I am writing to request an appointment for you to meet with me and executives of Serono Laboratories, Inc., regarding the use of Serono's growth hormone product Serostim™ for the treatment of wasting syndrome (cachexia) associated with AIDS. Early trial results have shown Serostim™ to be a promising therapy for AIDS patients. Serono is hoping to file an NDA for FDA approval in the near future.
