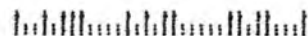

## **RELIGIOUS RIGHT AND "TRADITIONAL(??) VALUES" OUT OF CONTROL**

To Governor Carnahan and other interested parties:

Enclosed are newspaper articles describing one example of a problem in a political and legal system that is at best medieval. The State of Missouri is handling a legal case where a 32-year-old man has been charged of intent to pass the AIDS virus, even though the accused is being held in a local county jail, **is being denied needed medication routinely and given sham legal assistance by the local court.**

The accused, Mr Dale Null, was routinely abused, both physically and psychologically, by family members since childhood, until he left home in his teens. He has returned to his family in order to seek acceptance from his family as an adult, yet still encounters ignorance and hostility in connection with his HIV status and his sexual orientation. A most salient issue in this case is that the legal charges have been made by a frighteningly ignorant family member, a Ms Cheryl Herr, who is a practicing nurse in a local hospital in the Kansas City area and is clearly deficient in her understanding of H.I.V. Mr Null's purportedly "Christian" sister has decided that her brother must "pay for his actions" based upon the advice of her Baptist minister. Subsequently, she has provoked him and had him "put away".

Mr Null is being intentionally misled about the details of the legal proceedings, and routinely lied to about his legal rights by his appointed public defender, a Ms Anita Burns, under order from her superiors. It is clear that Mr Null has been framed in a possibly premeditated plan to have him quarantined, and is being railroaded through the legal system by rabid local Pharisees with the cooperation of ignorant and emotionally unstable family members.

Copies of the enclosed articles are being sent to government agencies and news media across North America in order to bring attention to a case that could easily be railroaded by local county authorities, and by default by the State of Missouri, into injustice endorsed by the ignorant, unless the case is brought to the attention of the broader public across the United States and Canada.

This case addresses both blatant prejudice toward people with AIDS and also toward people who are not heterosexual. This same prejudice is endorsed nightly on rabid ultraconservative television programming which often justifies insensitivity and ignorance in the name of Christianity.

We are almost in the 21st century, yet what is going on in Missouri sounds like something out of the rural Deep South of the 1950's. — Please read the enclosed articles for further details on this case.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES DESCRIBING HOW A PRACTICING NURSE IN SAINT MARY'S HOSPITAL OF BLUE SPRINGS MISSOURI HAS DEALT WITH A CASE OF HIV INFECTION IN HER OWN FAMILY. THE NURSE, MS CHERYL HERR, HAS ADMITTED TO SLAPPING HER HIV-POSITIVE BROTHER, MR DALE NULL, IN A FAMILY ALTERCATION WHICH SHE PROVOKED HERSELF, AND MADE THE LUDICROUS CLAIM THAT HER BROTHER MAY HAVE "INFECTED HER WHOLE FAMILY". SUCH COMMENTS INDICATE ALMOST TOTAL IGNORANCE ON HER PART OF BOTH THE PHYSIOLOGICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL RAMIFICATIONS OF H.I.V. IF A NURSE WOULD BEHAVE IN SUCH A MANNER TOWARD A FAMILY MEMBER WITH H.I.V., WHAT WOULD SHE DO WITH AN UNFAMILIAR PATIENT IN A HOSPITAL SETTING?

IN ADDITION TO MEDICAL INCOMPETENCE, THIS SITUATION POINTS OUT THE INCOMPETENCE OF THE LEGAL SYSTEM IN HANDLING SUCH A CASE. THE CLAY COUNTY COURT SYSTEM, UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, HAS BEEN DENYING MS HERR'S BROTHER, MR DALE NULL, SUFFICIENT OR APPROPRIATE MEDICATION. MR NULL IS CHARGED WITH A LEGAL VIOLATION THAT WOULD NOT EVEN BEEN CONSIDERED A BREACH OF LAW IN MOST OF THE UNITED STATES, OR EVEN MOST OF THE WORLD. EVEN THOUGH THE POLICE REPORT AND MS HERR'S REPORTS TO THE MEDIA VERIFY THAT SHE BEGAN A FIGHT BY SLAPPING MR NULL, MR NULL'S PUBLIC DEFENSE ATTORNEY, ANITA BURNS, WHO WORKS IN AND IS COLLABORATING WITH THE SMALL-TOWN COURT SYSTEM RETAINING HIM, REPEATEDLY AND FALSELY ASSERTS THAT HE CANNOT FILE CHARGES AGAINST HIS SISTER. CLAY COUNTY OFFICIALS ARE CLEARLY ATTEMPTING TO FRAME AND RAILROAD MR NULL INTO A MISSOURI STATE PRISON, AND HIS FAMILY IS COOPERATING IN ORDER TO BANISH A HOMOSEXUAL FAMILY MEMBER WITH AIDS AND AVOID FURTHER EMBARRASSMENT IN FRONT OF THEIR FUNDAMENTALIST "CHRISTIAN" ASSOCIATES.

THIS SITUATION IS A TRAVESTY OF BOTH MEDICINE AND LAW. IT APPEARS THAT OUR MEDICAL AND LEGAL SYSTEMS IN SUCH CASES HAVE BEEN MISTAKENLY PUT IN THE HANDS OF THE IGNORANT.

**NOTE THESE FACTS ABOUT THIS PARTICULAR CASE:** WHILE IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES, MS HERR IS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT "EVERYONE TIPTOES AROUND DALE (SINCE) NO ONE WANTS TO MAKE HIM MAD", SHE HERSELF HAS BEEN INVOLVED REPEATEDLY IN VIOLENT ALTERCATIONS WITH ONE OF HER PREVIOUS HUSBANDS, WHO WAS A STEROID ABUSER. SHE ALSO FREQUENTED SINGLES BARS PRIOR TO HER LATEST MARRIAGE, WHERE SHE COULD HAVE CONTRACTED H.I.V. THROUGH CONTACT WITH STRANGERS. IN FACT, HER RECENT BEHAVIOR DOES NOT RULE OUT THE POSSIBILITY OF HER OWN ABUSE OF STEROIDS. SHE REGULARLY ATTENDS A LOCAL BAPTIST CHURCH IN AN ATTEMPT TO SHORE UP HER IMAGE.

### **CHARGE INVOLVES HIV BITE**

IN CLAY COUNTY, MAN ALLEGEDLY TRIED TO INFECT HIS SISTER.

An HIV infected Independence, Missouri man charged with biting his pregnant sister in an argument last month is scheduled to appear in court today.

Clay County Prosecutor Michael Reardon alleges that the man, Dale Null, 32, tried to infect his sister with HIV. The virus causes acquired immune deficiency syndrome.

In an interview, Null acknowledged that he fought with his sister while the two drove through North Kansas City on February 18. But he said she hit him in the face and inadvertently scratched her thumb on his teeth.

Cheryl Herr, 27, of Independence said she slapped her brother, and he intentionally bit her thumb, breaking the skin in three places.

"He had my whole thumb in his mouth," said Herr, a nurse. "If I contract AIDS, he's infected my whole family." Herr said her first test for the virus was negative.

Meanwhile, Null has complained that he isn't receiving prescription medications necessary to treat his AIDS symptoms while in jail. He said he has prescriptions for three drugs but was getting only one.

Sheriff Bob Boydston said Tuesday that Null had received all the medications. "He's getting everything that he came in with," Boydston said.

Boydston said that Null hadn't received additional treatment for AIDS because the jail physician hasn't diagnosed Null as being HIV positive. The physician is awaiting test results, which should be completed today, he said.

"It is not the policy of the Clay County sheriff's Department to treat people for diseases that are not confirmed by our staff physician," Boydston said.

Reardon said his office filed a felony charge against Null because "we verified that he had been receiving treatment for AIDS." Reardon charged Null under a 1990 state law that prohibits knowingly trying to infect someone with the AIDS virus. If convicted, Null could be sentenced to five years in prison.

Null is the second person charged in Clay County with attempting to infect someone with HIV. Edward L Harris was convicted of trying in September to bite and infect a Gladstone public safety officer and was sentenced to five years in jail.

Null, who said he's gay, and members of ACT-UP/Kansas City charged Tuesday that Reardon is using the law to target homosexual men.

"Clay County seems to be using this law, I think, to harass people, to criminalize people with HIV, and to harass gay people," said Carl Hippensteel, a member of ACT-UP, which advocates homosexual civil rights.

"They haven't used it against any prostitutes yet; they've only used it against gay men."

Reardon said he files charges based on cases presented by county law enforcement agencies. He said not one has brought him a case concerning a prostitute or rapist knowingly spreading AIDS.

"I don't know if he's gay or not," Reardon said of Null. "It doesn't have anything to do with whether people are gay or straight."

## **SISTER FILES CHARGES AGAINST GAY BROTHER**

LIBERTY MO — Clay County jail officials are withholding some medications from a 32 year old Gay man with AIDS. The prisoner, Dale Null, has been charged with a state felony of risking infecting his pregnant sister with HIV during a family altercation when he allegedly bit her. Null, however, claims his sister hit him in the face repeatedly, knocking several of his teeth loose. While she was "clawing him," he said, her finger went into his mouth.

According to Null, he is not being allowed to take Bactrim, an antibiotic prescribed as a prophylaxis (preventative) for pneumocystis carinii pneumonia, a common secondary infection in people with HIV/AIDS. His doctor was also preparing to prescribe DDC, and anti-viral, after Null become resistant to the AZT he had been taking. Zanex, a mild depressant and anti-anxiety drug, is the only prescription medication he has been allowed to receive. Null, who has known his HIV-positive status since 1983, described the medical care available to him at the jail as "a joke." Results of blood tests taken since he was booked did not include any T-cell counts, an important marker for HIV patients.

Mark Chaney, a member of ACT UP/KC, said his efforts to help Null receive needed medical attention have been stonewalled by Clay County officials, including Null's public defender, Anita Burns.

According to Chaney, Burns told him, "I've heard of your group. I don't have any respect for you," and refused to discuss Null's case. When contacted by the NEWS-TELEGRAPH, Burns was out of the office. Later, someone from that office returned the call, only to say that there would be no information concerning Null's case given. Clay County jail official said there is no written policy concerning prisoner's medication.

"This is a real heinous, offensive law," said Chaney, "and this kind of abuse by Clay County is one of its consequences."

Null's lover, Blake Finley, is also frustrated at what he described as a "cover up" concerning Null's case. "Dale's health is obviously deteriorating while he's in there. It looks to me like they're letting him die intentionally."

According to Null's sister, Cheryl Herr of Independence, the argument that led to the arrest began on February 19 when she, Null, and their mother were driving to a business in North Kansas City to clean offices. A verbal argument led to Null hitting her in the chest and stomach, she claims. She held out her arm to ward off the blows when Null bit her, breaking the skin on her thumb in three places.

Herr's first HIV test results came back negative. She will be tested for HIV infection again in three months, she said.

"He has a violent temper," Herr said of her brother. "Everyone tiptoes around Dale—no one wants to make him mad."

Herr said the decision to press charges against Null was a difficult one to make. "I go to church and I talked to my pastor about this. Dale has to pay for his actions. He's my brother, bloodwise, but he's not my family."

Null said violence in his family, which he describes as "religious and dysfunctional," was common. His father, now deceased, was a Reformed Latter Day Saints (Mormon) minister. His sister has converted to Southern Baptist and his mother tried to get him to go to Bible classes to become heterosexual.

"My father used to beat me. He called me a faggot and beat me with a belt buckle. He gave me bruises and scars," Null told the NEWS-TELEGRAPH. "Mom never visits me in the hospital."

"Dale is the most sensitive of them all," said Finley of Null's family. "He opted out of the family early, then he got AIDS. He came back to them needing support, and just got insults and put-downs. This is a family of people who have had a real abusive, violent element in their environment. Add to that, his dad was a Mormon minister and needed to keep a proper image in the community. It's kind of like trying to keep a cat in the bag—this is just the crisis point."

Null said he wants to eventually get completely away from his family, but is more immediately concerned about the charges he is facing. "I'm at a point that I need a good lawyer," he said. "My lawyer is crap." Null said he has seen Burns only once, and that she was not present at a March 7 parole hearing. "She told me she was too busy," he said.

Chaney, who is trying to find a lawyer to represent Null, said the ones he's talked to have indicated such a case could cost more than \$10,000. "ACT UP only has \$900 in our defense fund," he said. Chaney is trying to find an attorney who will accept the case pro bono (without charge). Part of the problem, he said, is a widely held perception that it will be difficult for him to get a fair hearing in Clay County, which is considered to be arch-conservative.

"I'm getting the run-around," said Null. "I know my civil rights are being broken, but I can't do anything about it."

## **ACT-UP REPORT—LOCAL MAN CHARGED WITH FELONY**

by Mark Chaney:

On 2/19/94, Dale Null, 32, was charged with a Class D Felony in Clay County Circuit Court. He was bound over for trial in a preliminary hearing held on 3/2/94. His trial date is 3/16/94, also in Clay County Circuit Court.

Dale, who is HIV+, was charged with "creating a risk of infecting another with HIV." Dale became involved in a family argument with his sister, Ms Cheryl Herr of Independence Mo on 2/18/94. Ms Herr alleges Dale bit her thumb, breaking the skin. She then drove Dale to North Kansas City Police where he was held and then transferred to Clay County.

Dale adamantly denies this charge and says that his sister struck him in the mouth, scraping her thumb knuckle and loosening his front teeth. Dale is the 2nd HIV+ man that the Clay County prosecutor has charged and prosecuted in four months with the HIV felony law. Dale has gone without needed medication since 2/19/94. Clay County officials have failed to provide him with Bactrim, putting him at risk for the development of life-threatening PCP.

ACT-UP, since learning of the case on 3/1/94, continues to advocate for Dale with potential legal resources, with his public defender to take the case seriously and with the medical community to ensure Dale receive his needed medication.

Clearly, the ramifications of this case are dangerous! The law is vague and ill-defined. Clay County has routinely misapplied it for punitive and discriminatory prosecution. Clay County denies the handicapped needed and necessary treatments. Clay County continues to violate Dale's basic civil rights. Dale requires competent and aggressive defense. ACT-UP is still searching for this.

At this writing, Dale remains in jail without Bactrim and without, in my opinion, competent defense. \*\*\*\*\*

April 2, 1994: THE LEGAL DEFENDER, ANITA BURNS, AND HER BOSS, CATHERINE LADISH, WERE UNWILLING TO ASSIST MR NULL TO EITHER FILE CHARGES AGAINST HIS SISTER, OR TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHARGES KNOWN TO THE COURT IN RESPONSE TO THE LUDICROUS AND GROSSLY FALLACIOUS CHARGES ASSERTED AND REPEATEDLY ALTERED BY HIS SISTER, A MS CHERYL HERR. AS A RESULT, DALE HAS FIRED MS BURNS AND AT THIS TIME IS WITHOUT A LAWYER. WHAT FOLLOWS IS A TRANSCRIPTION OF HIS ACCOUNT OF THE EVENTS OF THE NIGHT OF FEBRUARY 18, 1994. MR NULL'S ACCOUNT CLEARLY AND FUNDAMENTALLY CONTRADICTS THE ACCOUNT OF MS HERR.

IT IS ALSO NOTEWORTHY THAT AFTER THE DISMISSAL OF SOME UNBELIEVABLY TENDENTIOUS AND MISINFORMED ACCUSATIONS OF H.I.V. TRANSMISSION MADE BY MS HERR, A FUNDAMENTALIST 'CHRISTIAN' AND PURPORTED NURSE, EITHER MS HERR AND/OR THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TRUMPED UP NEW CHARGES OF ASSAULT, ON MARCH 30, WHICH ARE CLEARLY CONTRADICTED BY THE FOLLOWING ACCOUNT. THE FACT THAT THERE HAVE BEEN NEW CHARGES ALSO BRINGS TO QUESTION THE MOTIVES OF MS HERR IN FILING ANY CHARGES AT ALL. THESE MOTIVES ARE ELUCIDATED BY:

- 1) COMMENTS MADE BY MS HERR AND OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS, QUOTED BELOW, ABOUT MAKING SURE DALE ENDED UP IN PRISON,
- 2) THE FACT THAT MS HERR HAS RECENTLY FALLEN INTO EXECUTORSHIP OF HER MOTHER'S ESTATE, AND
- 3) AN ACCOMPANYING CONCERN ABOUT RESPONSIBILITY FOR CARE OF HER BROTHER, DALE, SHOULD HE BECOME DISABLED DUE TO ADDITIONAL HEALTH PROBLEMS (WHICH ARE BEING SEVERELY COMPOUNDED BY HIS STAY IN THE CLAY COUNTY DETENTION CENTER).

IF DALE WERE TO DIE WHILE INCARCERATED, IT WOULD SOLVE MANY OF THE NULL FAMILY'S PROBLEMS, INCLUDING COVERING UP THEIR NOW OBVIOUS PLANS TO GET RID OF A FAMILY MEMBER WHOSE REAL "CRIME" IS EMBARRASSING FAMILY MEMBERS WITH HIS H.I.V. STATUS AND HIS SEXUAL IDENTITY, AND THREATENING TO BECOME DEPENDENT ON HIS SISTER SHOULD HIS HEALTH FAIL. MEMBERS OF THE NULL FAMILY ARE CLEARLY DOING ALL THEY CAN TO FRAME THEIR OUTCAST BROTHER. HERE IS A TRANSCRIPTION OF MR DALE NULL'S SPOKEN ACCOUNT OF THE INCIDENT:

"I would like to file charges against my sister for assault, for hitting me in the eye. Her name is Cheryl Herr. She lives at 827 South Logan (in Independence); telephone 836-3680. Work number is 228-6000. Race: White. Sex: female. Occupation: Nurse. Age: 27. Date of birth: 9-21-66. She hit me at about 6:00 pm on February 18, 1994; at the same time that she hit me, she said that she would 'make sure that (I) go back to prison'.

"SHE LIED ON SOME OF THE POLICE REPORTS. We were in the car. Cheryl had given me her keys to put down. She was complaining about how I forget things. Mom was sitting in the back seat, kicking the back of the seat I was sitting in. She knew I had back pains and problems from the spinal tap I had had in January. I told her to quit kicking me.

At the same time, Cheryl was mouthing off about my lifestyle. She said that I wasn't living my life right, and that I deserved to have AIDS. I told her to "mind her own business"; and at about that time she popped me in the mouth. She did not slap me; she doubled up her fist and hit me in the eye and in the mouth. She said she slapped me, but that's not what happened. She punched me in the eye and in the mouth. She punched me with the hand she wears her rings on; that's how she got her thumb hurt. We were in the car and she had already stopped at a stop sign, so we weren't moving. I did not punch her in the back of the head, as she claims; I was pulling her head back, by the hair, trying to make her quit hitting me, and the back of her head hit the car seat. She kept on by gouging at my eyes and my mouth. She said she started up the car right away and kept going; that's a lie. First she told me to get out, even though it wasn't her car. It was mom's car. Then she started the car and said she was going straight to the police station since I didn't get out. She was going to make sure I go back to prison. Mom didn't say a word.

"Cheryl was already upset about something before all this; Mom had kicked Mike (my brother) out of the house and he was having to stay at Cheryl's house. Mike had also told me that he would make sure I went back to prison.

"Anyway, while we were in the car, she hit me in the face three or four times; once or twice in the eye, and at least twice in the mouth. She told me to get out or she'd go to the police station and make sure that I'd be put back into prison. I would not get out of the car. She drove straight to the police station and to the front doors. She ran inside. Then I had to go in because the police told me to go in. Mom wouldn't move out of the back seat or do anything. My mom saw everything."

\*\*\* IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE PUBLIC DEFENDER AND DALE'S PAROLE OFFICER, GLEN PAYNE, WHO AT ONE TIME WORKED IN THE CLAY COUNTY LEGAL SYSTEM, CONSISTENTLY AND EMPHATICALLY ADVISED DALE NOT TO TALK TO HIS MOTHER. YET SHE IS THE ONLY, ALTHOUGH NOT AT ALL DISINTERESTED, WITNESS TO THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED EVENTS. AND THE QUESTION REMAINS: DOES HIS MOTHER WANT HIM PUT AWAY, TOO?

The February 1994 issue of the Government Executive, has an article "Painfully Aware" which attributes several statements/ideas to you which are upsetting to me and should be upsetting to this nation as a whole.

The first statement concerns your visits to the nations defense bureaucrats "to sermonize against Victorian sexual mores." If you mean by "Victorian sexual mores", such things that I and hopefully the majority of Americans still hold in high esteem, e.g., high moral standards, faithfulness and commitment to one's husband or wife, an absence of fornication, etc., then I can only hope that your endeavor will terminate in total failure. # 'Sex Respect' Course Stirs Disdain From Critics

**H**EMET, Calif.—It's Tuesday morning and the students in Bonnie Park's classroom at Acacia Middle School are chanting up a storm: "Be confident! Be a virgin!" "Do the right thing! Wait for the ring!" "Not on weak days! Only on good days!" "Don't be a louse! Wait for your spouse!" "Pet your dog! Not your cat!"

But while the classroom of 12- and 13-year-olds sings the praises of abstinence, critics of the sex education course based on the book *Sex Respect* are be-

ginning to raise their voices across the country.

*Sex Respect* argues that by remaining celibate, you won't need contraception. And with chastity, God is always on your side. The program, used in more than 1,500 school districts nationwide, was created in 1986 as a conservative alternative to sex education. It has since emerged as the target of Planned Parenthood and the American Civil Liberties Union, which call it a tool of the Christian right. And a growing number of parents in many districts have begun to agitate for a more hard-line approach to teens and sex.

Potentially as volatile as debates over creationism and abortion, the conflict is fueling law-

suits and school board warfare from Louisiana to Riverside County.

Proponents say past educational initiatives have failed to get teens to use contraceptives and have encouraged sex. They contend that adopting a safe-sex-is-no-sex approach replaces fear with self-control and self-esteem.

The 12-week course is based on a textbook written by an Illinois woman, an anti-abortion activist and former Catholic-school educator. It focuses on morality, warning of the dangers of promiscuity and premarital sex while extolling the virtues of sex—but only within marriage.

Responsibility, its proponents argue, is better than abor-

tion and sexually transmitted disease. Sex education based on maturity and not permissiveness is, they say, long overdue.

But, critics counter, *Sex Respect* tests the bounds of law and science by favoring moral pleas over clinical information and spurning contraception.

"The idea that teenagers, especially young ones, be told that it's better not to engage in intercourse makes a great deal of sense," said Debra Haffner, executive director of the U.S. Sex Information and Education Council. "But the problem is that *Sex Respect* contains many inaccuracies. It is based on a premise that young people should not make their own decisions, and it is extremely negative about sexuality."

In Hemet, the ACLU and Planned Parenthood teamed with a parent to wage battle against Park, who doubles as a teacher and school trustee.

In 1989, Park introduced the program to Acacia Middle School, where about 900 seventh-graders each year complete the course.

A born-again Christian, Park said Planned Parenthood and the ACLU are "on a mission to get rid of *Sex Respect* because it isn't politically correct. It doesn't promote the safe-sex agenda . . . the homosexual agenda."

Maureen Bryan, the parent who filed the complaint, calls *Sex Respect* "a fear-based, abstinence-only curriculum that I see as utterly inappropriate be-

cause of its religious bias, its overt counseling against abortion and its perpetuation of stereotypes that don't belong in a public environment."

**I**n 1992, Bryan took her adolescent son out of the program, which she said "taught him he was an animal who would most likely do anything he pleased—his biology made him that way—and that it was up to the female to control his behavior."

The 1986 version of *Sex Respect*—which underwent minor revisions in 1990—also noted that "nature is making some kind of a comment on sexual behavior through the AIDS and herpes epidemics."

A federal judge in Louisiana called that medically inaccurate and banned use of *Sex Respect* in the state.

The attorney for the Hemet Unified School District, Karen Gilyard, recommended that *Sex Respect* be dropped after Bryan filed a stinging complaint. The attorney said *Sex Respect* comes dangerously close to blurring the line between church and state.

The Hemet school board, dominated by a conservative Christian majority, rejected the complaint, then hinted at getting a new lawyer. But in recent weeks, the mood has mellowed. Some board members now favor dropping the program or having the state attorney general review it.

## *Fertility Finder*

They wanted to have children, but there wasn't much literature available on fertility 10 or 12 years ago when the John Hanleys got married.

When the papal document "Humanae Vitae" came out, John Hanley decided to do some research on the subject to see if he couldn't come up with some way for determining fertility.

He did. Called the Fertility Finder, he said it is an acceptable fertility index for anybody regardless of religion. It works for women on a 26-33 day cycle and shows, month to month, when fertile days are, based on when the menstrual cycle begins.

"We're not teaching birth control," Hanley said. "We're teaching about fertility and when it's possible to have children." The Fertility Finder is being implemented nationwide by the Federal Department of Education and is being used as part of the sex education program by the Illinois State Department of Education. The Chicago Board of Education is also planning to use it.

## Population agency to target illiteracy

AMSTERDAM—The head of an 82-nation conference on population growth said Sunday that fighting illiteracy among women is key to slowing a birthrate that could more than double the world's inhabitants in 100 years. The United Nations Population Fund, sponsoring the conference that begins Monday, will seek agreement on eradicating illiteracy among women by the year 2000 and improving the availability of contraceptives, conference sources said. The gathering opens the same day the U.S. House of Representatives debates a \$15 million proposal to resume funding the UN agency. The money was cut off in 1985 over an agency-supported Chinese birth-control policy that reportedly included forced abortions.

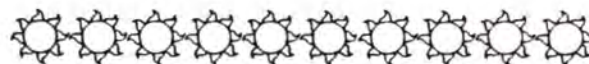

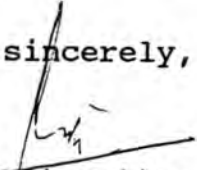
Thank you very much for your letter of May 25, 1993.

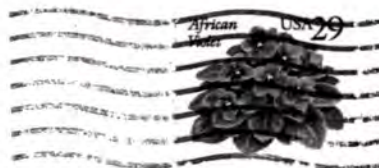

### Bruce Eddeth (Eddie) Hawkins

Bruce Eddeth (Eddie) Hawkins, born March 12, 1947, died at his home in Austin on Sunday morning, January 16. He had lived part of his childhood and most of his adult life in Austin.

Ed Hawkins had a beautiful way of living fully in the present moment. He was a private, gentle man of innate social grace and refined sensibility. He had a playful wit and a gift for placing things in the world so that others loved the environments he created. Most of his work experience was in service and catering: Eddie was an exquisite butler and a masterful chef who had a fine palate and a classic sense of style and presentation.

In 1985, with partner Tom Cameron, Ed opened *reTogs*, Austin's first consignment store for men, and ran the store until illness forced him to close it and retire in 1989. He established the local market for men's previously-owned clothing of quality. His knowledge of fabrics, tailoring, and workmanship, and his personal integrity with his clients set the standard for men's consignment and resale shops in the city.

Ed took delight in both art and nature; he thought hiking trails as remarkable as museums. Throughout his life, he regarded experiences as opportunities for learning and growth. Consequently, people in the health-care professions who sustained Eddie during his extended months of illness have invariably said that Eddie made their work not so much a chore as a pleasure and a privilege. Heartfelt thanks go especially to Drs. Berman, Blair and Levy and their fine staff at Jefferson Street Family Practice; to the incomparable, humane nurses on the Fourth Floor East at St. David's Hospital; to the loving Caremark staff, Medical Park Tower Pharmacy, the Home Health Division of Austin/Travis County, CCAD, PVNS, and AIDS Services of Austin.

Survived in the Austin area by Cameron and a loving family of friends, Eddeth is also survived by his mother, Pansy Hawkins of Greenwood, South Carolina; his sister, Sylvia Peurifoy of Cleveland, North Carolina; nieces and nephews.

His father, Miller Willis Hawkins, preceded him in death.

Mourners are encouraged to make donations in Eddie's name to charities of their choice.

Cremation was handled by King-Tears. A memorial gathering will occur on Sunday afternoon at 12:30 at Auditorium Shores Gazebo on Town Lake; friends are asked to bring a poem to read or a remembrance to share.

The silence and the sluggish action of our government toward the epidemic of AIDS have contributed to this valuable citizen's death and will allow another tragic and needless death that will appear in tomorrow's papers.

There are some problems no government can solve. But a cure for AIDS is achievable with our nation's great resources. AIDS research *must* be greatly intensified without delay.

Your office and your position of leadership can help stop this modern-day holocaust. Please perform one compassionate act today-- one phone call to the National Institute of Health, one declaration of the urgency of AIDS in your next speech, one visit to an AIDS ward or hospice-- to fight AIDS in the memory of this citizen's death.

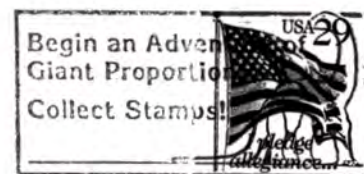

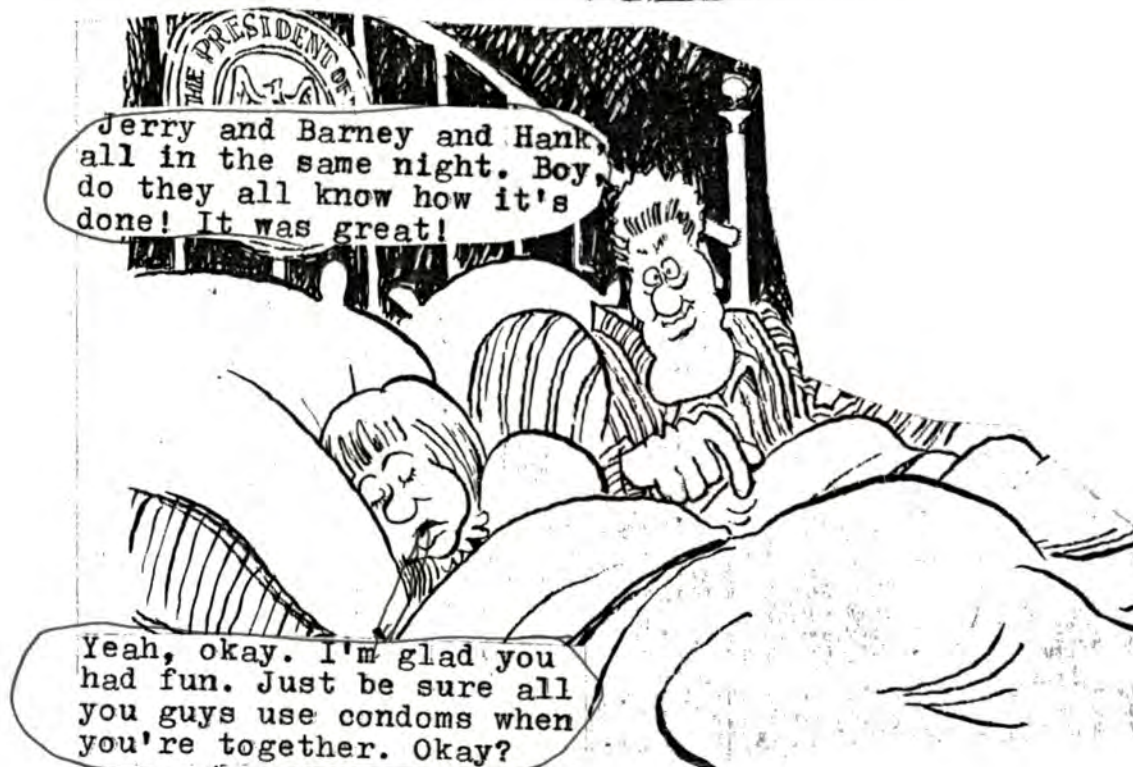

## SAVING THE PLANET

I want to congratulate Discover for outstanding coverage of the global environmental crisis throughout 1988. This past year will be remembered as a turning point in public understanding of the immense challenges we face.

I have just returned from some of the front lines of the world's environmental conflict. In November, I traveled to the Antarctic, where both the warming of Earth's atmosphere and the destruction of the ozone layer have had their first and most dramatic impacts. In January, I ventured up the Amazon in Brazil to see the tropical rain forests, environmental treasure chests that are being looted at the rate of 100 yards a second.

I was most struck by the vast global importance of seemingly minor regional events. We have always assumed that our ability to create powerful new technologies like nuclear weapons posed the most immediate threat to human survival. But in the forest, the world environmental crisis has advanced to the point that even the simplest forms of technology have the potential to do much damage.

## letter in 4-'89 Discover

The need to address these global environmental problems led me to introduce on the first day of the 101st Congress the World Environment Policy Act. The legislation proposes:

- The rapid phaseout of chlorofluorocarbons, which are responsible for most of the damage to the ozone layer and contribute to the greenhouse effect as well.

- Carbon dioxide reductions, through such measures as improved automobile fuel economy standards.

- A new Council on World Environmental Policy, in place of the Council on Environmental Quality, to give these issues the international importance they deserve.

- A national recycling program, leading to an eventual ban on the production of packaging that cannot be recycled.

- Programs to identify and control sources of methane, protect the rain forests, and confront the underlying problem of overpopulation. (MH)

These measures are not too much to ask. Recycling trash and making more

efficient cars will save money as well as energy. Preserving the tropical rain forests will protect thousands of useful species as well as the global climate. In the face of such an unprecedented crisis, our real fear should be not that we might ask too much, but that we will do too little.

The economic and political currents of our world, like the global environment itself, are becoming more complex and turbulent than ever. It will take a new way of thinking to find safe passage to a new era. As General Omar Bradley said at the end of World War II, "It is time we steered by the stars and not by the lights of each passing ship."

## Ozone summit takes strong steps 'Global' law called strongest ever

COPENHAGEN, Denmark — Officials from 93 countries agreed Wednesday to speed up the elimination of ozone-depleting chemicals to save the Earth's protective atmospheric layer.

Environment ministers and other officials at the three-day United Nations Environment Program meeting agreed to "the strongest package of global environmental law ever enacted," said the agency's executive director, Mustafa Tolba.

"If this timetable holds, the

hole in the ozone layer will not become larger in the next century. On the contrary, it will reduce," said Danish Environment Minister Per Stig Møller, the host of the conference.

Scientists say the ozone layer that shields the Earth from damaging rays from the sun is disappearing faster than previously forecast. The results will be more skin cancer, blindness, vulnerability to disease and damage to marine food chains.

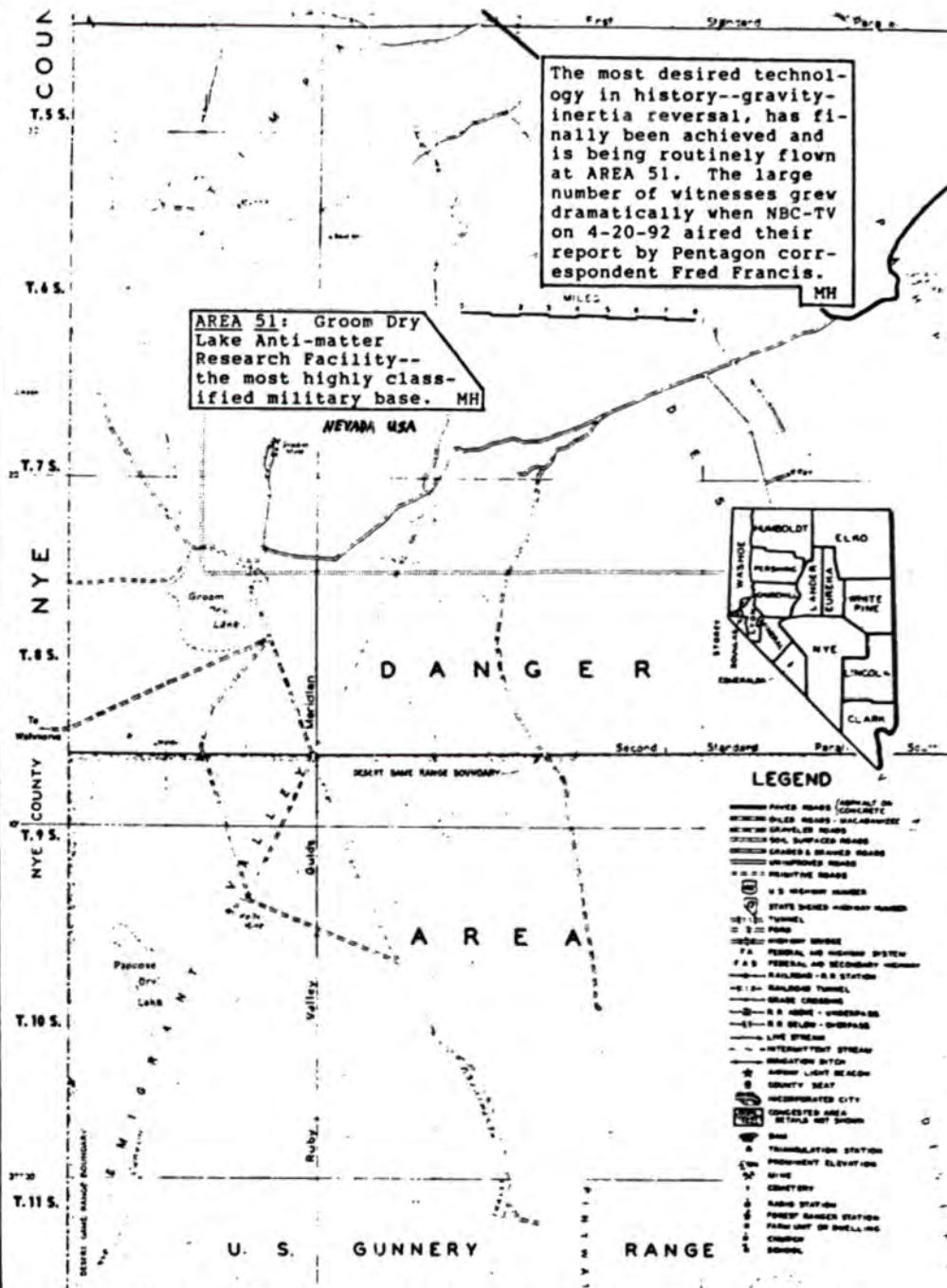
The signatories to the Montreal Protocol on the control of ozone-depleting substances agreed to phase out chlorofluorocarbons, or CFCs, and carbon tetrachloride by Jan. 1,

1996, four years ahead of schedule.

The ministers moved up elimination of halons by six years, from 2000 to 1994. Methyl chloroform is to be banned by 1996, nine years earlier than previously agreed.

CFCs are used in refrigeration, air-conditioners and aerosol spray cans. Carbon tetrachloride is used for dry cleaning and as a fumigant. Halons are used in firefighting foam. Methyl chloroform is used in dry cleaning. Environmental organizations said even the new timetables are too slow.

"Governments shook hands today on the weakest controls on the table..." said Fiona Weir of Friends of the Earth.

# We Need **Crime Control** **NOT** **Gun Control or a Federal Police State**

In the past several months the militant gun control lobby and its powerful allies in the media and Congress have seized on several sensational shootings and a public concern over crime to push for a vast array of gun control measures, some calling for outright confiscation of firearms. The same forces are pushing for new draconian legislation to expand federal criminal jurisdiction far beyond what the Constitution authorizes.

- ◆ But the problem is not that there are too many guns. There are estimated to be well over 200 million firearms in the U.S., including some 60-65 million handguns. There are over 60 million gun owners. Less than 0.2% of the total firearms and less than 0.4% of handguns are used in criminal activities. In other words 99.8% of U.S. guns are not involved in criminal use.
- ◆ The problem is a criminal "justice" system that rewards criminals. A tiny (but growing) minority of our population is responsible for our crime wave. For years, "liberals" have passed laws and won court decisions that handcuff the police and prosecutors while giving vicious criminals more "rights" than their victims. Now these same "liberals" say the solution to the problem they have caused is to disarm the law-abiding citizen.
- ◆ Gun control laws target the law-abiding owners of the 99.8% of firearms, rather than the tiny minority of violent criminals who misuse guns, who will violate gun control laws, and who will continue their crime rampages until they run into an armed citizen or are taken out of circulation with some serious prison time.
- ◆ Politicians who exploit the public alarm over crime to promote gun control instead of crime control are contemptible demagogues and threats to society who must be opposed and exposed.
- ◆ The God-given right that every individual possesses to arm himself for protection against

ordinary criminals, foreign invaders or tyrannical government is guaranteed in the 2nd Amendment of the Bill of Rights of the U.S. Constitution — the same Constitution every elected office holder takes an oath to uphold and defend.

- ◆ The lessons of history in our own century make perfectly clear how great a threat gun control is to freedom, peace and safety. Rigid gun control has been the cornerstone of every totalitarian system, whether communist, nazi or fascist.
- ◆ Another cornerstone of totalitarianism has always been the centralization of police powers under the national government. The same forces who are promoting gun control are also promoting legislation that is moving us toward a federal police state.
- ◆ Yes, we must get tough on crime, but we must not embrace Big Brother totalitarianism in the process. Our constitution strictly limits the federal government's powers to those specifically delegated to it. Jurisdiction over most criminal matters (murder, rape, robbery, theft, fraud, etc.) was wisely left by our founders to the state and local governments. Federal laws and court rulings have greatly impaired local law enforcement, while federal welfare and education programs have undermined morality, family cohesiveness and respect for authority. We don't need more federal intrusion; we need Congress to remove the federal meddling that is responsible for much of our crime problem.

We need crime control--not gun control. National registration of guns was swiftly followed by confiscation and totalitarian government in Czechoslovakia in 1948, Poland in 1981, and Lithuania in 1990.

**HOAX** - The Ozone layer and the so-called holes in the ozone layer are one of the biggest hoaxes in history. It is designed to hasten the New World Order. The only answer to such a problem, were it real, is centralized control of the earth's atmosphere and everything that goes into it. In other words one-world-government. The treaties signed at the Earth Summit in Brazil were designed to nibble away at the sovereignty of nation states.

Ozone does not stop ultraviolet radiation from reaching the earth. It is a product of the chemical reaction that shields us from the harmful rays. What really happens is that the sun produces light and many other forms of radiation including the harmful ultraviolet spectrum. The atmosphere contains gases, mainly oxygen, carbon dioxide, nitrogen, trace gases, and other forms of some of these same gases. Take oxygen, its symbol is O but it seldom exists in that state. For good reasons that I will not get into here, it usually bonds with another atom of O and the result is the oxygen that we are most familiar with, O<sub>2</sub>. A single atom of oxygen, O, is known as an ion. Another form of oxygen, ozone, can also be found in small amounts in the atmosphere. Ozone is produced when large amounts of energy comes in contact with molecules of O<sub>2</sub> causing the O<sub>2</sub> to split into individual atoms which are O and are called ions. Ions cannot exist long alone and seek each other out to form, once again, O<sub>2</sub>. Frequently these ions will bond together to form O<sub>3</sub>, or three atoms of oxygen called ozone. Ozone is only a temporary state because the third atom is always seeking to depart and does so at the very first opportunity that is presented. This may be caused by another jolt of energy such as lightning or by coming into contact with something that will oxidize. Lightning is

one of the most recognized means of converting O<sub>2</sub> into ions and thus into ozone. That is the pungent odor that you smell during or right after thunderstorms.

Ozone is constantly being formed and destroyed every few seconds. The largest source of ozone comes from ultraviolet light entering the atmosphere and meeting large numbers of oxygen, O<sub>2</sub>, molecules. The resulting chemical reaction depletes the ultraviolet light and splits the oxygen molecule into ions. These ions seek each other or molecules of O<sub>2</sub> and form either O<sub>2</sub> or O<sub>3</sub>. The O<sub>3</sub> does not exist more than a few seconds and reverts to O<sub>2</sub> as the third atom is released to either unite again with another ion forming O<sub>2</sub> or unites with another chemical which it oxidizes. As you can see, ozone is a by-product of the process and has nothing to do with protecting us from the ultraviolet light.

Animals, including humans, breath air. We absorb the oxygen from our lungs into our bloodstream. The body burns this oxygen creating carbon dioxide. We exhale this waste gas along with the inert gases. Green plants, including plankton in the ocean, breath the carbon dioxide using the carbon atoms as their cellular building blocks. When they are done they exhale the oxygen. As long as there is oxygen in the atmosphere and as long as the sun produces ultraviolet light we will always have plenty of ozone in the atmosphere. Do we really need it? The answer is yes, but not to protect us from ultraviolet light. Ozone, O<sub>3</sub>, kills harmful bacteria and provides a more ready form of oxygen than the common form called O<sub>2</sub>.

The only place where the so called "ozone holes" occur are near the poles in the arctic and antarctic circles. The holes only occur in winter at whichever point is experiencing winter. They occur where the earth's tilt causes perpetual night during the winter months and where no ultra violet light is coming into contact with oxygen. Thus there is NO production of ozone. Another so called "hole" will predictably appear at the other polar region when that hemisphere is in its winter months. You should know by now that they are not holes at all but only areas where the ozone producing chemical reaction between ultraviolet light and oxygen does not occur. You should have also deduced from this process that the so called holes will seem to appear and disappear as the region moves from winter into summer and then back again into winter. The whole process is a natural cycle, it is predictable and is very simple to understand.

The scam that CFCs deplete the ozone layer (nonexistent) can be easily exposed. Most of the CFCs in the world can be found in the northern

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hemisphere where most of the rich nations are located. Why then does a so called "hole" appear over antarctica every southern hemisphere winter? Why not over New York, Tokyo, Paris, Los Angeles, or Stockholm where these CFCs are in the most use and thus can be found in the atmosphere in the largest amounts? Why does Los Angeles spend hundreds of millions of dollars to DEplete the ozone in the atmosphere directly above the city every year? Is it because the few personnel stationed at the weather and research facilities at antarctica use too much hair spray? Why is it that I am able to predict the exact locations and months that the so called "holes" will appear and disappear over the arctic and antarctic? Because the whole thing is a hoax designed to make idiots who cannot think for themselves scream for total control of everything and thus help to usher in the one world totalitarian socialist government.

Let us take a hard look at chlorofluorocarbons or CFCs. According to the doomsday prophets chlorofluorocarbon molecules are going to rise to the stratosphere where ultraviolet radiation will break them up releasing chlorine molecules which will act like a hungry cookie monster and eat all the ozone molecules. This will cause an ozone hole and everyone will get skin cancer. Right? Wrong!

Now lets look at what they don't tell you. According to measurements, only one percent of CFCs actually break up in the stratosphere, so that 7,500 tons of chlorine are being released into the stratosphere every YEAR. That is for the whole atmosphere in a years time. The amount of chlorine spewed into the atmosphere from natural sources makes that measly 7,500 tons look like a drop in the ocean. The atmosphere absorbs 5 MILLION TONS from ocean biota (algae, plankton, etc.), 8.4 MILLION TONS from biomas burning, 36 MILLION TONS from volcanoes, and 600 MILLION TONS from seawater. This does not include a volcano like Mount Pinatubo, which loaded at least 20 MILLION TONS of chlorine into the atmosphere, of which a very significant portion went into the stratosphere.

Mount Erebus in Antarctica, which erupts every day, emits 20 times more chlorine into the atmosphere than the entire amount of chlorine allegedly produced from the breakdown of CFCs. Mount Erebus is about six miles upwind from McMurdo Sound, the station from which chlorine measurements are taken. The readings are then used to claim that CFCs, not natural chlorine sources, cause the depletion of the ozone layer. It really does not matter as ozone is not layered in the atmosphere and it is not what shields us from those nasty ultraviolet rays.

The case is exactly the same with halogens. The doomsayers went all

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halogen fire extinguishers banned, because they produce bromine. This chemical is supposed to be a super ozone destroyer, ten times more dangerous than CFCs. The Actual amount of bromine released is very insignificant, perhaps not even measurable because most of the bromine that's actually in halogen is destroyed in a chemical reaction during fire suppression. On top of that they never have a life long enough in the atmosphere that's necessary to even get to the stratosphere.

Ozone levels over a measured period of time shows a clear oscillation from year to year. If you compare the cycle in ozone levels with the number of sunspots over the same period, the correlation is clear. An 11-year and a 22-year cycle in ozone levels, matching the sunspot cycle, are clearly evident. A major influence on the density of ozone in the atmosphere is sunspots, solar flares, the influence of the sun. It is how ozone is created in the first place - billions of tons of ozone are created every instant and are destroyed every instant.

In 1988 the Ozone Trends Panel released a report supposedly documenting that there had been a three percent depletion of the ozone layer over the northern hemisphere. They gave a press conference, they handed out a summary of the report, but the report itself did not come out for another three years. When it came out, what it said was actually different from what they reported at the press conference. But it scared everybody, and it got everything into motion that was necessary to ban CFCs. Then they gave a whole sequence of conferences after that, with the same modus operandi. they gave a press conference in April 1991 that claimed "eight percent ozone depletion," no scientific paper to follow it up, no peer review of the data. Last October, they gave another press conference, where they claimed something very similar, but again with no report, nothing published in the scientific literature.

In their 1988 press conference, the Ozone Trends Panel picked a very curious date, 1969, to start their analysis of worldwide ozone data. And they ended in 1985, 17 years or one-and-a-half solar cycles later. If you draw a straight line from 1969 to 1985, you get the ozone depletion that they claim. But if they had used the 22-year period between 1962 and 1985, there is not a great deal of change. It's entirely a decision of what date they picked to begin their measurements, one of the most critical features of how they've been manipulating public opinion.

Another way the Ozone Trends Panel manipulated their data to scare the public involves the enormous variability in the ozone in the atmosphere from day to day, month to month, and at different times of the year. The

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density of the ozone in the atmosphere over the northern hemisphere in March is much greater than in October of the same year - a 40 percent difference and it happens every year according to the natural cycles previously described. The Panel started measuring in the time of year when the ozone is densest, and stopped in the part of the year when it is the least dense. Again, these groups are manipulating the data intentionally to scare the public into believing there is a danger which does not actually exist.

They also claim a dropoff in CFC concentrations, going from 100 to 5 parts per trillion, in just the first two or three kilometers upon entering the stratosphere. The ozone depletion proponents say the concentrations get lower because ultraviolet radiation is breaking up the CFC molecules, and the stratosphere is the only place where there are intense enough amounts of ultraviolet radiation to break down the CFC molecules.

The stratosphere starts around 25 kilometers above the earth's surface, and very small amounts of ultraviolet radiation in the range necessary to break down CFC molecules get within 30 kilometers. In order to find the significant concentrations of ultraviolet radiation that can break up CFC molecules, you've got to get above 40 kilometers. CFC molecules just don't make it up that high. So it can't be ultraviolet radiation that's getting rid of the CFCs which is then supposed to be releasing chlorine which is then supposed to be destroying the imaginary ozone layer. Sorry folks it just is not happening.

Another thing they conveniently omit is that the stratosphere is an inversion layer, which means that instead of getting colder with altitude, it gets warmer, and when you have warm air on top of cold air, the cold air is like a plug. It's why Los Angeles has its smog problem. The air cannot rise above the valley because of the inversion layer - the air remains trapped. Whatever air makes it to the upper part of the atmosphere comes right back down because of this plug, there is no evidence that they are being broken up.

The threat touted by the doomsayers is increased skin cancer, a blatant lie. The only reason skin cancer has risen is that the old taboos against being in the sun and sun-tanning have fallen by the wayside. The population of the world has doubled and there are more people out in the sun and on beaches than ever in the history of the world. More light skinned people have moved south or north as the case may be in order to enjoy milder winters. If a person living in the northern hemisphere moves south only 60-120 miles it translates into an increase of 10 to 20 percent

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in ultraviolet radiation exposure. If you were to move from Tromso, Norway, to Panama or Bombay, you're talking about an increase in ultraviolet radiation of more than 600 percent!

According to the theory of those who want to scare you into the New World Order, a one percent ozone depletion means a two percent increase in ultraviolet radiation. But the data shows ultraviolet radiation actually decreased as much as seven percent between 1974 and 1975, when these measurements were taken in the United States. When this study was released in *Science* magazine by Joseph Scotto of the National Cancer Institute - the only network in the world systematically measuring ultraviolet radiation - the government shut down the instruments!

CFCs are being banned, yet nobody talks about the consequences of this action. The fact is that the entire world food supply depends on what is called the "cold chain," the network of refrigerated warehouses and refrigerators in homes, supermarkets, and so on, that keep food from spoiling. The world already produces more than enough food to feed every man, woman, and child, the problem is that between 30 to 60 percent of it spoils every year, depending on the country.

By truly banning the CFCs, effectively you're going to have to scrap every refrigerator around the world - a billion home refrigerators, several hundred million commercial refrigerators. It could mean a collapse of the worldwide cold chain. Remember *Global 2000*, the plan to deplete the world's population by 2 billion people? To make it worse, any potential drop-in substitute cannot presently be used in any existing equipment. So you've got to build entirely new equipment. And who benefits? The multinational corporations that belong to the Illuminati. Those who manufacture new equipment and the chemical companies that could make hundreds of BILLIONS of dollars in revenues every year from the ban of CFCs.

The ozone depletion theory is a fraud. There is no significant increase or decrease in ozone, no significant increase or decrease in ultraviolet radiation. The threat does not exist. It is not there. It has been proven time after time.

## Abortion Foes Plan to Boycott French Pill Maker

WASHINGTON, June 1 (AP) — A coalition of abortion opponents announced plans today to boycott the French maker of the abortion pill RU486 and its American subsidiaries for arranging to bring the drug into the United States.

The coalition, which includes the National Right to Life Committee and the Southern Baptist Convention, said it would decide which of the companies' products to boycott within a few weeks.

The French manufacturer, Roussel Uclaf, had for years chosen not to sell the drug in the United States in the face of such boycott threats. Last

month, under pressure from the Clinton Administration to make the drug available here, the company donated the RU486 patent rights to a nonprofit organization, the Population Council.

The council is seeking a United States manufacturer and plans to test RU486 on 2,000 American women this fall in seeking Food and Drug Administration approval of the pill. The drug, which can be used within seven weeks of conception to end a pregnancy, could be licensed for sale within two years.

Despite Roussel Uclaf's donation of the rights, the anti-abortion coalition nevertheless vowed to punish the

company, its German parent, Hoechst, and two United States subsidiaries, the drug maker Hoechst Roussel and the chemical manufacturer Hoechst Celanese.

"They cannot escape the moral responsibility for what will ensue," said the National Right to Life Committee's president, Wanda Franz. "What RU486 will bring us is serial killing by abortion."

The four companies produce a wide variety of items, including prescription medicines and polyester and bulk chemicals used by companies in the United States to make products like detergents.

# Revival of faith

Religious concerns no longer off-limits in prime-time fare

**L**OS ANGELES—Television has gotten religion. "Picket Fences" routinely grapples with issues of faith. "L.A. Law" introduced an evangelical attorney into its secular ranks. On "Northern Exposure," a rabbi counsels a Jewish man vexed by an interreligious romance.

"Christy," the story of a young teacher at a Quaker-run school in Appalachia, finds a home on TV after a producer's fruitless, two-decade quest to turn the popular Catherine Marshall novel into a movie.

"Something's happening out there," says L. Brent Bozell, chairman of the conservative Media Research Center, which in a study of 1993 TV programs found religion to be nearly invisible.

"It has been a year when religion and faith were accessed a lot more than we intended at the beginning," says David E. Kelley, creator of "Picket Fences," the CBS drama about a small town's life and residents.

The reasons cited for the surge vary, as do the reactions to it. Some religious leaders consider the attention a mixed blessing. It is also a clear change from past TV seasons.

Media Research Center's study found religion was mentioned or dealt with just 116 times in more than 1,000 hours of entertainment programming in 1993. Believers were depicted negatively 68 percent of the time, the study found.

In other years, television usually ventured no further than shows that were cosmetically religious but devoid of religious content.

Series like "Amen" and "Father Dowling Mysteries" used their characters' faiths merely as window dressing. Serious consideration of religious values was absent.

Some suggest that America was finally ready—if not overdue—for such depictions of faith on TV.

"There's a desire to reclaim lasting values, a reaching out for examples" after the excesses of the 1980s, says Ken Wales, producer of CBS' "Christy."

"I think reality is hitting Hollywood," Bozell says, "in the sense that Hollywood can't escape society and the devastating condition

of society. All they have to do is get in their limousines and drive a few blocks to the inner city, South Central L.A."

Alexandra Powers, who played the evangelical Jane Halliday on NBC's now-canceled "L.A. Law," says she's gotten letters praising the character's devout, intelligent and non-preachy nature.

"I became aware of the need for this type of character," the actress says. "There are so many Christians who feel they don't have a voice in the media or on television, and I think a lot of people related to her."

Networks, fending off criticism over TV violence, also are seen as eager to move toward what Bozell deems "family values" programs that embrace morality.

Kelley, however, says there are other forces at work in "Picket Fences."

"We don't sit back here as producers and say it's time to start proffering family values, so much as you are trying to proffer entertainment drama that may provoke people to think and to feel," he says.

Religion and faith "have given us the occasion to explore our characters further," Kelley says.

Despite its thoughtful approach, the series has drawn criticism. Catholic leaders objected to an episode in which a judge chastises a priest for the church's birth control stance.

But Father Gregory Coiro, of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Los Angeles, generally credits the show with sensitivity to religious

issues. He reserves harsh words for those less careful.

A recent "Roseanne" on ABC, he says, showed a young son struggling to understand faith and his family's lack of religious commitment, but coming in for ridicule as well as compassion.

Meanwhile, mom Roseanne is ripping off a company that mistakenly filled a mail order twice, and getting away with her dishonesty, Coiro says—disturbingly non-Christian behavior.

Also disquieting is the lack of the simple gestures of faith that are a part of many people's everyday life, he says.

"In most programs, we never see families going to church or synagogue," Coiro says. "We never see them saying grace before meals or showing any kind of devotion."

"If a character is facing some sort of crisis, there are millions of people who, in that situation, the first thing they would do is pray."

Bozell says the television industry is so careful to avoid offending its mass audience, and is so wrapped up in its own view of the world that it can't help but approach the topic gingerly.

He recalls complimenting one network executive on a new family-oriented show with religious themes and mentioning a study showing that 91 percent of Americans believe in God.

"Look, we're not talking God here—we're talking religion," the alarmed executive replied.

"I wanted to hit myself on the head; how in the world was what I said controversial?" Bozell says. Believing in God, he says, "is not a controversial position—but for Hollywood it is."

The techniques of safer sex can distract us from the bare bones. For example, one girl asked me, 'I was with a lover for six years who had AIDS. I've been alone for a year and I'm just about ready to go out again so I want to know how to use rubber dams.'

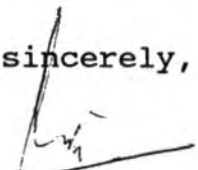

Dear Mr. Hanley,

Thank you for your letter of March 22nd concerning the Fertility Finder.

On expert advice, in the light of modern Natural Family Planning methods, I find your Fertility Finder to be unacceptable.

1. It is simply a pocket version of the "Rhythm Method" - hence it is twenty-five years out of date. Therefore, it is not a reliable guide for women, whose cycles vary widely and who today can rely on the observation of their bodily symptoms to chart their own personal cycles, taking into account the variable factors in their own lives (Ovulation Billings and Sympto-Thermal Methods).

2. It is a morally imprudent guide, because you include the advice referring users to a physician "if you experience cycles with considerable monthly variance". Such advice would open the way for many women to be subjected to pressure to accept contraception.

4. Because your Fertility Finder is not reliable, particularly at certain phases of a woman's life, it will result in unplanned pregnancies, which will in turn lead to abortions - for example if used by teenagers.

5. Promoting an outmoded method of N.F.P. widely will give a bad reputation to N.F.P. in general and will strengthen the attacks on N.F.P. made by those who dishonestly describe all N.F.P. as "Rhythm".

For these serious reasons, not only do I find the Fertility Finder to be of no use to Catholics, but I counsel you to abandon this project at once. You have a duty to the medical scientific community and to the moral and physical well-being of women and families not to continue promoting an inadequate device, which will discourage couples from using modern N.F.P.. I hope that your sincerity will lead you to study the modern methods of natural child spacing which have superseded "Rhythm", and to work in promoting those methods.

### [57] ABSTRACT

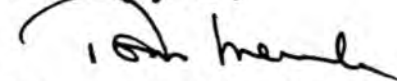
Thanks for sending me the materials you promised during our phone conversation. As I mentioned to you, my role is to let our operational staff know about important developments in our field. They, in turn, work with the member-country governments who have projects that cover family planning and reproductive health services.

Because it is a lending rather than granting agency, the Bank does not get directly involved in the procurement of contraceptives. It does advise governments about how to do it and encourages other donors to co-finance this procurement using their grant funding. We are currently preparing materials on this topic to guide the operations staff. The Bank is encouraging countries to include natural approaches where-ever it is feasible.

I think that your point about combining a fertility regulation method with use of condoms to prevent AIDS is an excellent one. A number of family planning agencies have adopted this approach.

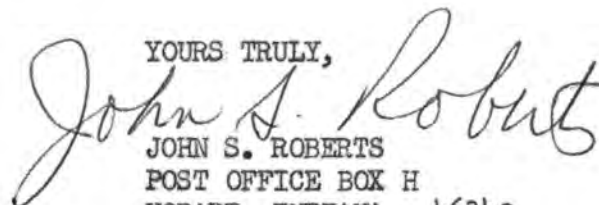

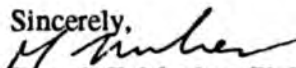
I received a package of correspondence from and to you relative to acetaldehyde and HIV today. I am really not sure why it was sent to me as I am not an AIDS researcher, my area of expertise lies in Toxicology, specifically alcohol. From your correspondence it appears that you have developed the hypothesis that acetaldehyde may be a useful adjunct to therapy for HIV infected individuals. It appears that this hypothesis has generally been dismissed by the NIH, specifically by Dr. John Bader.

From my perspective I would like to add a degree of caution to your continued efforts. Acetaldehyde, a highly toxic intermediate of alcohol metabolism, could in fact cause damage to viruses. However, the danger lies in the specificity of the toxicity. The therapeutic drugs which are being developed (such as AZT, DDC, etc.) rely on the principal of selective (or specific) toxicity, they cause death or damage to the infectious agent or diseased cell at doses which do not significantly affect normal function. A chemical that kills the patient while it kills the virus or cancer is not a useful drug. In the case of acetaldehyde, as you so rightly pointed out, it is toxic (and severely so) to a wide variety of human organ systems at exceedingly low dose levels. We believe it may also target the T-cells of the immune system and produce a lessening of their function, something which would be very dangerous in an HIV infected human. I do not dismiss your hypothesis, only add a note of caution to your quest.

It is important to remember that the more we learn about the basic biology of a disease process, the more likely we are to find a cure. I would urge you to continue your efforts, particularly with members of congress, to increase funding for medical research generally since, as amply illustrated by your letters, we cannot determine from where the next advance will come (perhaps the cure for AIDS will be found by research on the genetics of the fruit fly!!).

If I may be of any assistance to you please do not hesitate to write.

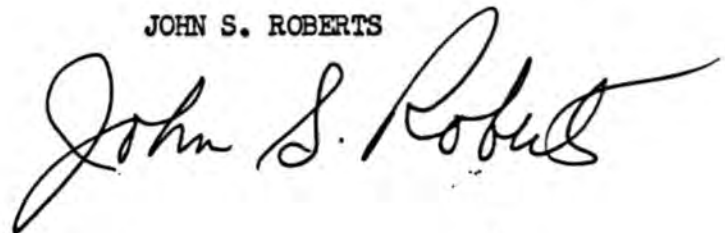

3. UNDER CLOSELY CONTROLLED MEDICAL SUPERVISION, INITIATE THE ANTABUSE REACTION TWICE A WEEK.
4. CONDUCT THE STUDY FOR SIXTEEN WEEKS.
5. CHECK THE RESULTS.

MY EFFORTS HAVE BEEN AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE FOCUSED ON HAVING SOMEONE/SOMEWHERE CONDUCT A CLINICAL TRIAL OF THE "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL PROCEDURE". I HAVE ALWAYS MAINTAINED THAT I WILL BE THE FIRST PERSON TO SHUT UP ABOUT ALL OF THIS IF A CLINICAL TRIAL PROVES ME WRONG.

IF ANYONE EVER WANTS MORE INFORMATION FROM ME AFTER I HAVE READ TO THEM MY "SEVEN POINTS", I WILL SEND A COPY OF THIS LETTER ALONG WITH YOUR LETTER IN WHICH YOU HAVE POINTED OUT THE RESULTS OF AN EXTENSIVE FRENCH STUDY INVOLVING 2,333 PERSONS.

THE RESULTS OF THIS STUDY DO INDEED SEEM TO ABNEGATE WHAT I HAVE BEEN IMPLYING ABOUT ANTABUSE (DISULFIRAM, DITHIOCARB, IMUTHIOL, DTC, DITHIOCARB, DIETHYLIDITHIOCARBAMATE).

HOWEVER, AS LONG AS THIS SUBSTANCE IS IN THE BODY, SOMETHING UNUSUAL HAPPENS TO THE METABOLIZATION OF ALCOHOL.

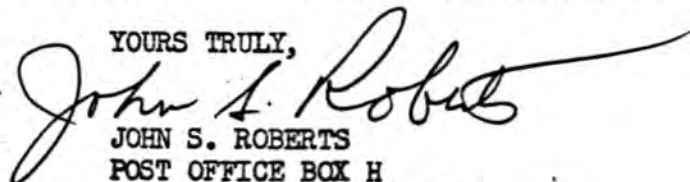

TO PUT IT IN ITS SIMPLEST TERMS - IF I HAD HIV/AIDS I WOULD GO TO MY DOCTOR AND TELL HIM TO START THE "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL PROCEDURE" IMMEDIATELY.

Mr. Roberts:

Over the past several months you have sent me copies of several letters you have sent to various Government researches and policy-makers regarding the further study of antabuse for the treatment of HIV.

Attached please find several articles outlining the clinical study of diethyldithiocarbamate, DTC. DTC, sometimes called ditiocarb, was sold in France and in many buyer's clubs under the trade name Imuthiol. Antabuse, a prescription drug used to treat alcoholism, is a close relative of DTC. Shortly after taking Antabuse, only DTC can be detected in the blood. This has been confirmed by the manufacturer and independent sources including DTC researchers.

I am most concerned about your assertion that HIV/AIDS can be "cured" by antabuse treatment. Please note that the Lange study which you referred to was conducted with the drug Imuthiol and the main conclusion of his 1991 abstract is that the presence of acid-labile alpha interferon was correlated with unfavorable prognosis. Also note that in 2,333 person, placebo-controlled study of Imuthiol conducted in France, volunteers receiving Imuthiol were more likely to progress to ARC, progress to AIDS, and experienced more opportunistic infections than those receiving placebo. Proposing that this approach may "cure" HIV/AIDS, when data suggest it may worsen the course of disease is unethical and irresponsible to the community of people living with HIV/AIDS facing difficult treatment decisions. People need to be given all information on a given approach to HIV/AIDS therapies in order to make informed treatment decisions.

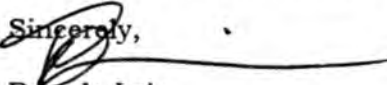
As a result of the above mentioned study, Imuthiol was withdrawn by the sponsor and people taking the drug were urged to discontinue use. In New Zealand, the only country where the drug had been approved for marketing, sales were discontinued.

Several clinical trials of DTC have been conducted. A number of small, uncontrolled, studies published in 1985 raised initial optimism over the use of DTC as a possible therapy for HIV (Lancet 12/21/85, Lancet 11/9/85). Additional small studies, one conducted at the University of Arizona, and a multi-center trial in France, provided early data-supporting further study. Despite these initial encouraging results, the large 2,333 person study conducted in France, where 1669 volunteers received DTC and 664 received placebo, resulting in a significant increased risk of AIDS in those people receiving DTC, weighs heavily in evaluating Antabuse as an HIV/AIDS therapy.

While there may be a yet undiscovered use of Antabuse in the management of HIV/AIDS, it is clearly not a cure. Further study of Antabuse or DTC should be approached with great caution, with all study participants being informed of the potential risk of therapy.

I encourage you to consider these issues when propagating support for further studies of Antabuse. Additionally, and perhaps most importantly, I discourage you from omitting the 1991 results of the French study when propagating Antabuse as a "cure" to people living with HIV/AIDS.

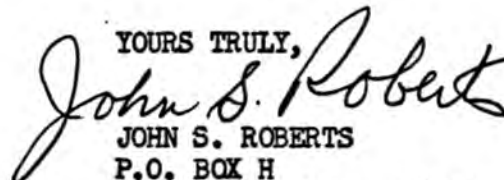

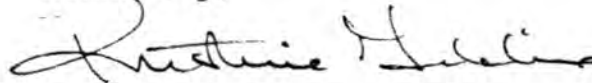

ENCYCLOPEDIA AMERICANA, 1991 EDITION, VOLUME 1, PAGE 518:

"UNFORTUNATELY, HOWEVER, THE DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL REACTION CAN BE SET OFF BY ALCOHOL USED IN FOOD PREPARATIONS OR BY INHALED FUMES (AS FROM AFTER-SHAVE LOTION)."

IN OTHER WORDS, A PATIENT WHO HAD DITIOCARB IN HIS LIVER COULD GET UP IN THE MORNING, HAVE A GLASS OF ORANGE JUICE, HAVE A CUP OR TWO OF COFFEE, SMOKE A CIGARETTE, SHAVE AND APPLY AFTER-SHAVE TO HIS FACE AND AUTOMATICALLY THE LEVEL OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE IN HIS BLOOD WOULD HAVE BEEN INCREASED.

THROUGHOUT THE DAY IF HE ATE SOME FRUIT OR SIMPLY SMELLED AUTO EXHAUST FUMES HIS LEVEL OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE WOULD BE INCREASED.

IF THE PATIENT TOOK HIS DITIOCARB CAPSULE ON SUNDAY EVENING AND SIX DAYS LATER ATE AN APPLE ON SATURDAY AFTERNOON, THERE WOULD STILL BE ENOUGH OF A DITIOCARB RESIDUE IN THAT PATIENT'S LIVER TO PREVENT NORMAL METABOLIZATION OF ACETALDEHYDE; 98.43% OF IT WOULD NOT BE METABOLIZED IN 18.6 MINUTES; PERHAPS 19.6 MINUTES WOULD BE REQUIRED TO DO THE JOB; THIS MEANS THAT ON THIS PARTICULAR SATURDAY AFTERNOON A TOXIC POISON WOULD BE FLOWING FREE THROUGH THE BLOOD OF THIS PATIENT FOR AN EXTRA MINUTE.

IN OTHER WORDS, THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE COURSE OF THE WEEK VARYING AMOUNTS OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE COULD BE IN THE BLOOD OF THOSE PATIENTS WHO TOOK DITIOCARB IF THOSE PATIENTS WERE INDEED EXPOSED TO THE FACTORS WHICH ARE LISTED ON PAGE 374 OF THE "JOURNAL OF APPLIED TOXICOLOGY" AND ON PAGE 518, VOLUME 1 OF THE ENCYCLOPEDIA AMERICANA.

GRANTED, IT MIGHT BE A MINUTE AMOUNT, NOT ENOUGH TO MAKE THE PATIENT NAUSEOUS, BUT THE FACT IS INDISPUTABLE - ACETALDEHYDE, IN ANY AMOUNT, CANNOT BE PROPERLY METABOLIZED BY THE LIVER IN A NORMAL MANNER IF DITIOCARB IS PRESENT IN ANY AMOUNT.

I THINK IT WAS THIS UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE THAT WAS AT WORK IN THE REISINGER AND HERSH STUDIES: IT IS MY HYPOTHESIS THAT THE HIV VIRUS ITSELF WAS BEING DESTROYED BY THIS HIGHLY TOXIC POISON.

THE SAME CAN BE SAID FOR THE LANG STUDY; HOWEVER, I THINK THAT THE QUANTITY OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE BEING GENERATED IN THESE FRENCH PATIENTS WAS GREATER AND THEREFORE MORE EFFECTIVE. HOW COULD THIS HAVE COME ABOUT?

BUT FIRST -

IN THE REISINGER STUDY 15 PATIENTS RECEIVED 5mg OF DITIOCARB (DTC) INTRAVENOUSLY ONCE A WEEK AND 15 PATIENTS RECEIVED 10mg OF DITIOCARB (DTC) ORALLY ONCE A WEEK. IN THE LANG STUDY ALL 83 PATIENTS RECEIVED 10mg OF DITIOCARB(DTC) ORALLY ONCE A WEEK.

NOW WE HAVE SOMETHING TO COMPARE.

WHAT DOES REISINGER HAVE TO SAY ABOUT THOSE PATIENTS WHO RECEIVED 10mg OF DITIOCARB (DTC) ONCE A WEEK? (P.682)

"ORALLY DTC TENDED TO DECREASE HIV-RELATED DISEASES, BUT THE DIFFERENCE FROM THE ORAL PLACEBO GROUP WAS NOT SIGNIFICANT."

NOW, LET US LOOK AT SOME OF THE OBSERVATIONS WHICH LANG MAKES ABOUT HIS PATIENTS; REMEMBER, THEY TOO RECEIVED 10mg OF DITIOCARB (DTC) ORALLY ONCE A WEEK:

- (P.704) - LANG TABLE II (SEE MY PAGE 13) HIGHLIGHTS THE "DISAPPEARANCE OF CONSTITUTIONAL SYMPTOMS" AND THEY ARE "PERSISTENT DIARRHOEA, WEIGHT LOSS, PERSISTENT FEVER". ALSO NOTE "DISAPPEARANCE OF SPLENOMEGALY".

AND TO TOP IT OFF, THE LANG STUDY SHOWED AN INCREASE IN THE CD4-POSITIVE LYMPHOCYTES (T-HELPER CELLS) - SEE LANG TABLE III (MY PAGE 13) AND STATES (P.705):

"THE PRESENT FINDINGS, AND THOSE ACCOMPANYING LONG-TERM ADMINISTRATION OF DITIOCARB (3 YEARS), CLEARLY SHOW THAT THE CD4+ CELL-DEFECT IS NOT AGGRAVATED. IN FACT, THE REVERSE OCCURRED, WITH DITIOCARB PRODUCING AN INCREASE IN CD4+ CELLS AND IMPROVEMENT IN CONSTITUTIONAL SYMPTOMS OF AIDS-RELATED COMPLEX. FURTHERMORE, PRELIMINARY DATA IN A SMALL NUMBER OF PATIENTS INDICATE THAT DITIOCARB DOES NOT ENHANCE HIV REPLICATION IN VITRO OR IN VIVO."

WHEREAS WITH REISINGER (P.681) THESE CELLS "..... DECREASED IN PERIPHERAL BLOOD IN ALL TREATMENT GROUPS DURING THE STUDY."

SEE ALSO REISINGER TABLE II (MY PAGE 13).

WHAT IN THE WORLD COULD HAVE ACCOUNTED FOR THIS DRAMATIC DIFFERENCE IN RESULTS?

IN BOTH THE REISINGER AND HERSH STUDIES THE SUBJECT OF ALCOHOL IS MENTIONED ALMOST AS AN ASIDE.

IN THE LANG STUDY IT IS NOT MENTIONED AT ALL.

LATE FRIDAY AFTERNOON, MAY 14, THIS THOUGHT OCCURRED TO ME WHILE I WAS REVIEWING THE LANG STUDY:

- MOST FRENCHMEN DRINK WINE WITH THEIR MEALS. -

DOMINIQUE NORBROOK, PASSPORT TO FRANCE, PAGE 20:

"ALTHOUGH MEALS IN FRENCH RESTAURANTS MAY NEED A LOT OF ELABORATE PREPARATION, EVERYDAY COOKING AT HOME IS QUICK, SIMPLE AND TASTY. A MEAL MAY CONSIST OF SEVERAL COURSES, EATEN WITH SLICES OF FRESH, CRUSTY BREAD AND ACCOMPANIED BY WINE."

SUNDAY AFTERNOON, MAY 16, AS I COMPARED AND CONTRASTED THESE THREE STUDIES FOR THE UMPTENTH TIME IT DAWNED UPON ME - IT DAWNED UPON ME WITH CRYSTAL CLARITY -

IF YOU TAKE A MINUTE AND STEP BACK AND LOOK AT IT FROM A CERTAIN PERSPECTIVE YOU CAN SEE WHAT THE LANG STUDY COULD BE INTERPRETED AS REPRESENTING (ASSUMING, OF COURSE, THAT THE FRENCH DITIOCARB PATIENTS WERE DRINKING WINE WITH THEIR MEALS) -

- THE LANG STUDY REPRESENTS THE SUCCESS OF THE "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL PROCEDURE".

1. P.702 - "THE DISEASE DID NOT PROGRESS....."
2. P.704 - "ALL THE 9 PATIENTS IN THE DITIOCARB GROUP....."
3. P.704 - "WHEN CHANGE IN CLINICAL STATUS WAS SCORED....."
4. P.704 - LANG TABLE II
5. P.705 - ".....WITH DITIOCARB PRODUCING AN INCREASE IN CD4+ CELLS....."

WINE DRINKING WITH MEALS IS SO MUCH A PART OF THEIR CULTURE THAT I THINK THE FRENCH RESEARCHERS SIMPLY OVERLOOKED ALCOHOL AS A FACTOR AND DID NOT REALIZE THAT AN EXCESS AMOUNT OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE WAS BEING GENERATED WHENEVER THE DITIOCARB PATIENTS DRANK WINE WITH THEIR MEALS.

OTHER THAN INTERVIEWING THE PATIENTS THEMSELVES, WHAT CLUES DO WE HAVE THAT THIS MIGHT HAVE BEEN THE CASE?

SIDE EFFECTS AND ADVERSE REACTIONS TO DITIOCARB

SIDE EFFECTS AND ADVERSE REACTIONS WERE NOT FACTORS IN THE REISINGER AND HERSH STUDIES. I STILL CONCLUDED, HOWEVER, THAT THERE MUST HAVE BEEN A SMALL OR MINUTE AMOUNT OF UNMETABOLIZED ACETALDEHYDE AT WORK DESTROYING THE HIV VIRUS ITSELF.



LANG STATES (P.705):

"DITIOCARB DID NOT INDUCE MORE MAJOR ADVERSE CLINICAL OR BIOLOGICAL REACTIONS THAN PLACEBO (TABLE IV), ALTHOUGH IT WAS ASSOCIATED MORE FREQUENTLY WITH MINOR SIDE-EFFECTS — UNPLEASANT TASTE, ABDOMINAL DISCOMFORT, NAUSEA, OR MALAISE."

NOW LET'S LOOK AT LANG TABLE IV (SEE MY PAGE 13).

THERE IS ONE SIDE-EFFECT THAT I WANT TO FOCUS UPON - "NAUSEA". YOU WILL NOTE THAT 19% OF THE DITIOCARB PATIENTS SUFFERED NAUSEA WHEREAS THE REISINGER STUDY NOTED (P.681) THAT:

"NAUSEA AND FATIGUE WERE INFREQUENT IN BOTH DTC GROUPS."

REMEMBER - THE REISINGER "ORAL" GROUP GOT THE SAME DOSAGE AS DID ALL OF THE LANG "ORAL" GROUP - 10mg/kg PER PATIENT.

IF YOU LOOK BACK IN THIS FILE TO THE FEBRUARY 18 LETTER THAT I WROTE TO DR. BADER YOU WILL SEE A PAGE WHERE I LISTED THREE DIFFERENT DESCRIPTIONS WHICH I TOOK FROM THREE DIFFERENT ENCYCLOPEDIAS TO DESCRIBE THE "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL PROCEDURE".

IN ALL THREE DESCRIPTIONS IS FOUND THE WORD - "NAUSEA".

IT IS ON THIS BASIS AND LOOKING AT THE OTHER SIDE-EFFECTS LISTED IN LANG TABLE IV THAT I CONCLUDE THAT THE FRENCH DITIOCARB PATIENTS WERE EXPERIENCING "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL" REACTIONS.

LET'S SAY I AM CORRECT. LET'S SAY THAT THE "DISULFIRAM/ALCOHOL PROCEDURE" IS THE KEY TO THE ATTACK ON THE HIV VIRUS. HOW THEN SHOULD THE PROCEDURE BE IMPLEMENTED?

ON PAGE 22 OF HIS BOOK 100 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT AIDS - A GUIDE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE, MICHAEL THOMAS FORD STATES:

"TO MAKE THINGS WORSE, THE AIDS VIRUS MAY ENTER A CELL AND BECOME DORMANT, WAITING INSIDE THE CELL TO BE USED AT A LATER TIME. IT CAN STAY THERE AS LONG AS SIX MONTHS WITHOUT THE BODY RECOGNIZING ITS PRESENCE. HIV IS ALSO ABLE TO MUTATE, OR CHANGE ITS FORM, VERY EASILY. THIS MAKES IT VERY DIFFICULT FOR THE IMMUNE SYSTEM TO DESIGN AN EFFECTIVE PLAN OF ATTACK. THE IMMUNE SYSTEM FORMS DEFENSES BASED ON THE INVADING SUBSTANCE'S STRUCTURE. WHEN THAT STRUCTURE CHANGES, WHATEVER DEFENSES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED BECOME USELESS. WHEN HIV MUTATES, THE LYMPHOCYTES THAT HAVE BEEN PROGRAMMED TO ATTACK AND KILL IT NO LONGER RECOGNIZE IT, AND THE AIDS VIRUS CAN MOVE FREELY THROUGHOUT THE BODY UNTIL NEW DEFENSES ARE CREATED."

AND ON PAGE 28 HE STATES:

"SOME PEOPLE DEVELOP AN ACUTE FLULIKE SYNDROME SIMILAR TO MONONUCLEOSIS, WITHIN TWO TO THREE WEEKS OF BECOMING INFECTED WITH HIV. THIS IS THEN FOLLOWED BY A LONG PERIOD DURING WHICH THE PERSON IS ASYMPTOMATIC, OR HAS NO SYMPTOMS AT ALL. THIS PERIOD CAN LAST FOR MANY YEARS. THIS IS DANGEROUS BECAUSE DURING THIS TIME AN INFECTED PERSON MAY UNKNOWINGLY PASS THE VIRUS ON TO OTHER PEOPLE. DURING THIS ASYMPTOMATIC PERIOD, THE VIRUS WILL CONTINUE TO MULTIPLY. FINALLY, MAYBE AS LONG AS EIGHT TO TEN YEARS AFTER THE INITIAL INFECTION, THE PERSON WILL ONCE AGAIN DEVELOP SYMPTOMS OF HIV INFECTION."
