SUBJECT: Points for President's meeting with Nixon

-- The President met yesterday with former President Nixon to discuss his recent visit to Russia. President Nixon reiterated his strong support for additional Western assistance for Russia, a view which President Clinton shares.

-- The President expressed his strong support of President Yeltsin and Russia's political and economic reform program. The President will be discussing new efforts to assist Russia in the coming months with our G-7 partners, including French President Mitterrand, with whom he meets today.

SUBJECT: President Nixon

Please pass to Tony and Sandy

I wanted to let you know that President Nixon, who will travel to Moscow in early March, has asked me to have lunch with him in New Jersey on Thursday in order to brief him on the situation in Russia and our policy. I think that I should accept. I would talk to you before I go to discuss what I say. It would also be a good idea for the President to call him before his departure--I will submit a schedule request for a phone call.

I also wanted to convey best wishes to you from Henry Bienen and Dick Ullman at Princeton. I was at the Woodrow Wilson School two days ago for a speech on Russia. They both asked for you and would like you to consider visiting the school for a speech at any time of your choosing.

SUBJECT: Weds. Situation

At this morning's Senior Directors' meeting, Sandy Berger announced that (1) Wednesday is a national day of mourning for President Nixon and the Federal government will be closed but (2) each office must be covered. I am interpreting that guidance as follows:

1. I will be in tomorrow so the office will by definition be "covered."
2. Anyone can take tomorrow off without having to request leave.
3. If you have something you need to do, especially if it is due Thursday or Friday, and it requires secretarial assistance, better get it done today, since I would expect Sandie and Angie will not be in tomorrow.
4. In short, Wednesday will be treated like a Saturday.
