I learned over the weekend that the information we had received from Arkadelphia was incorrect. The total number of entries in the file for individuals who had contributed \$250.00+ equalled not 100,000 but rather 50,000. I further learned that last year the card went to all individuals from that list who had contributed \$100+. This will add an additional 50,000 names.

I have listed below the various holiday lists as they now exist:

White House list(including POW/MIA)	78,000
DNC list	65,000
People-Based list(Arkadelphia)	52,000
State Department	7,775
Military Office	2,100
Secret Service	2,100
Ushers Office	345
Personnel	2,885

I recommend that we ask Arkadelphia to give us the additional 50,000 records that will include everyone who contributed \$100+ at some point during the campaign. This will still leave us at a total of 265,785 before the duplicates are removed in the merge/purge process.

Further, including this list will assure that we have all entries on the POC list, the Clinton early contributors list and the general election list. There is no guarantee that these individuals will be included if we do not include the additional 50,000. The DNC has included in their list all contributors of \$100+.

It should be noted that 15,000 of the names on the above lists will not need to go through the merge/purge process and they will not require postage.

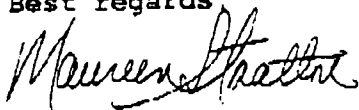

As you know, all the ornaments for the White House Holiday Tree will be donated by students from 200 university art and design schools around the United States. The handcrafted ornaments we receive from your students will be donated to the White House and will become part of the White House collection.

As the general theme, the First Family has chosen to decorate the Blue Room Tree with ornaments depicting the **TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS.*** We are asking your art students to create 12 individualized ornaments depicting the day of their choice.

Here are some requirements and restrictions which I hope will be helpful:

1. *The size of the Blue Room Tree will be approximately 19'6". The size of each ornament shall be from 5" to 18" high. Weight should not exceed 12 ounces. All ornaments should be three dimensional and hung with a gold cord.*
2. *The medium of each ornament shall be chosen from one of the following categories: glass, metal, fiber, ceramic or wood.*
