On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Black Leadership Commission on AIDS, I am writing to appeal the decision of the Center's for Disease Control and Prevention's Program Announcement 305, "Cooperative Agreements for National/Regional Minority Organization HIV/STD Prevention, Immunization, and TB Projects.

We respectfully take issue with the conclusion of the Objective Review Committee's Summary regarding BLCA's experience in addressing the issues outlined in the application. Since our founding in 1986, BLCA has championed the priorities listed in Program Announcement 305 with unprecedented success in African-American communities. In addition, BLCA has extensive experience in delivering HIV/AIDS-related technical assistance to the African-American community, particularly to the Black churches. Our work has gained national and international recognition. In fact, if you positioned the criteria of Announcement 305 alongside the mission, goals and accomplishments of this agency, BLCA would seem to be a proto-type of the type of agency the CDC would look to carry out the goals of Announcement 305.

We would like to request an administrative hearing to 1) appeal the decision, and 2) request an opportunity to submit a document of clarification.

I look forward to speaking with you regarding this matter.

QUALITATIVE RATING: Fair

Summary of Strengths:

The applicant has assisted community-based organizations (CBOs) in obtaining funds.

The applicant has conducted and developed workshop seminars and training sessions for more than 300 black organizations and institutions.

The applicant implemented the first and oldest prevention, education, and service delivery program targeting clergy of the Black Church in the nation.

The applicant founded the Public Education Technology Transfer Committee (PETT), a collaborative effort to improve the dissemination of and transfer of treatment care information to communities of color.

The applicant prepared hundreds of black leaders and people of color living with AIDS to sit on advisory boards and councils.

The applicant's plan for conducting the program activities include the utilization of the applicant's Self-Help Institute, which will offer culturally competent technical assistance to providers, CBOs, states, local health departments, and agencies at the regional and national level.

The applicant furnishes numerous letters in support and intended collaboration of the program.

Summary of Weaknesses:

The applicant has listed training and technical assistance for programs other than HIV/STD.

^ The applicant does not specifically discuss or document experience in providing HIV/STD technical assistance and training from a national or regional level or organizations and agencies serving racial and ethnic minority populations.

^ The applicant does not demonstrate or adequately document the types of the unmet needs of the target population, organizations, and agencies.

The applicant does not address the objectives in measurable terms.

The applicant's plan for the program staff to conduct the program activities is not clear.

The applicant does not provide evidence of collaboration with the CBOs.

Recommendations:

The applicant should address the weaknesses mentioned above.
