O'KEEFFE PAINTING - TALKING POINTS

As we look to the new century, the White House looks forward to acquiring more works by major 20th century American artists, particularly those works depicting the American landscape. The O'Keeffe painting is the third work depicting the southwestern area of the country to be acquired by the White House.

Georgia O'Keeffe is one of the most important figures in American art and the most well known woman artist in America. This painting, Bear Lake, New Mexico, is the first work by an major 20th century American woman artist to hang in the state rooms of the White House. It will hang in the Green Room.

It depicts the landscape of New Mexico on the lands of the Taos Pueblo.* The area is a sacred site to the Taos Indians and not accessible to the public. (The Governor and War Chief from the Taos Pueblo were invited to the reception.) O'Keeffe painted this work in 1930, one year after her first visit to New Mexico.

This is not the first time an O'Keeffe work has been on exhibit in the White House. One of her sculptures, Abstraction, was displayed in the Jacqueline Kennedy Garden in 1995-1996, a generous loan from the Georgia O'Keeffe Foundation, Inc., partial donor of Bear Lake, New Mexico.

This year has been a major one for O'Keeffe's legacy. A new museum to show her work opened in July in Santa Fe and last week it was announced that her home in Abiquiu, New Mexico will be a promised gift from the O'Keeffe Foundation to the National Trust for Historic Preservation to be preserved in perpetuity for future generations.

O'Keeffe joins twenty-one other women artists represented in the White House collection. Among them are Mary Cassatt, Grandma Moses, Henriette Wyeth and First Ladies Caroline Harrison and Ellen Wilson.

The O'Keeffe Foundation (which owned the painting).

William Rollnick and Nancy Ellison Rollnick whose donation to the O'Keeffe Foundation will assist the endowment established to preserve O'Keeffe's house in Abiquiu.

The Committee for the Preservation of the White House advised on the selection of the painting and The White House Historical Association assisted in facilitating the donation.

(Ray Kreuger, chairman of the O'Keeffe Foundation will speak on O'Keeffe and her life in New Mexico.)

Draft Press Release

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The White House announced today the acquisition of Bear Lake, New Mexico, a painting by one of America's foremost artists, Georgia O'Keeffe, for the permanent White House collection. The painting will be unveiled by (the President and) Mrs. Clinton at a White House ceremony on October 24, 1997. Following the unveiling, the painting will hang in the Green Room of the White House. This is the first painting by a major 20th century American woman artist to be exhibited in the state rooms of the White House.

Bear Lake, New Mexico (1930, oil on canvas, 30 x 40 in.) is a landscape painting of an area north of Taos on Taos Pueblo land. A sacred site by the Taos Indians, the area is not accessible to the public.

Georgia O'Keeffe (1887-1986) went to New Mexico for the first time in 1929 and painted this work the next year. For the next two decades, she would continue to visit New Mexico during the summer months and spend the remainder of the year in New York City. In 1949, three years after the death of her husband, Alfred Stieglitz, she moved permanently to Abiquiu, New Mexico.

Bear Lake, New Mexico was done at an important time in O'Keeffe's career. A pencilled star made by O'Keeffe on the backing board of the painting indicates that she considered this a significant work. She painted two other scenes of Bear Lake. One, a vertical canvas, is in a private collection; the other, an abstract work was destroyed. Bear Lake, New Mexico was exhibited once, in 1931, at An American Place, the Alfred Stieglitz gallery in New York City where O'Keeffe exhibited her work from 1930. The painting remained in her possession until her death in 1986.

The acquisition of this painting was recommended by the Committee for the Preservation of the White House. Mrs. Clinton serves as honorary chair. It is a gift to the White House from the Georgia O'Keeffe Foundation, Abiquiu, New Mexico, and William D. Rollnick and Nancy Ellison Rollnick, New York.

Twenty-one women artists are now represented in the permanent White House collection. Among them are Mary Cassatt, Anna Mary Robertson Moses (Grandma Moses), Lilla Cabot Perry and Henriette Wyeth.

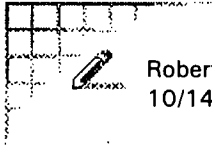
