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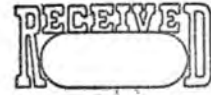

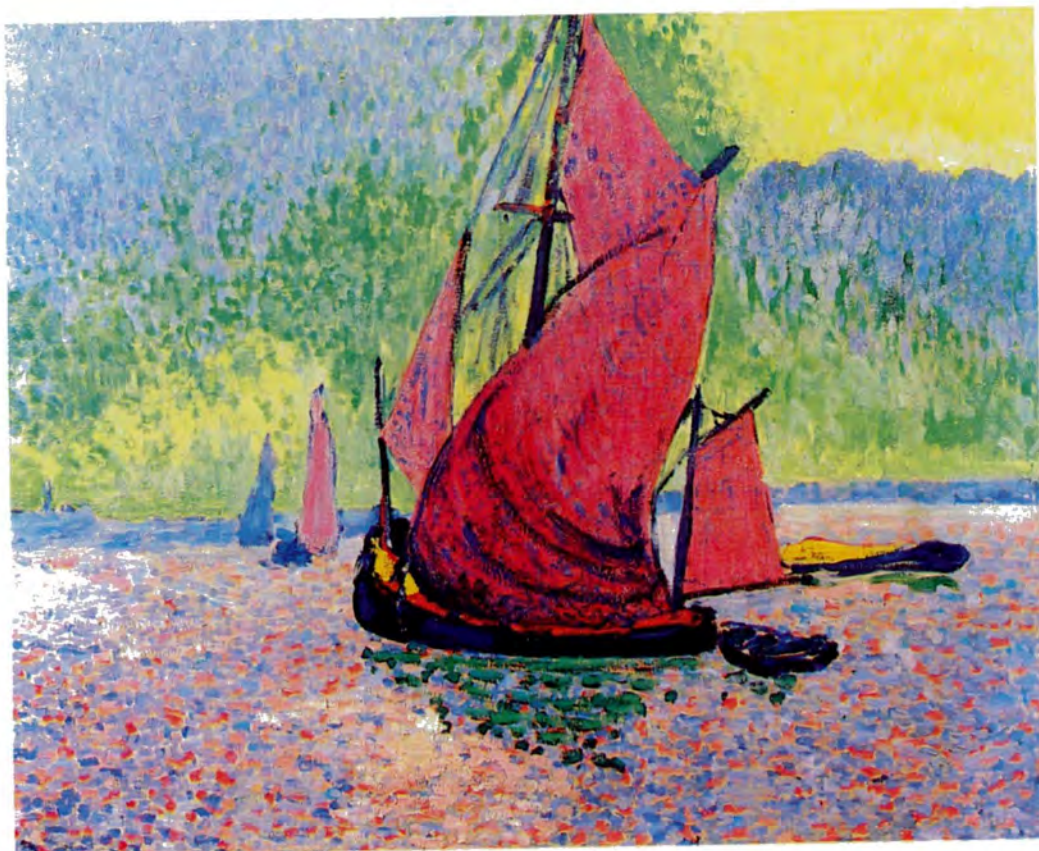
Please know that we all support you in your efforts and keep you in our prayers. For someone involved in "grassroots" AIDS prevention, it gives me great hope to know you're in charge.

Once again, it was an honor and a pleasure meeting you.

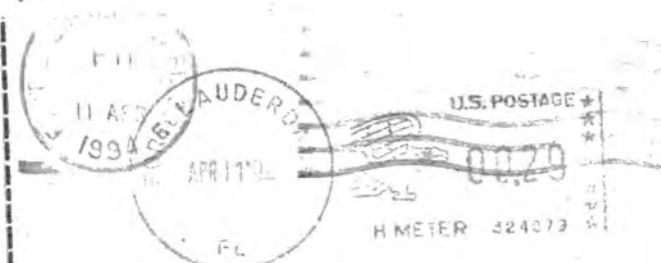

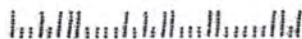
THE RED SAILS

SUBJECT: Update

Welcome to sunny Florida. I hope you slept on the plan because this is shaping up to what could be a long week! I am attaching a couple of items to this memo that need your attention.

You need to call Carol Rasco to respond to her memo on the Action Agenda (attached), which was most likely precipitated by a communication from P. Fleming, as her memo and conversation with Andrew (attached) would indicate. Carol's contact information is also attached.
