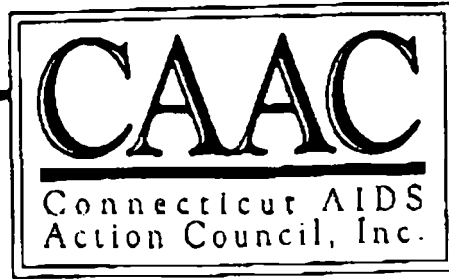


**Traveling North on Habersham Road, 3434 is the last driveway on the left, before Valley Road.**

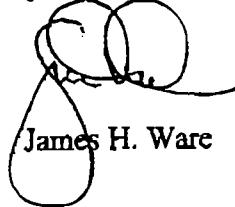
Dear Ms. Thurman,
