Dear Mr. President,

The growing awareness by the American people of an increasing number of national, global, man made and natural threats, for which there is little to no defense, is a very key element in the evolution of the best possible systems for our defense.

For threats like the "Sudden Conventional Attack(s)," the "little to no defense" status or assessment may at first seem incorrect. For that threat or any threat simply ask the following question, "What is the defense?" Accordingly, even with detection and several minutes of warning, during the first hour or hours of sudden or multiple conventional military attacks on our nation, what is the defense for you, your loved ones or any American who encounters the threat? The reality is there would be "little to no defense" for some period of time. Imagine the painful, deplorable, heartbreaking and costly consequences of "little to no defense," during such a time!

Briefly, we the American people pay some 250+ billion dollars year after year in taxes for defense! We also pay another whopping 250 billion dollars or more per year in taxes for the interest payments to service the national debt! To the best of my knowledge a large part of the national debt was incurred, in one way or another, by spending on defense! Conservatively, we the people pay an estimated 400+ billion dollars in total per year in taxes for and as a result of defense! With about 130 million working taxpayers, each taxpayer pays on average at least \$3,000.00 per year! Over the last 10 years, each taxpayer has spent on average at least \$30,000.00+ just for defense! That is a huge sum of money for "little to no defense" and to date, there is no end or limit in sight to such massive spending!

Mr. President, for all that money we continue to spend and have spent on defense, I firmly believe we have the most powerful military and related offensive arsenals for dispensing destruction and death on earth! A formidable deterrent, to be sure, as long as an adversary cares, is puny, is not mad or does not make a mistake or a stupid miscalculation. Won't happen! Can't happen! Wishful thinking, to be sure! A prescription for a very terrible nightmare... a very great deal of pain, grief and misery.....to say the least!

Year after year, we the American people with little or no complaints give a large amount of our hard earned money for our national security, our defense, Yet, "*believe it or not*" we the American people have *little to no defense*! Now consider this! With *little to no defense*, the leaders of our nation have allowed the *downsizing of what little defenses we have*! Why? This imprudent course makes no sense, beckons hostile actions and ultimately always requires massive resources to correct! In brief, it will lead to a costly nightmare!

Given the growing awareness and concern that we the people live in a very dangerous world with little to no defense. Add to that worry the other dominant concerns of our time, such as: global competition, global instability and terrorism, uncertainties about good wages, jobs, and the economies worldwide, rising educational costs, rising retirement costs, soaring health care costs, huge entitlement costs, rising law enforcement and related incarceration costs, ongoing inflation (gasoline, oil, housing), excessive, if not oppressive overt and covert taxation and a host of other social issues. Now, combine all of those amassing concerns with the dismal projection that tax rates will most likely grow to 70% to 80% of wages for our children. *At minimum*, all of us should conclude that *some form of creative, cost effective, constructive and timely change in the course of our nation is required, before we encounter a very violent, massive unforgiving natural disaster or any one or more of the possible destructive man made threats*. Threats that range from civil unrest to a nuclear accident, a sudden attack on our nation or any terrorist or hostile actions that threaten our security or interests!

After years of concern about these matters and blessed with the insight to envision the evolution of cost effective systems that will significantly improve our defensive and economic might, a plan has been developed to try to achieve those ends. *The essence of the plan requires that we the people work together to make a creative, cost effective, constructive, timely and relatively minor change in the course of our nation.
