SUBJECT: UUP ON TRIMBLE TRIP AND PRESIDENT'S VISIT

1. BELFAST CONSUL GENERAL SPOKE TO JEFFREY DONALDSON AND JIM WILSON OF THE ULSTER UNIONIST PARTY MORNING OF OCTOBER 27 ABOUT UUP LEADER DAVID TRIMBLE'S TRIP TO THE U.S., ABOUT LAST WEEKEND'S UUP CONFERENCE (SEPTTEL), AND ABOUT THE PRESIDENT'S VISIT TO NORTHERN IRELAND.

TRIMBLE'S TRIP

2. TRIMBLE RETURNS TO BELFAST FROM LONDON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27. HE THEN WILL DEPART BELFAST AT 11:30 AM OCTOBER 28 FOR WASHINGTON VIA LONDON HEATHROW, ARRIVING DULLES AT 7:25 PM OCTOBER 28 ON BA 223. ACCOMPANYING TRIMBLE WILL BE UUP SECURITY SPOKESMAN KEN MAGINNIS MP, AND HONORARY SECRETARY JEFFREY DONALDSON. MARTIN SMYTH, MP, WILL JOIN THE GROUP FOR ITS APPOINTMENTS IN WASHINGTON.

3. DONALDSON SAID THE SCHEDULE FOR THE U.S. WAS NOW MOSTLY CONFIRMED. WHILE HE UNDERSTOOD THE DIFFICULTIES, HE EXPRESSED HOPE THAT A TIME FOR THE WHITE HOUSE APPOINTMENT WOULD SOON BE FORTHCOMING. DONALDSON NOTED POSITIVELY THAT HE HAD READ DUP LEADER IAN PAISLEY WOULD BE MEETING WITH NSA LAKE AND THE VICE PRESIDENT, SAYING HE THOUGHT THIS WAS A GOOD THING.

THE PRESIDENT'S TRIP

4. DONALDSON SAID THAT, FOLLOWING THE MEETING WE HAD EARLIER IN THE WEEK WITH HIM, KEN MAGINNIS AND TWO MEMBERS OF THE WHITE HOUSE PRE-ADVANCE TEAM, HE WAS MORE AWARE OF THE LOGISTICAL DIFFICULTIES PRESENTED BY THE UUP PROPOSALS THAT PRESIDENT VISIT UUP-HELD PARLIAMENTARY DISTRICTS IN LISBURN OR CARRICKFERGUS. HE ASKED IF AN EAST BELFAST ENTERPRISE CENTER EVENT WOULD INCLUDE UUP DEPUTY LEADER JOHN TAYLOR (WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE EAST BELFAST PARTNERSHIP) AND WAS ASSURED THAT IT WOULD. DONALDSON SAID HE AND OTHER PARTY OFFICIALS WERE NOW LOOKING AT POSSIBILITIES SURROUNDING ALDERGROVE (BELFAST INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT), WHICH IS IN A UUP CONSTITUENCY, AND AT WAYS IN WHICH THE SCOTS-IRISH LINKS TO THE U.S. MIGHT BE HIGHLIGHTED.

5. DONALDSON MENTIONED THAT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN NORTHERN IRELAND IS LOCATED BETWEEN CITY HALL AND THE EUROPA HOTEL. HE ALSO MENTIONED THE STONE LAID BY GENERAL EISENHOWER TO COMMEMORATE THE FIRST U.S. SOLDIERS WHO CAME TO NORTHERN IRELAND AT THE OUTSET OF U.S. INVOLVEMENT IN WORLD WAR II. CONGEN AFFIRMED THAT WE WERE AWARE THE STONE WAS DUE TO BE RELAID FOLLOWING THE RENOVATION OF CITY HALL GROUNDS NOW UNDERWAY.

1. THE FOLLOWING PRESS GUIDANCE WAS PREPARED AND
APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF EUROPEAN AND CANADIAN AFFAIRS
FOR THE DEPARTMENT BRIEFING. QUESTIONS SHOULD BE
REFERRED TO ARIC SCHWAN OR JIM HUTCHESON, EUR PUBLIC
AFFAIRS.

2. BOSNIA: CAN RUSSIA VETO JOULWAN'S ORDERS?

Q. WILL RUSSIA HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO COUNTERMAND ORDERS GIVEN TO THEIR IFOR TROOPS BY THE GENERAL JOULWAN?

A. -- NO SUBORDINATE COMMANDER, RUSSIAN OR OTHER, WILL BE ABLE TO COUNTERMAND COMMAND DECISIONS AND REMAIN A PART OF THE IMPLEMENTATION FORCE. AS SECRETARY PERRY NOTED, THE RUSSIANS - LIKE ANY OTHER CONTRIBUTING NATION - RETAIN NATIONAL COMMAND AUTHORITY OVER THEIR TROOPS. BUT FORCES REFUSING OPERATIONAL CONTROL BY GENERAL JOULWAN COULD NOT REMAIN IN THE COALITION.

-- DISCUSSIONS REGARDING POLITICAL CONTROL OF RUSSIAN FORCES CONTINUE.

3. ARMS CONTROL: CFE TREATY

Q: WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF NOVEMBER 17 FOR THE CFE TREATY?

A: -- AS YOU KNOW, THE CFE TREATY SETS LIMITS ON THE CONVENTIONAL MILITARY EQUIPMENT OF 30 STATES, INCLUDING ALL THE MEMBERS OF NATO AND THE FORMER WARSAW PACT.

-- NOVEMBER 17 MARKS THE END OF THE CFE TREATY'S EQUIPMENT REDUCTION PHASE, AND THE TREATY'S EQUIPMENT LIMITS NOW TAKE EFFECT.

-- OVER 50,000 PIECES OF EQUIPMENT HAVE BEEN DESTROYED UNDER CFE DURING THE LAST THREE YEARS, AND OVER 2,000 ON SITE INSPECTIONS HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED.

-- THE PRESIDENT HAS SENT A MESSAGE TO THE CFE JOINT CONSULTATIVE GROUP TAKING NOTE OF THIS EVENT AND LOOKING TOWARD NEXT STEPS IN THE TREATY'S IMPLEMENTATION AND SPEEDY RESOLUTION OF ALL COMPLIANCE CONCERNS, INCLUDING, IN PARTICULAR THE FLANK ISSUE.

-- (THERE WAS AN ON-THE-RECORD BRIEFING ON CFE TODAY.)

Q: WHAT IS THE STATUS OF THE CFE FLANK ISSUE?

A: THE 30 CFE STATES HAVE AGREED IN VIENNA ON KEY ELEMENTS OF A FLANK SOLUTION.

-- THESE INCLUDE (1) A REALIGNMENT OF THE MAP DESCRIBING THE CFE FLANK TERRITORY OF THE FORMER SOCVIET UNION IN CONFORMING WITH THE OBJECTIVES AND BASIC STRUCTURE OF THE TREATY; (2) A TIME-LINE TO ELIMINATE, THROUGH

WITHDRAWAL OR REDUCTION, EXCESS EQUIPMENT FROM THE FLANK REGION: AND (3) ACCOMPANYING MEASURES TO ENSURE ENHANCED TRANSPARENCY AND VERIFICATION, AND CONSTRAINTS ON TLE HOLDINGS IN THE AREA(S) AFFECTED BY THE MAP REALIGNMENT.

-- MUCH GROUND REMAINS TO BE COVERED, HOWEVER, TO WORK OUT AN AGREEMENT BASED ON THESE KEY ELEMENTS. THE U.S. IS WORKING INTENSIVELY WITH NATO ALLIES, THE RUSSIANS, AND OTHER CFE STATES TO RESOLVE THIS ISSUE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, IN A WAY THAT PRESERVES THE INTEGRITY OF THE TREATY.

Q: IS RUSSIA GOING TO MEET ITS ARMS CONTROL OBLIGATIONS TODAY?

A: -- RUSSIA'S OVERALL RECORD ON CFE IMPLEMENTATION IS POSITIVE. RUSSIA HAS MET ITS TREATY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FIRST TWO PHASES OF EQUIPMENT REDUCTIONS, AND IT LOOKS LIKE RUSSIA WILL IN FACT COMPLETE ALL ITS REQUIRED CFE TREATY EQUIPMENT DESTRUCTION BY THE NOVEMBER 17 DEADLINE. THAT MEANS RUSSIA WILL HAVE DESTROYED SOME 11,000 PIECES OF EQUIPMENT IN THE CFE AREA IN FULFILLMENT OF ITS TREATY OBLIGATIONS.

-- HOWEVER, RUSSIA HAS NOT MET THE EQUIPMENT LIMITS GOVERNING THE TREATY'S FLANK REGION.

-- AS YOU KNOW, THE RUSSIANS HAVE MAINTAINED FOR NEARLY TWO YEARS THAT THE CFE TREATY'S FLANK ZONE EQUIPMENT LIMITS DO NOT GIVE THEM SUFFICIENT FLEXIBILITY TO MEET THEIR DEFENSE NEEDS.

-- RUSSIA HAS ALSO SAID CONSISTENTLY THAT IT IS COMMITTED TO CFE, AND COMMITTED TO FINDING A COOPERATIVE SOLUTION TO ITS FLANK CONCERNS.

-- TODAY THE 30 CFE STATES HAVE AGREED IN VIENNA ON KEY ELEMENTS OF A SOLUTION.

-- WE ARE DISCUSSING THIS ISSUE INTENSIVELY WITH THE RUSSIANS BOTH BILATERALLY AND, TOGETHER WITH OUR ALLIES, IN THE CFE JOINT CONSULTATIVE GROUP IN VIENNA.

4. NORTHERN IRELAND: PRESIDENT'S VISIT AND PEACE PROCESS

Q: IS THE PEACE PROCESS ABOUT TO COLLAPSE IN NORTHERN IRELAND?

A: -- QUIET DIPLOMACY AND CONTACTS BETWEEN THE BRITISH AND IRISH GOVERNMENTS AND THE PARTIES

IN NORTHERN IRELAND ARE CONTINUING. GERRY ADAMS OF SINN FEIN AND LOYALIST PARTY LEADERS HAVE EACH HAD MEETINGS THIS WEEK AT THE WHITE HOUSE WITH THE PRESIDENT'S NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISOR, TONY LAKE. WE CONTINUE TO BELIEVE THAT THE TWIN-TRACK APPROACH PROPOSED BY THE BRITISH AND IRISH GOVERNMENTS REPRESENTS THE MOST PROMISING WAY TO MOVE THE PEACE PROCESS FORWARD.

Q: WILL THE PRESIDENT'S VISIT TO NORTHERN IRELAND BE CANCELLED?

A: -- THE PRESIDENT'S TRIP TO LONDON, NORTHERN IRELAND, AND DUBLIN REMAINS AS SCHEDULED. PREPARATIONS FOR THE VISIT ARE CONTINUING.
