belong to and have for quite some while yet i am not able to approach them with this matter as again i am not able to ever know what the reaction will be to my situation and the individual. It will be a long while before i truly trust anyone in positon of power who may explode in some indeterminate way on my person with their lack of knoledge and fear. I pocess enough fear and lack of knowledge of my own without it being enforced by others.

I have 1 month and a week or so to end this semester of school. I have endured in a way that could never be equated to anything that i know of ever having been written. When someone sneezes or hacks and coughs i am effected bodily in that i honestly flinch and cannot help the wonder of "is this going to be the one ""virus"", that will do it". I am unable to begin ineterpersoanl relationships with others because of my fear of their reaction. I go through periods of agoraphobia that can only be eaquated to this reluctance to face the lack of knowledge that many times appears in others due to fear and misunderstanding.

This in true essense is my announcement that i suffer from a life situation that were it not for my life knowledge and my innate strength to survive would leave me paralyzed and in a state of complete inability to continue this pursuit of life.

I have not reached a conclusion about taking a pill to "cure" my mind, as i cannot give up the belief that it inside of me is the ability to solve this.

I cannot do this alone though and am seeking the help that is available to me through the Veterans Administration.

I am seeking a judgement of 100 percent disability so that i might begin to face and conquer this that is my lifes trauma.

I will ask that i be given a year away from school next year so that i may concentrate on that what is most important to me.

Overcoming this situation that is my life and finding that strength that i have lost to the folly of others

and my own thoughts.

I have had it with trying to print this year old letter.

I am asking for your help so that I may better approach this situation that is my life.

I know that there are answers out there and I plan on finding them.

U.S. officials view AIDS as security threat

By Associated Press

WASHINGTON — Clinton administration officials Sunday defended their decision to classify AIDS as a threat to national security — a designation aimed at garnering more attention and funding toward combating the disease worldwide.

Sandy Thurman, director of the White House Office of National AIDS Policy, said AIDS has become such an epidemic that, in years to come, it threatens to destabilize nations and the economies of whole continents.

"We have to respond to this because we've never seen a crisis like HIV and AIDS globally," Thurman said. "We're beginning to understand that this epidemic, not only has health implications, but has implications as a fundamental development issue, an economic issue and a stability and security issue."

Senate Majority Leader Trent Lott, in an appearance earlier in the day, said he does not believe AIDS is a national security threat.

"I guess this is just the president trying to make an appeal to, you know, certain groups," Lott, R-Miss., told "Fox News Sunday." "I don't view that as a national security threat, not to our national security interests, no."

Thurman countered that a report earlier this year from the National Intelligence Council indicates that the disease is "sweeping the globe," posing a crisis in Africa

today and threatening India and newly independent nations of the former Soviet Union in the future.

"With the logistical expertise that the national security community brings, with the diplomatic expertise that is necessary to sort of pave the road for leaders around the world to respond to this epidemic, this gives us a whole new ability to respond to AIDS like we would respond to any other international threat," Thurman said.

The White House, in raising the status of AIDS, has creating an interagency working group. The Clinton administration has designated about \$325 million to fighting the disease worldwide this year, most of it going to Africa, and the president wants an additional \$100 million for fiscal 2001, Thurman said.

She said a large focus of the effort would be on finding a vaccine.

- b) Have we any clearly defined plan for solving unusually difficult problems as they develop?.

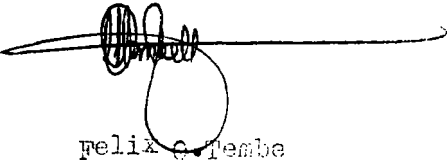

A CONCEPT PAPER ON HIV/AIDS, FROM SUBA FOCUS YOUTH ORGANISATION

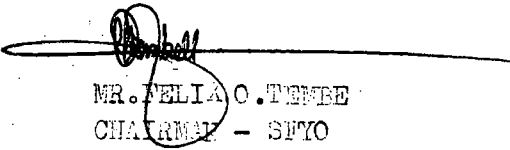
Suba Focus Youth Organisation is a community based organisation and a grassroots movement which was formed to majorly tackle themes and issues such as HIV/AIDS/STDs, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT, AGRICULTURE, POVERTY ALLEVIATION AND FAMINE ERADICATION, SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT, SUSTAINABLE USE OF ENERGY EMPOWERING AND LIBERATING WOMEN and many others. SFYO is managed by its chairman (Felix Tembe), and other officials such as the secretary, the treasurer besides a board of committee comprising of fifteen members. The administration organ operates under the direction of the secretary and includes arms such as finance, research, planning committee and education section. Though this is a community based organisation SFYO is headquartered in Kericho Town.

The political resources of SFYO include INFORMATION, FORCE, AUTHORITY, STATUS, LEGITIMACY and others. Economic goods and services as part of such resources are fields that are really lacking hence, dragging the organisation's operations. This is why SFYO seeks partnership with your office which we do hope will be in a position to fund its activities that are aimed at stopping the spread of HIV/AIDS in the rural areas in Kenya. Initially, the issue of fighting this pandemic seemed quite simple to say, it appeared that all that had to be done was to create awareness so as to enable everybody desist and abstain from careless sexual behaviour and other high risk activities. However, given the dimension which the pandemic has taken and the rate of ignorance in the rural areas, lack of modern health infrastructures, lack of resource centres to help in passing important information to the people, and other various shortcomings prevailing in the rural areas, we feel it is high time we acted to save the mass comprising about 80% of the total populace in Kenya. A successful fight against HIV/AIDS in these areas is fundamentally important because they form the economic engine of the government and are the critical partner to it.

The figures registered of deaths and infections are quite alarming. While Africa, has already realised 12,000,000 deaths from AIDS, she continues to bury about 5500 people daily and recording about 11,000 new infections daily. The projection is that by the year 2005, more than 100,000,000 people world - wide will be infected with HIV. In Kenya, if prevalence does increase to 15% by the year 2005, the infected people in the population would increase from 2,200,000 this year to 3,000,000 by the year 2005. The number of new AIDS cases each year resulting from these infections would increase from over 700,000 in 1999 to 2,700,000 by the year 2005. Such a crescendo threatens security and stability, and trade and investment of the country. To stop the spread of this scourge, an effort less of looking at the government as the only hope must be initiated from all alike.

To campaign against HIV/AIDS effectively, organise seminars, conferences and workshops for mobilisation, counsel for HIV/AIDS, carry research or behavioural changes, lobby and advocate, set up rehabilitation centres, resource centres and other activities to help in the 'stop-spreading campaign', SEYO is hereby requesting a grant of approximately US\$ 650,000 to enable it implement these programmes for a period of three years.

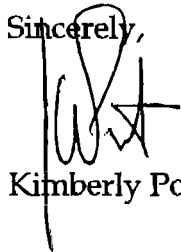
Per Brian Foucart's suggestion, I am forwarding you my resume for any assistance you might offer regarding my current job search.

The Children's park is meant to promote sport within the Compound and assist our OVCS improve on their healthy well being physically and mentally through exercise and training.

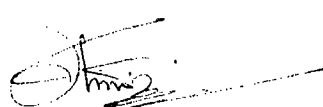

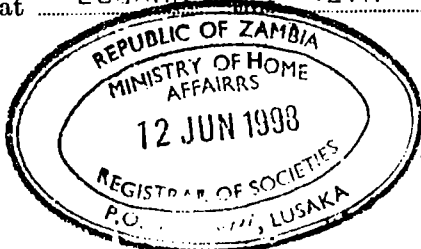

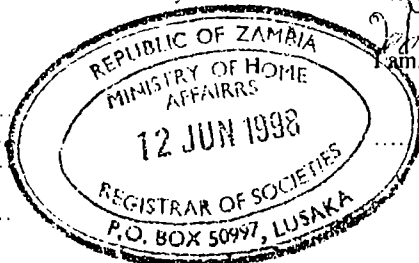
I forward herewith a Certificate of Registration for your society.

2. I take this opportunity of drawing your attention to the salient requirements of the Act and the Rules; these are:

- (1) To keep one or more books of account showing details of all moneys received and payments made by the society (rule 3).
- (2) To keep a register of members showing the full name and address of each member, the date on which each member was admitted to membership and the date on which each member terminated such membership (rule 4).
- (3) To submit to the Registrar of your district, that is, your District Secretary, an annual return in duplicate on Form SO9 not later than the 31st March of each year (rule 16).
- (4) To give notice to the Registrar of your district, that is, your District Secretary, in duplicate on Form SO8 within fourteen days, of any change of office bearer (rule 15).
- (5) To notify the Registrar of your district, that is, your District Secretary, in duplicate on Form SO7 within one month, of any change in a society's name or of any of the provisions of its constitution or rules or of any addition or decrease on its objects or if it becomes a branch of or affiliated to or connected with any organisation or group of a political nature established outside the country (section 15).
- (6) To notify the Registrar of your district, that is, your District Secretary, in duplicate on Form SO7 of any change of a society's postal address or of the situation of its registered office (section 32).
- (7) To supply any of the information the Registrar may require under section 17 or 18 or rule 19.

Forms SO7, 8 and 9 can be obtained from the District Secretary of the district in which a society's offices are situated.

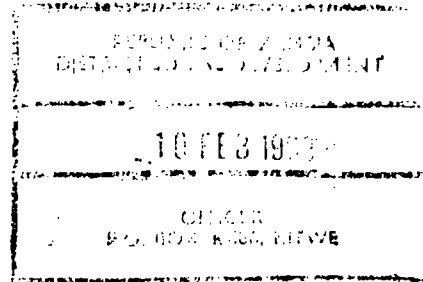
