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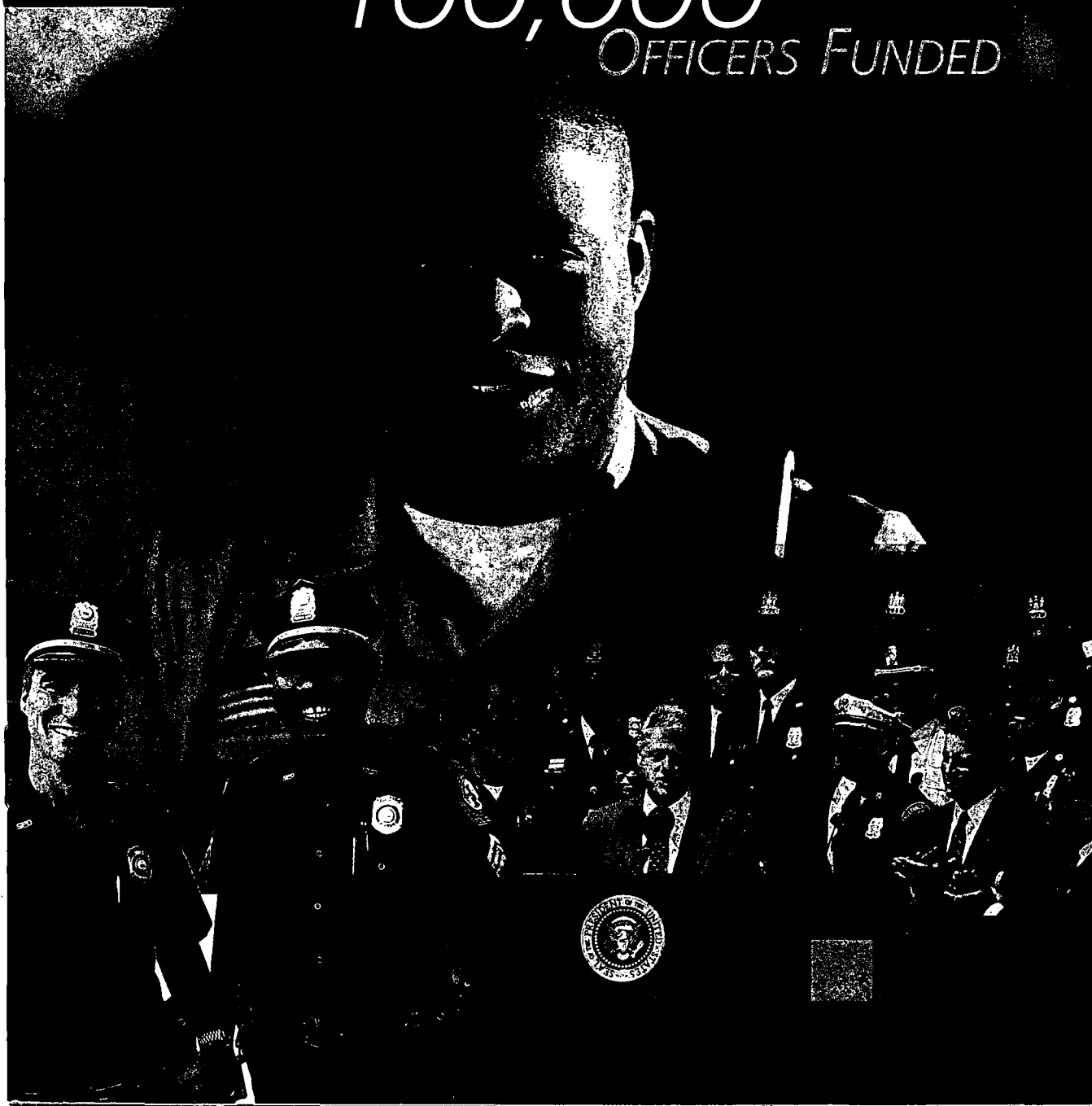

ATTENTION CRIME LA'S AND GRANT STAFFERS

The Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) is pleased to announce the next round of COPS grant awards under the COPS Universal Hiring Program (UHP). Enclosed you will find a copy of the latest round of **COPS UHP** grants to your state. Funding under these grants will allow law enforcement agencies to help pay for the salary and benefits to hire additional sworn officers. Grants will be made for up to 75 percent of the total salary and benefits of each officer over three years, up to a maximum of \$75,000 per officer. A limited number of waivers of the local match will be awarded to those experiencing "severe fiscal distress." Funding will begin once the new officers have been hired or on the date of the award, whichever is later, and will be paid over the course of the grant.

COPS in Schools

Program Information

Recent headlines about violence in our schools are resulting in a surge of interest in school safety. Unfortunately, these headline-making crimes are not isolated incidents.

According to the National Education Association:

- 100,000 children carry guns to school;
- 160,000 children miss class every day because of the fear of physical harm; and
- 81 percent of teachers say they spend most of their time on undisciplined students.

Many communities are discovering that trained, sworn Law enforcement officers assigned to schools make a difference. The presence of these officers provide schools with on-site security and a direct link to local law enforcement agencies.

Community policing officers typically perform a variety of functions within the school. From teaching crime prevention and substance-abuse classes to monitoring troubled students to building respect for law enforcement among students, School Resource Officers combine the functions of law enforcement and education.

To help hire community policing officers to work in schools, the COPS Office is offering up to \$60 million to local law enforcement agencies. The COPS in Schools initiative provides an incentive for law enforcement agencies to build working relationships with schools to use community policing efforts to combat school violence.

The COPS in Schools initiative reduces the local match requirement for law enforcement agencies seeking to hire additional officers in and around schools.

Funding Requirements

Grants will be awarded to provide for a designated portion of the salary and benefits of each new officer over three years. The maximum is \$125,000 per officer; any remainder is paid with state or local funds. Funding begins when new officers are hired or on the award date (whichever is later). Funds are distributed over the course of the grant.

COPS grants must not replace funds that eligible agencies otherwise would have devoted to hire officers in the future. In other words, any hiring under the COPS in Schools program must be in addition to, not in lieu of, officers that otherwise would have been hired. Grant recipients must develop a written plan to retain their COPS-funded officer positions after Federal funding ends. This plan must be submitted with the application.

Program Requirements

To be eligible to receive funding under this grant program, applicants must:

- be eligible to receive funding under the current guidelines established for the Universal Hiring Program (UHP);
- provide assurance that the officers employed under this program will be assigned to work in primary or secondary schools;
- enter into a partnership agreement with either a specific school official or with an official with general educational oversight authority in that jurisdiction.

In addition to these program requirements, applicants must document:

■ Problem Identification and Justification

For Example:

Problem Identification: Gang violence adjacent to or within schools.

Justification: Documentation such as crime data, information on the number of gang members in a particular school, number of suspension and expulsions related to gang activities, school survey, and complaints from the community.

■ Community Policing Strategies

Examples include conflict mediation, mentoring activities, gang mediation, problem solving projects, and truancy programs.

■ Quality and Level of Commitment to Program

Examples include the amount of dedicated officer hours deployed to school activities, the duration and quality of the proposed program, evidence of previous successes, and a description of the impacted or targeted areas.

■ Link to Community Policing

Information on how proposed activities are linked to an overall organizational community policing strategy.

Deadlines

Use the Universal Hiring Program application to apply for COPS in Schools grants. The application deadlines are December 4, 1998, February 5, April 2, June 4 and July 16, 1999. If your agency already was awarded a FAST, AHEAD or UHP grant, you may request additional officers at any time. Note on your application if you are requesting officers that will be assigned to primary or secondary schools.

COPS Grant Programs

Hiring and Redeployment Grants

Universal Hiring Program (UHP): Assists law enforcement agencies in hiring additional community policing officers.

COPS in Schools (CIS): Assists law enforcement agencies in hiring community policing officers to work in and around schools.

Distressed Neighborhoods Pilot Project: Funds cities that have experienced higher crime rates, poverty and unemployment. These cities will receive a UHP grant with a full waiver of the COPS local match requirement.

Accelerated Hiring, Education And Deployment (AHEAD): A hiring program superseded by UHP.

Funding Accelerated for Smaller Towns (FAST): A hiring program superseded by UHP.

Phase I: A hiring program superseded by UHP.

Police Hiring Supplement (PHS): A hiring program administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) before the establishment of the COPS program.

Making Officer Redeployment Effective (MORE): Provides funds to acquire new technologies and equipment and hire civilians for administrative and support tasks. These grants allow officers and deputies to spend more time on the street fighting crime rather than filling out paperwork.

MORE Renewal: Under the MORE grants, civilian awards can be renewed for up to two additional years.

Small Community Grant Program (SCGP): Help agencies serving populations under 50,000 to retain police officers by paying for a portion of the fourth year salary and benefits of existing COPS-funded officers.

Innovative Community Policing Grants

Advancing Community Policing: Assists policing agencies with further developing an infrastructure to support community policing.

Anti-Gang Initiative: Brings effective community policing strategies to the front line in the battle against gangs in 15 communities.

Community Policing to Combat Domestic Violence (DV): Funds innovative community policing efforts to curb domestic violence by developing partnerships between law enforcement agencies and community organizations.

Evaluation and Research Grants: Provide funding to policing agencies, universities and criminal justice facilities to evaluate community policing.

Methamphetamine Initiative: Assists local law enforcement agencies with developing innovative community policing responses to problems of crime and disorder related to Methamphetamine usage.

Problem-Solving Partnerships (PSP): Funds problem solving and partnership development between law enforcement agencies and community organizations to address persistent crime or disorder problems, including street-level drug dealing, rape or

sexual assault, residential or commercial burglary, auto theft, larceny, homicide, assault, alcohol-related problems, vandalism, prostitution or other disorder problems.

Regional Community Policing Institutes (RCPI): Provide comprehensive and innovative community policing training and technical assistance to policing agencies and community members.

School Based Partnerships: Provide policing agencies with a unique opportunity to work with schools and community-based organizations to address persistent school-related crime problems.

Technology Grants: Fund projects to develop technologies that will advance community policing and help fight crime. These grants are funded by the COPS Office and administered by the National Institute of Justice.

Training Grants: Provide funding for community policing training to public safety, educational and research organizations, as well as projects administered by U.S. Attorneys' offices.

Troops to COPS: Joint program with the Department of Defense that provides incentives for COPS grantees to hire recently separated members of the armed services by providing up to \$5,000 per officer

Youth Firearms Violence Initiative (YFVI): Funds innovative community policing efforts in 10 cities to curb the rise in violence associated with young people and firearms.
