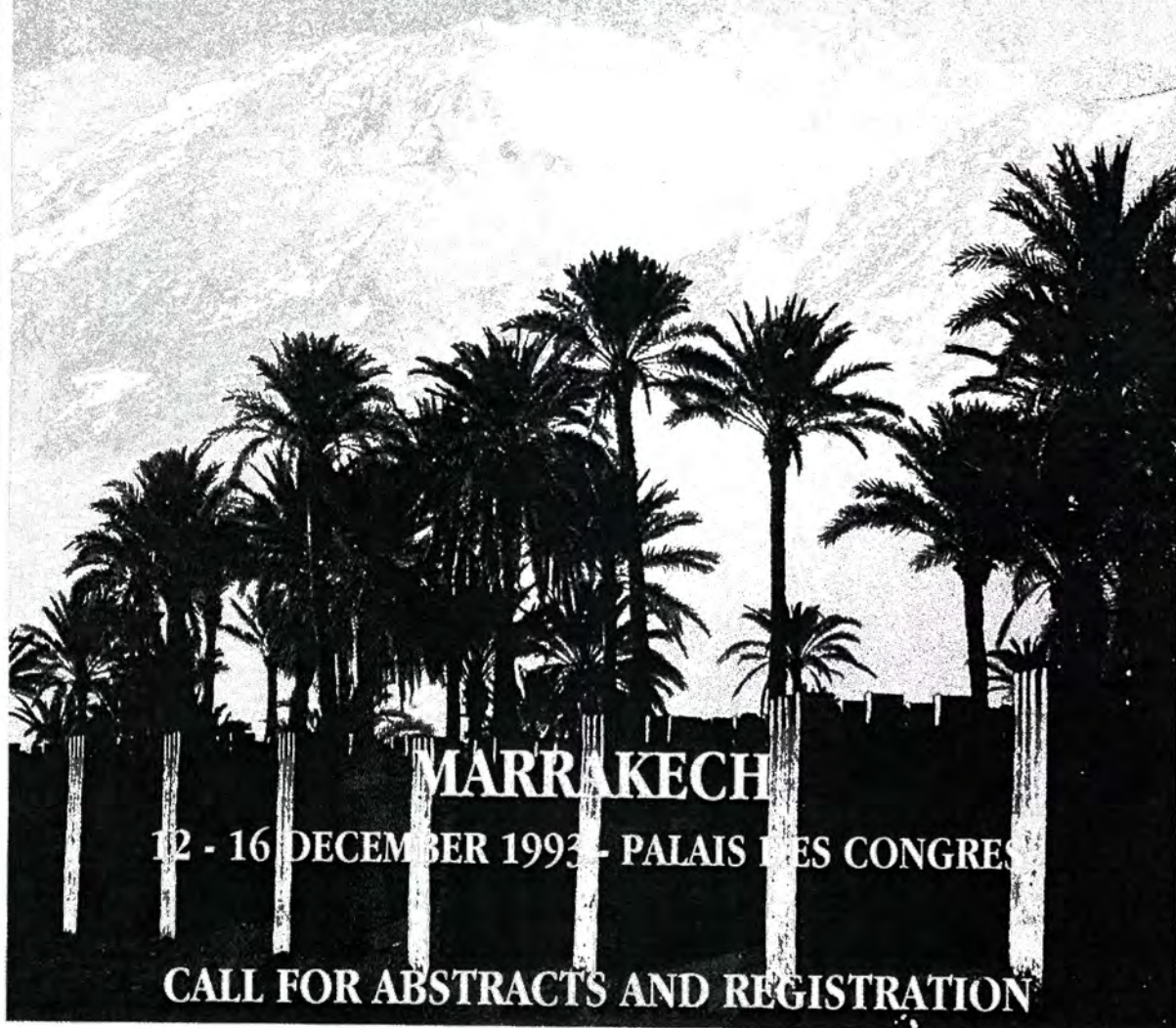

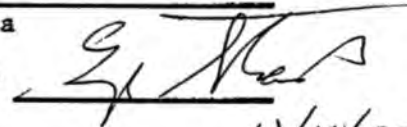

Moreover, there is no direct service (contract or otherwise) from any U.S. city to a European city with connecting service to Marrakech after 9:00 p.m. If she traveled on December 13, 1993, she would have missed the connecting flight into Marrakech via Casablanca, and not participated in the conference for another day. As it happened, the outbound trip was a very circuitous routing, that required three layovers and more than 16 hours of travel.

1. SUMMARY. AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON AIDS AND STDs

IN AFRICA IS BEING HELD IN MARRAKECH, MOROCCO 12-16 DECEMBER 1993. IN AN EFFORT TO STIMULATE ACTION ON THE ISSUE OF HIV/AIDS IN AFRICAN MILITARY POPULATIONS, THERE WILL BE A SPECIAL PANEL CONCENTRATING ON AIDS AND THE MILITARY. THIS CABLE REQUESTS THAT ACTION ADDRESSEES ENCOURAGE APPROPRIATE HOST GOVERNMENT PARTICIPATION IN ORDER TO DRAW ATTENTION TO THE ISSUE OF AIDS IN MILITARY POPULATIONS. END SUMMARY.

2. BACKGROUND: IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE, IT IS ESTIMATED THAT AIDS WILL EXCEED MEASLES AND MALARIA AS A LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH AMONG CHILDREN UNDER FIVE YEARS OF AGE IN AFRICA. AT THE CURRENT LEVELS OF HIV INFECTION, IT IS INEVITABLE THAT AIDS-RELATED DEATHS WILL REVERSE THE PREVIOUSLY FAVORABLE TREND IN LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH, CHILD MORTALITY, AND ADULT MORTALITY OVER THE NEXT FIVE YEARS. BY 1995, AIDS WILL INCREASE THE MORTALITY OF AFRICAN ADULTS BETWEEN AGES 15-49 YEARS BY ABOUT 33

PERCENT.

3. SEVERAL FACTORS MAKE THE GLOBAL HIV/AIDS PANDEMIC A SIGNIFICANT INTERNATIONAL SECURITY ISSUE AS WELL AS AN IMPOSING ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL CHALLENGE. UNQUESTIONABLY, THE ULTIMATE IMPACT OF HIV/AIDS EXTENDS WELL BEYOND ITS MORTALITY TOLL AS A VIRAL EPIDEMIC.

4. SIGNIFICANCE: AN INCREASE IN DEATHS AMONG YOUNG ADULTS OF THE MAGNITUDE PREDICTED IS LIKELY TO HAVE SUBSTANTIAL ADVERSE EFFECTS ON ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND MILITARY/SECURITY STABILITY THROUGHOUT AFRICA.

-- ECONOMIC CONSEQUENCES:

0 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN AFRICA WILL UNQUESTIONABLY BE AFFECTED. AIDS WILL RESULT IN INCREASED STRESS ON FRAGILE AFRICAN ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURES AS LABOR PRODUCTIVITY DECLINES; OBSTACLES TO TRADE FOREIGN INVESTMENT AND TOURISM INCREASE; AND HEALTH SYSTEMS AND SOCIAL COPING

0 COMMUNITIES WILL INCREASINGLY BE FORCED TO BEAR THE BRUNT OF THE EPIDEMIC THROUGH THEIR EXPANDING RESPONSIBILITIES TO CARE FOR THE SICK AND DYING AND TO FEED, SHELTER AND EDUCATE THE MILLIONS OF ORPHANS LEFT BEHIND.

-- POLITICAL CONSEQUENCES:

0 AIDS MAY UNDERMINE POLITICAL STABILITY IN COUNTRIES WHERE KEY OFFICIALS SUCCEED TO THE DISEASE AND POTENTIAL SUCCESSORS STRUGGLE FOR POWER.

0 AIDS WILL GENERATE A SEARCH FOR SCAPEGOATS THAT WILL FOCUS ON LEADERS WHO FAIL TO STOP THE EPIDEMIC.

-- MILITARY/SECURITY CONSEQUENCES:

0 AS THE DISEASE SAPS THE ECONOMIC STRENGTH OF AFFECTED COUNTRIES, HIGH RATES OF HIV/AIDS INFECTION AMONG THE POLICE AND MILITARY PERSONNEL, THREATENS INTERNAL AND NATIONAL SECURITY.

0 THE DEMORILIZATION OF MILITARY/SECURITY FORCES MAY LEAD TO SMALLER, MORE ECONOMICAL FORCE STRUCTURES BUT MAY ALSO FURTHER EXACERBATE THE AIDS EPIDEMIC IN AFRICA BY INCREASED DISSEMINATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF HIV THROUGHOUT

AFRICA BY RETURNING MILITARY PERSONNEL WITH HIGH RATES OF INFECTION.

5. ORGANIZATIONAL EFFORTS: IN JUNE 1993 MILITARY AND CIVILIAN LEADERS FROM 28 NATIONS MET IN BERLIN, GERMANY FOR A POLICY SEMINAR ON HIV/AIDS IN MILITARY POPULATIONS AROUND THE GLOBE. THE PARTICIPANTS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES FROM CONGO, KENYA, MOROCCO, RWANDA, SENEGAL, UGANDA, AND ZIMBABWE, AS WELL AS UNDP, WHO AND OTHERS, DRAFTED AND ADOPTED A CONSENSUS STATEMENT ENTITLED MILITARY AND CIVILIAN COOPERATION IN RESPONSE TO THE HIV AND AIDS EPIDEMIC AS A POLICY STATEMENT TO ENCOURAGE FOCUS ON THIS AREA. 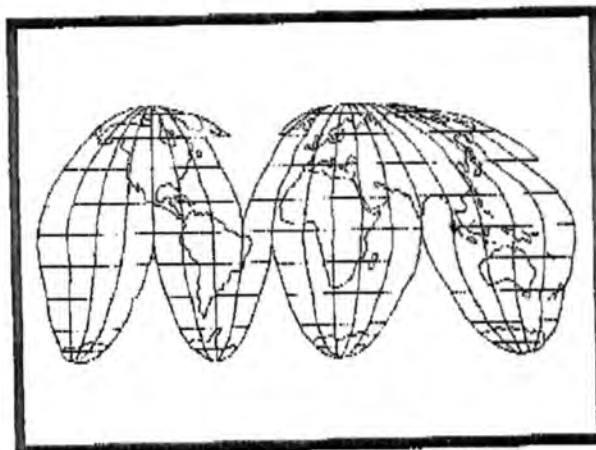

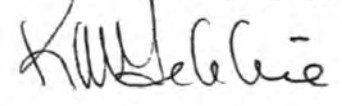

Your office has asked that I submit justification for using a non-contract, and non-U.S. carrier on a December 12, 1993 trip from Washington to Marrakech, Morocco for Kristine M. Gebbie, National AIDS Policy Coordinator. In short, there is no direct service (contract or otherwise) from any U.S. city to Marrakech at any time, or from any U.S. city to a European city with connecting service to Marrakech after 9:00 p.m.

On November 17, 1993, I made air travel arrangements for Ms. Gebbie to travel from Washington, D.C. to Marrakech, Morocco to participate in the 8th Annual International Conference on AIDS in Africa and the 8th African Conference on Sexually Transmitted Diseases. The conference dates were December 12-17, 1993. The American Embassy in Paris requested, on behalf of the French Government, that Ms. Gebbie stop in Paris on her return to meet with the French Minister of Social and Health Affairs. The reservation was confirmed November 22, 1993. The tickets were issued December 6, 1993. The Travel Order was signed December 10, 1993.

According to Omega Travel, there were absolutely no other available routings that would 1) meet Ms. Gebbie's departure schedule, which was dictated by a speaking engagement in Washington on the evening of December 12 and 2) facilitate her arrival in time to participate in the conference. Moreover, there is no direct service (contract or otherwise) from any U.S. city to a European city with connecting service to Marrakech after 9:00 p.m. If she traveled on December 13, 1993, she would have missed the connecting flight into Marrakech via Casablanca, and not participated in the conference for another day. As it happened, the outbound trip was a very circuitous routing, that required three layovers and more than 16 hours of travel.

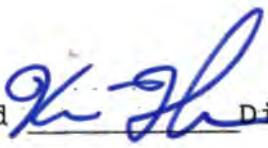
