MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET SECRETARY

SUBJECT: President's trip to Russia, Northern Ireland and Ireland

Secretary Daley wishes to accompany the President on his trip to Russia, Northern Ireland and Ireland for the following reasons:

Russia. Secretary Daley is working in support of the Presidential message that Russia must proceed with the necessary economic reforms to achieve real economic growth, and he looks forward to building on the Summit's achievements by leading a trade mission to Russia in 1999. Secretary Daley's participation would reinforce the importance of Russia's continued economic reform and commercial interchange between our two countries.

The Secretary would be pleased to support planned Presidential meetings with leaders of the Government and Duma. In addition, we strongly support the proposed speech at the Plekhanov Academy, where the President could underline support for a new Russia based on entrepreneurship, regional investment and integration into the international economy.

The Secretary would also be available to augment the President's message in whatever way would be most helpful to the objectives of the Summit. Our recommended options for the Secretary, assuming these are not possible for the President, would include: (i) meeting with the American Chamber of Commerce (the fastest growing Amcham in the world) and with a group of Russian business leaders, to promote financial stabilization, economic reform and foreign investment; (ii) a visit to a business sites to underline U.S.-Russian investment, manufacturing and technology initiatives; (iii) commercial signings involving U.S. and Russian partners; and (iv) a speech to graduates of the Commerce Department's Special American Business Internship Program, which brings Russian mid-level managers to American companies for business internships.

As appropriate, the Secretary could also hold separate meetings with the Russian Ministers of Trade and Industry (his counterpart), Economy, and Fuels and Energy to underline U.S. interest in trade and investment-led economic growth in Russia.

Northern Ireland and Ireland. The Secretary wishes to support the President's message on the importance of encouraging political stability in Northern Ireland by promoting economic development. The Secretary carried this same message for the President earlier this year when he led a trade mission to Belfast, Londonderry and the Border Counties.

We hope to build on that progress by continuing our dialogue with government officials, such as Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, Marjorie Mowlam. Secretary Daley has already promised this Department's support for Mowlam's October 1998 tour of 11 U.S. cities. Our National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration is also working with Northern Ireland's Department of Agriculture to promote better collaboration on oceanic research. Mowlam wishes to issue an announcement of our progress, which could be included in the President's schedule at your discretion.

If appropriate, the Secretary could amplify the President's message by representing him at events such as the opening of a diesel engine plant in West Belfast. The plant, which is expected to employ 200 - 300 people, is part of a joint venture led by Emerson Electric (St. Louis, MO) and Caterpillar (Chicago, IL). I understand that the President's pre-advance team may have visited the site.

Secretary-Designate Richardson's Participation
in the US-Russia Presidential Summit

This memo provides information on Secretary-Designate Richardson's participation in the upcoming U.S.-Russia Presidential Summit in Moscow on September 1-2, 1998.

PURPOSE: Ambassador Bill Richardson will be sworn in as Secretary of Energy sometime in the next several weeks. As Secretary, he will make progress on the President's national security and nonproliferation agenda a key priority during his stewardship of the Department of Energy. The Department will play a critical role at this Summit, finalizing the Joint Statement on plutonium disposition, developing the agreement on economic diversification in the troubled Russian nuclear cities (directed by Vice President Gore and Prime Minister Kiriyyenko) and advancing the U.S.-Russia cooperative agenda on energy and economic issues. As it has in the past, the Department of Energy will provide the President with the technical and programmatic expertise necessary to complete and implement these bilateral efforts.

To serve the President, Secretary Richardson will need to establish strong working relationships with senior officials of the Russian Government. Accompanying the President at this Summit will be an invaluable and irreplaceable opportunity to develop and cement these relationships. Secretary Richardson's Russian Counterpart, Minister of Atomic Energy Adamov, will almost certainly participate in the summit meetings. Secretary Richardson can build on this opportunity to assert personal leadership in: obtaining agreement with Russia on CTBT test-site transparency; pursuing Administration objectives regarding Caspian oil issues; extending agreements with Russia on energy efficiency and renewable energy; and influencing Russia to curtail its exports of nuclear technology to Iran while moderating the relationship between Minatom and Iran.

Russia:

The Department of Education has been working with several governments on a wide range of education issues, specifically strengthening public instruction in new democracies. As was evident in Brazil and Chile in the past year, and with former "Eastern Block" leaders that have come to Washington, education is central to maintaining these new democracies. Secretary Riley has had several meetings with Education Ministers both here in Washington and abroad, but has yet to meet with Russian education leaders. Secretary Riley plans to meet with several education officials in Russia, including the Minister of Education, Aleksandr Nikolayevich Tikhonov. Secretary Riley's mission will be to discuss and promote the Administration's education policies, with the specific goal of helping to strengthen public instruction in relatively new free enterprise systems.

Ireland:

Secretary Riley visited Ireland in June of 1997, where he met with the several of Ireland's newly elected officials, including Prime Minister Bertie Ahern and Education Minister Michael Martin. Secretary Riley also visited the University College of Dublin and Trinity College of Dublin during his visit. The Secretary plans to follow up his previous meetings with more in depth discussions focusing primarily on the relationship Ireland and the United States have with respect to higher education exchange programs for students and teachers, as well as several other education issues of concern to both nations.

However, if the Dublin to Shannon, Limerick goes via AF-1, HMX-1 will take three (3) VH-3s (2 for the lift with 1 B/U) and one (1) VH-60 for the other mission. In either case we plan on using one lift package to cover the entire visit to Ireland.

(NOTE 2) HMX-1 has several concerns about a Dublin to Shannon, Limerick movement. First, it forces HMX-1 to use VH-60s (vice the preferred VH-3) due to the extra fuel requirement versus pax ratio. Looking to see if there would be any passenger restrictions due to the length of legs or ambient conditions.

There are several after action items that are sure to arise from last weeks North Carolina lift that will certainly apply to this Ireland scenario as well. The biggest point is that it puts POTUS in a VH-60 for a long uncomfortable 70 minute flight.

The lift package is being developed for probably between 80 and 100 passengers. Is this suffice?

Russia:

The Department of Education has been working with several governments on a wide range of education issues, specifically strengthening public instruction in new democracies. As was evident in Brazil and Chile in the past year, and with former "Eastern Block" leaders that have come to Washington, education is central to maintaining these new democracies. Secretary Riley has had several meetings with Education Ministers both here in Washington and abroad, but has yet to meet with Russian education leaders. Secretary Riley plans to meet with several education officials in Russia, including the Minister of Education, Aleksandr Nikolayevich Tikhonov. Secretary Riley's mission will be to discuss and promote the Administration's education policies, with the specific goal of helping to strengthen public instruction in relatively new free enterprise systems.

Ireland:

Secretary Riley visited Ireland in June of 1997, where he met with the several of Ireland's newly elected officials, including Prime Minister Bertie Ahern and Education Minister Michael Martin. Secretary Riley also visited the University College of Dublin and Trinity College of Dublin during his visit. The Secretary plans to follow up his previous meetings with more in depth discussions focusing primarily on the relationship Ireland and the United States have with respect to higher education exchange programs for students and teachers, as well as several other education issues of concern to both nations.

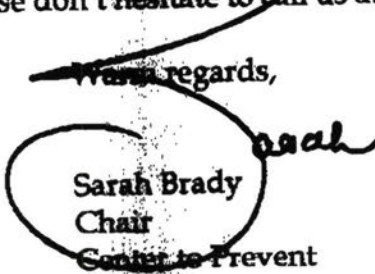

SUBJECT: Medical Advisory for Russia & Ireland, 9/98

The following is the WHMU travel advisory for the President's trip to Russia and Ireland in September 1998. This information is applicable for travel in the Moscow area and throughout Ireland for a period of less than 30 days. If travel is anticipated into other areas, please contact the Medical Unit for additional information. Dr. Mariano, Dr. Nash, and MAJ McDaniel will travel on this trip.

Specific immunizations recommended for this trip (in addition to insuring your routine immunizations { polio, tetanus, measles/mumps/rubella, influenza } are up to date) are:

HAVRIX (Hepatitis A vaccine)
Typhoid

From August 10 to August 31, 1998 the Medical Unit Clinic will only be opened on 17-18 August, and 24-25 August to get these vaccines (due to short staffing). If you need these vaccines we recommend you come before August 10th. You must bring your shot record with you in order to get immunizations.

Some travellers to Moscow have reported being told that **Diphtheria** vaccination is required for entrance. According to the Russian Embassy this is not the case. Most Americans are fully immunized for diphtheria as part of their routine immunizations (DPT, Td).

As with most trips, the major health threat is Traveler's diarrhea. The best approach to this problem is prevention:

Drink (and brush teeth with) only bottled water or beverages made from bottled water.
Do not use ice cubes!
Do not eat raw or poorly cooked meat or seafood (cooked food should be eaten while still hot).
Only eat fruit that you peel yourself.
Drink/eat only Pasteurized dairy products.
Avoid food from street vendors.

General health issues common to all overseas travel include:

Ensure you bring a supply of any prescription medicines (bring twice what you expect to need).
Bring a small supply of over-the-counter cold remedies, Tylenol, Aspirin, and Band-aids.

Don't forget any personal needs such as an extra pair of glasses, contact lens supplies, hygiene products. Things that are easily replaceable in the States are not so easily found overseas.

Anyone with chronic medical problems should contact their personal physician before traveling to check on any specific recommendations they may have. Hospitals in the major cities we are traveling to are reasonably advanced, but they still may not be accessible or be up to the same standards/cleanliness that you are used to.

Jet lag is always a concern on a trip of this duration. Most authorities do NOT recommend "sleeping pills" for long distance travel as they tend to produce "less effective" sleep. There are some situations where such medication may be helpful, although we would prefer that you discuss this issue with your personal physician prior to departure. Some helpful techniques for minimizing jet lag include:

Avoid caffeine and alcohol while traveling.

Practice destination sleep-wake cycles as soon as possible.

Try to eat and exercise at regular intervals.

Many White House personnel have passports reflecting recent travel to areas of the world in which Yellow Fever is endemic (e.g. Africa). While Yellow Fever is not a problem on this trip, countries can require certification of vaccination against Yellow Fever if you have travelled to Yellow Fever endemic areas. This certification is part of your personal yellow shot record. Take your shot record with you if you travelled to Ghana, Rwanda, Senegal, or Uganda.
