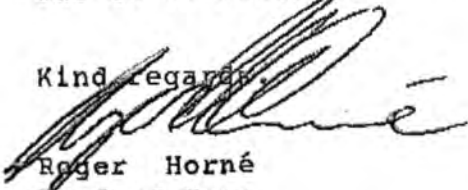

Dear Mr. Kytte,

as our producer Diana Maguhn already explained to you we are very much interested in a short interview (5-6 Min.) with the new aids coordinator. GTA represents n-tv, the only 24 hour German news-channel, which is linked to CNN. Around 15 July, 93 the station plans a one hour broadcast on AIDS worldwide with films from different countries. As the US is extremely hurt with AIDS & HIV infected people we visit for our film segment hospitals, schools & aids centers to give an overall view of the current situation here. Our questions would include whether schools over here should teach more about the use of condoms, the danger of aids, etc. Also if a needle exchange for drug addicts could at least slow down the spread of the deadly virus.
