I have had a chance to talk with Linda about another set of White House dates. We can suggest:


June 7,8,9,10,14,15,16,17 or 23-30.

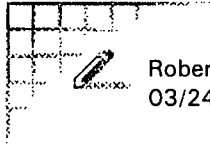
Dear Bitsey:


