LEAD STORIES

1. PRESIDENT HOSNI MUBARAK MET WITH YEMENI FOREIGN MINISTER MOHAMED SALEM BASANDWAH IN CAIRO ON MAY 11 TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN YEMEN. AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AFTER THE MEETING, BASANDWAH DESCRIBED THE WAR IN YEMEN AS "AN ACT TO REPEL SOME SOCIALIST PARTY LEADERS WHO REBELLED AGAINST THE CONSTITUTION." HE PREDICTED THAT THE FIGHTING WOULD END "WITHIN HOURS" AND DENIED THAT EGYPTIAN ISLAMIC EXTREMISTS (IN YEMEN) ARE FIGHTING SIDE BY SIDE WITH THE "NORTHERN FORCES." HE ALSO DENIED THAT ARABS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE FIGHTING AND ADDED THAT ALL ARAB COUNTRIES ARE NEUTRAL AND HAVE NOT INTERFERED IN YEMEN'S INTERNAL AFFAIRS. BASANDWAH NOTED THAT HIS GOVERNMENT HAS ASKED THE GOVERNOR OF ADEN TO HAND OVER ANY CAPTURED EGYPTIAN EXTREMISTS TO THE EGYPTIAN CONSULATE. HE STRESSED THAT THERE ARE NO IRAQI OR SUDANESE "FIGHTERS" AMONG THE SANAA FORCES AND ADDED THAT "WE DO NOT NEED MORE MEN." BASANDWAH EMPHASIZED THAT FOR THE WAR TO STOP, THE "OUTLAWS" MUST RESPECT THE LAW AND THE CONSTITUTION AND MUST SURRENDER THEIR FORCES AND ARMS TO THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT. HE PROMISED THAT THE "OUTLAWS" WILL OBTAIN A FAIR TRIAL IF THEY SURRENDER.

BASANDWAH DEPARTED CAIRO ON MAY 11. MEANWHILE, AN ARAB LEAGUE DELEGATION IS EXPECTED TO MEET WITH YEMENI LEADERS ON MAY 12 TO MEDIATE A HALT TO THE CIVIL WAR. IN A RELATED DEVELOPMENT, THE SHEIKH OF AL-AZHAR CALLED ON THE YEMENI LEADERS TO STOP THE BLOODSHED AND URGED ARAB AND ISLAMIC RULERS TO HELP RESTORE PEACE IN YEMEN (ALL PAPERS).

2. PRESIDENT MUBARAK MET WITH INTERIOR MINISTER HASAN AL-ALFY ON MAY 11 TO REVIEW THE INTERNAL SECURITY SITUATION. AFTER THE MEETING, AL-ALFY TOLD REPORTERS THAT HE WILL SOON PROVIDE INFORMATION ON THE ARRESTS OF SEVERAL "AIDES" OF TALAAT YASIN HAMMAM, A TERRORIST LEADER WHO WAS KILLED IN A SHOOT-OUT WITH SECURITY FORCES ON APRIL 25. AL-ALFY SAID THAT AN UNSPECIFIED QUANTITY OF WEAPONS, EXPLOSIVES, AND "HIT LISTS" WAS CONFISCATED WHEN HAMMAM'S AIDES WERE ARRESTED (ALL PAPERS).

3. AL-WAFD (OPPOSITION) REPORTS THAT INTERIOR MINISTER HASAN AL-ALFY HAS DENIED THAT ISLAMIST LAWYER ABDEL HARETH MADANI, WHO DIED RECENTLY WHILE IN POLICE CUSTODY, WAS TORTURED TO DEATH. AL-ALFY CLAIMED THAT MADANI DIED OF AN ASTHMA ATTACK WHILE IN CUSTODY. AL-ALFY REFUSED OTHER COMMENTS ON THE

4. AL-WAFD (OPPOSITION) REPORTS THAT SECURITY FORCES
HAVE ARRESTED SIX TERRORISTS WHO ALLEGEDLY KILLED

THE TERRORISTS REPORTEDLY RECEIVED INSTRUCTIONS FROM

DEPUTY, RIFAAT ZIDAN, WHO IS ALSO THE LEADER OF THE
TERRORIST GROUPS IN ASSIYUT.

LEAD STORIES

1. ALL PAPERS REPORT THAT YEMENI PRESIDENT ALI ABDALLAH SALEH TELEPHONED PRESIDENT MUBARAK ON MAY 16 TO BRIEF HIM ON THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS ON THE CIVIL WAR IN YEMEN. A STATEMENT IS EXPECTED TO BE ISSUED IN YEMEN ON MAY 17 ANNOUNCING THE SEPARATION OF SOUTHERN FROM NORTHERN YEMEN. MEANWHILE, AN ARAB LEAGUE DELEGATION IS EXPECTED TO DEPART SANAA FOR CAIRO ON MAY 17 AFTER ITS TALKS WITH YEMENI OFFICIALS. AN UNIDENTIFIED ARAB LEAGUE OFFICIAL SAID THAT THE DELEGATION DID NOT MEET WITH YEMENI PRESIDENT SALEH. THE OFFICIAL ALSO DENIED THAT SANAA HAS REJECTED THE LEAGUE'S PROPOSAL FOR A CEASE-FIRE.

2. PRESIDENT MUBARAK MET WITH MINISTER OF DEFENSE HUSSEIN TANTAWI WHO BRIEFED HIM ON THE RESULTS OF HIS RECENT VISIT TO WASHINGTON. IN A STATEMENT TO REPORTERS AFTER THE MEETING, TANTAWI MADE THE FOLLOWING POINTS: US ECONOMIC AND MILITARY AID TO EGYPT IS NOT EXPECTED TO BE REDUCED BECAUSE US OFFICIALS APPRECIATE MUBARAK'S PEACE EFFORTS AND ARE AWARE OF EGYPT'S POLITICAL AND MILITARY "WEIGHT" IN THE MIDDLE EAST; THE US WILL CONTINUE TO MODERNIZE THE EGYPTIAN ARMED FORCES AND PROVIDE EGYPT WITH MILITARY TECHNOLOGY; AND STUDIES ARE UNDER WAY TO EXAMINE IF FACTORY 200, WHICH PRODUCES THE M-1 A-1 TANK, COULD BE USED TO PRODUCE OTHER TYPES OF WEAPONS (ALL PAPERS).

3. "THE EGYPTIAN ASSOCIATION FOR JUNIOR LAWYERS" ISSUED A STATEMENT ON MAY 16 CRITICIZING THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD-CONTROLLED BAR ASSOCIATION FOR USING THE DEATH ISLAMIST LAWYER ABDEL HARETH MADANI, WHO DIED RECENTLY WHILE IN POLICE CUSTODY, TO INCITE LAWYERS NATIONWIDE AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT. THE STATEMENT ADDED THAT THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD SEEKS TO "SETTLE OLD SCORES" WITH THE GOVERNMENT AT THE EXPENSE OF THE MAJORITY OF "HONEST AND NATIONALIST" LAWYERS (AKHBAR). IN A RELATED DEVELOPMENT, AL-SHAAB (OPPOSITION) REPORTS THAT A GROUP OF LAWYERS WILL ORGANIZE A "PEACEFUL MARCH" AT NOON ON MAY 17 FROM THE BAR ASSOCIATION HEADQUARTERS IN DOWNTOWN CAIRO TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE TO PROTEST MADANI'S DEATH. AL-SHAAB SAID THAT DEMONSTRATORS WILL CARRY BANNERS CONDEMNING TORTURE AND DEMANDING THAT THE POLICE OFFICERS RESPONSIBLE FOR MADANI'S DEATH BE BROUGHT TO ACCOUNT.
