1. MAY 26 EDITIONS OF ARABIC AND ENGLISH-LANGUAGE SAUDI
NEWSPAPERS REPORTED ON NEW U.S. DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS TO
END FIGHTING IN YEMEN. REPORTS WERE DRAWN FROM NEWS
AGENCIES AND DATELINED CAIRO.
2. BOLD HEADLINE IN THE SAUDI GAZETTE: "U.S. LAUNCHES
BID TO END YEMEN WAR." CITING AN EGYPTIAN DIPLOMAT, THE
GAZETTE STORY REPORTED THAT THE U.S. HAS CONTACTED
EGYPT, SAUDI ARABIA, AND THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES IN AN
EFFORT TO HELP BROKER A CEASEFIRE BETWEEN RIVAL LEADERS
IN THE YEMEN CIVIL WAR. THE EGYPTIAN DIPLOMAT ADDED
THAT THE AIM OF THE U.S.-LED MEDIATION WAS "TO PRESERVE
YEMEN'S UNITY WITHOUT RESORTING TO FORCE." U.S. CHARGE
D'AFFAIRES IN CAIRO, EDMUND HULL, TOLD THE PRESS THE
EGYPT AND THE U.S. WERE WORKING TO OBTAIN A CEASEFIRE IN
YEMEN AND FACILITATE THE OPENING OF TALKS BETWEEN THE
TWO PROTAGONISTS.
3. AL-JAZEERA'S HEADLINE: "ARRANGEMENTS UNDER WAY TO
HOLD A SUMMIT MEETING IN LONDON OR PARIS BETWEEN SALIH
AND AL-BIDH UNDER AMERICAN SPONSORSHIP." SUB-LEADS
REPORTED THAT FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE OUTBREAK OF
FIGHTING, THERE WAS TELEPHONIC CONTACT BETWEEN SALIH AND

SUBJECT: EU AID FOR VICTIMS OF FIGHTING IN YEMEN

1. THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON MAY 26 ANNOUNCED THE GRANTING OF 300,000 ECU (ROUGHLY THE EQUIVALENT OF 350,000 USD) TO FINANCE EMERGENCY HUMANITARIAN AID FOR THE VICTIMS OF THE CIVIL WAR IN YEMEN. THE AID WILL COVER THE PURCHASE, TRANSPORTATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF DRUGS AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AS WELL AS EMERGENCY HEALTH CARE.

2. THE OPERATION WILL BE CONDUCTED FOR THREE MONTHS BY THE UNHCR. THE COMMISSION NOTED THAT THE UNHCR ALREADY SENT TEAMS TO YEMEN AND THAT THESE TEAMS ARE WORKING IN COOPERATION WITH THE YEMENITE RED CRESCENT ORGANIZATION.

((Text)) ((DER SPIEGEL)) Why has the Arab League failed in the conflict in Yemen?

(('Abd al-Majid)) We have not failed; we made enormous efforts to defuse the conflict.

((DER SPIEGEL)) But this has not prevented the fratricidal war.

(('Abd al-Majid)) The Arab League does not have the right to intervene in the internal conflicts of a member state. The Republic of Yemen officially still exists as a unified state. Nevertheless, the Arab League remains an important political instrument, and that includes in the conflict in Yemen as well.

((DER SPIEGEL)) What can you do?

(('Abd al-Majid)) Both parties to the war in Yemen now want to negotiate. The Arab League has been called upon to mediate between Sana and Aden.

((DER SPIEGEL)) Are you thinking of sending peacekeeping forces under the green banner of the Arab League?

(('Abd al-Majid)) If both sides consider this appropriate, why not?

((DER SPIEGEL)) In other conflicts in the region, the League has also been ineffective -- for instance, in Somalia.

(('Abd al-Majid)) No state whatsoever existed there, which made the costly intervention of UN troops difficult. International organizations cannot replace a state.

((DER SPIEGEL)) The Arab League also stayed out of the rapprochement between the Israelis and the Palestinians.

(('Abd al-Majid)) Not at all. By unanimously recognizing the respective UN resolutions, we have clearly accelerated the peace process.

((DER SPIEGEL)) Are all Arab League members really ready to recognize Israel's right to exist?

(('Abd al-Majid)) All, without any exception -- under the precondition that all parties strive for a just peace on the basis of "land for peace."
