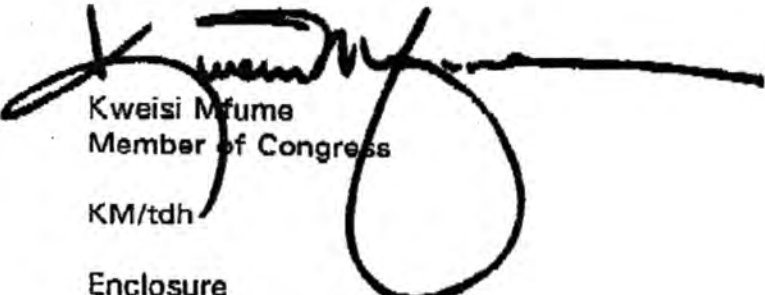

HOWARD G. AYLESWORTH, JR.

Howard G. Aylesworth, Jr. is director, manufacturing and customer support for the Aerospace Industries Association (AIA). He is responsible for monitoring issues, regulations and developments that affect AIA members in the areas of customer support, unapproved parts, aircraft noise and engine emissions, and industry and regulatory affairs pertaining to civil aviation.

Aylesworth has most recently led the Aerospace Industry Evaluation of the FAA Parts Approval Action Team Phases I and II, the Aerospace Industry Notice 8110.XXX Working Group, the Aerospace Industry Distributor Regulation Task Force, and is currently chairman of the Parts Approval Action Team Phase III Working Group. These efforts have built industry consensus on enforcing parts manufacturer approvals and eliminating unapproved parts, issues which have heretofore been divisive to the civil aviation community.

Before joining AIA in 1991, Aylesworth worked in economic development and finance. He was vice president, product development for Fiscal Planning Services, Inc., a fiscal management consulting firm in Bethesda, Maryland, and a consultant for the Lower Mississippi Economic Development Commission. He was a professional staff member on the Economic Stabilization Subcommittee of the Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs, U.S. House of Representatives, and was a marketing specialist and economist for the Maryland Department of Economic and Community Development. Aylesworth was a freight specialist for the Ramsey Scarlett Company in Baltimore, Maryland, has taught economics for the Maryland Community College System, and was an assistant economist at the Federal Reserve Board, Washington, D.C.

Aylesworth received his bachelor's degree in economics and philosophy of science from the University of Denver in 1967, and master's degree in political economy from the American University in 1972. A recipient of the Frank Tamanga Monetary Economist Award, Aylesworth is also a member of the Phi Gamma Mu Social Science Honorary Society and the Omicron Delta Epsilon Economics Honorary Society.

Aylesworth is a past Commissioner on the Maryland Commission on Indian Affairs, and was a representative on Maryland's High Technology Roundtable. He is a Member of the Board of COPE, Inc., a heating oil distributor.

AIA is the trade association representing the nation's manufacturers of commercial, military and business aircraft, helicopters, aircraft engines, missiles, spacecraft and related components and equipment.

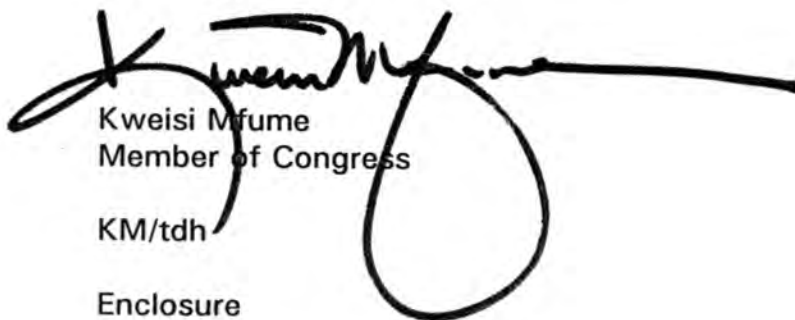
