I. PURPOSE

Prime Minister and Mrs. (Kathleen) Reynolds will be honored at tonight's "Celebration of Ireland," a black tie event at the White House. The evening provides an opportunity for you and the First Lady to host your Irish-American supporters as well as the Prime Minister and his wife for an evening of Irish entertainment and traditional Irish cuisine.

II. BACKGROUND

This evening isn't a reception or a State Dinner, rather it's an unprecedented format for a visiting Head of State. The format, an evening of ongoing entertainment and food rather than a seated dinner or program, evolved from conversations with the Ireland Embassy. Because of the strong relationship between Ireland and the United States, the initial guest list developed by the White House and the Irish Embassy included more than 250 "must invite" guests. Unfortunately, that number far exceeded our seated dinner limit of 140. Thus, together we developed the "Celebration of Ireland."

Throughout the evening, guests will enjoy an ongoing musical program by leading Irish-American entertainers in the East Room and a traditional Irish buffet in the State Dining Room. We worked with a leading chef in Dublin, Ireland as well as famous chefs specializing in Irish cuisine at the Waldorf Astoria and Plaza Hotels.

Following is a list of the entertainers.

Entertainment

Oliver Barry is one of Ireland's leading concert promoters who has been instrumental in consultation for the musical program of the "Celebration of Ireland."

Sue Richards, an Irish Folk Harpist from Rockville, MD, is a nationally known teacher and performer of traditional Irish music. Her solo recording, "Morning Aire," was recently awarded "Album of the Year" by the Washington Area Music Association.

Dr. Richard S. Blair, former piping soloist and Officer-in-Charge of the United States Air Force Pipe Band, was a member of the group performing at President John F. Kennedy's funeral. He will lead you, the First Lady, the Prime Minister and Mrs. Reynolds down the Grand Staircase.

Phil Coulter, often referred to as Ireland's Ambassador of Music, has achieved worldwide acclaim for his songwriting and has been recorded by legends such as Elvis Presley. You saw them at last year's St. Patrick's Day dinner.

Barbara Murphy-Edwards, born in Dublin, Ireland, where she received her early music training before immigrating to the United States with her parents in 1959, plays the Irish Harp.

Sharon Shannon Band is a twenty-four year old legend in traditional folk and rock circles who has revolutionized the role of the accordion in Irish traditional music.

Altan, an award-winning group with members from the North and South of Ireland, is considered to be the country's premiere traditional band. After performing at Carnegie Hall earlier this week, they have adjusted their schedule to play for you following another engagement earlier in the evening.

Kevin Broesler's School of Dancing composed of world champion Irish dancers from New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore will perform Irish jigs, slip jigs and hornpipes. They are accompanied by the 1986 Irish Button Accordionist Champion, Bill McConiskey, and the highly popular musician, Felix Dolan.

Deidre O'Callahan is one of the Prime Minister's favorite Irish Harpists who has performed throughout the world.
