BACKGROUND

Congressman Lewis is very optimistic about the prospects of the trip. He is convinced that the people of South Africa, blacks as well as whites, are eager for the elections to take place; that the ANC will move aggressively to build a broad based inclusive government; and that the South African government will need a tremendous amount of U.S. financial help and foreign investment.

w Congressman Amo Houghton, the ranking republican on the trip wants to raise two key issues. One, the elections will force South Africa to deal with the lack of capital for young entrepreneurs. The elections have raised expectations and the young business people expect much. This ties into his second concern about trade. Without trade, there will be no real efforts toward improving the economy and providing jobs. American must be helpful and encourage other nations to do the same.

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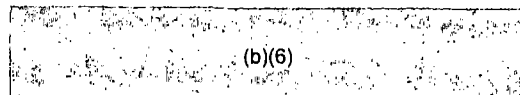

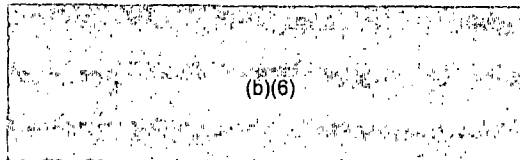
