On February 12, 1992, Sabriya's family received the type of news that no family wants,
expects or ever deserves. Without any warning or prior illness their beautiful and gifted
17 year old daughter, Sabriya Ihsan Bakewell was diagnosed with our nation's leading

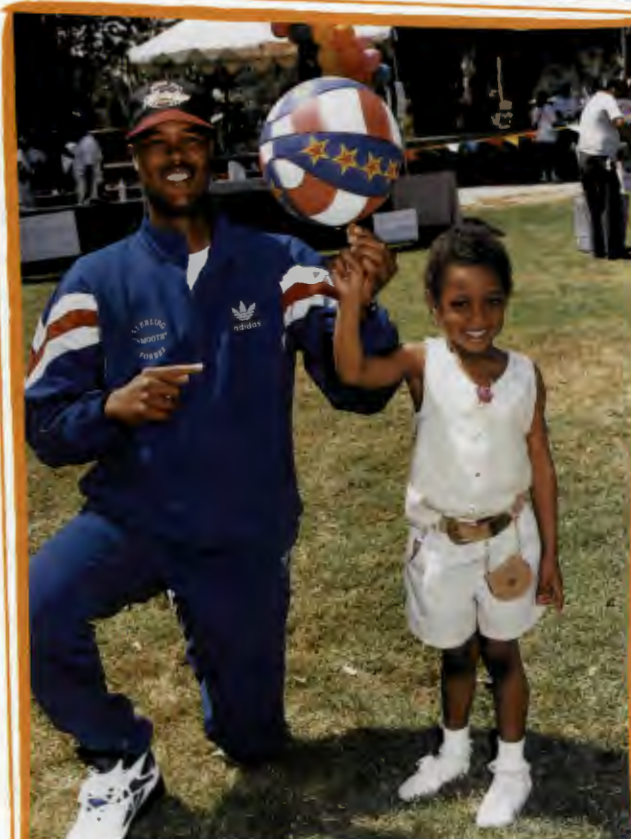
