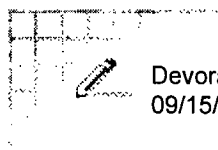

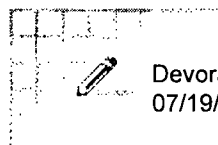

The perfect person for this policy would be a white, 50 year old woman (married) with a parent aged 75 or older who lives with her at home. This family should have children aged 14 to 20. Their joint income should be \$40,000 to \$60,000. The mother should not have prescription drug costs of over \$6000 or approximately \$2,000.
